




special investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office in conjunction with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation has resulted in theft and forgery charges against former Wayne County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) Chief Deputy Gerald Baer. The investigation revealed that Baer used two schemes to steal at least \$7,700 dollars from the sheriff's office.

Mr. Baer stole at least \$3,440 by taking cash from WCSO's confidential drug funds. Mr. Baer used white-out, added signatures, and l
