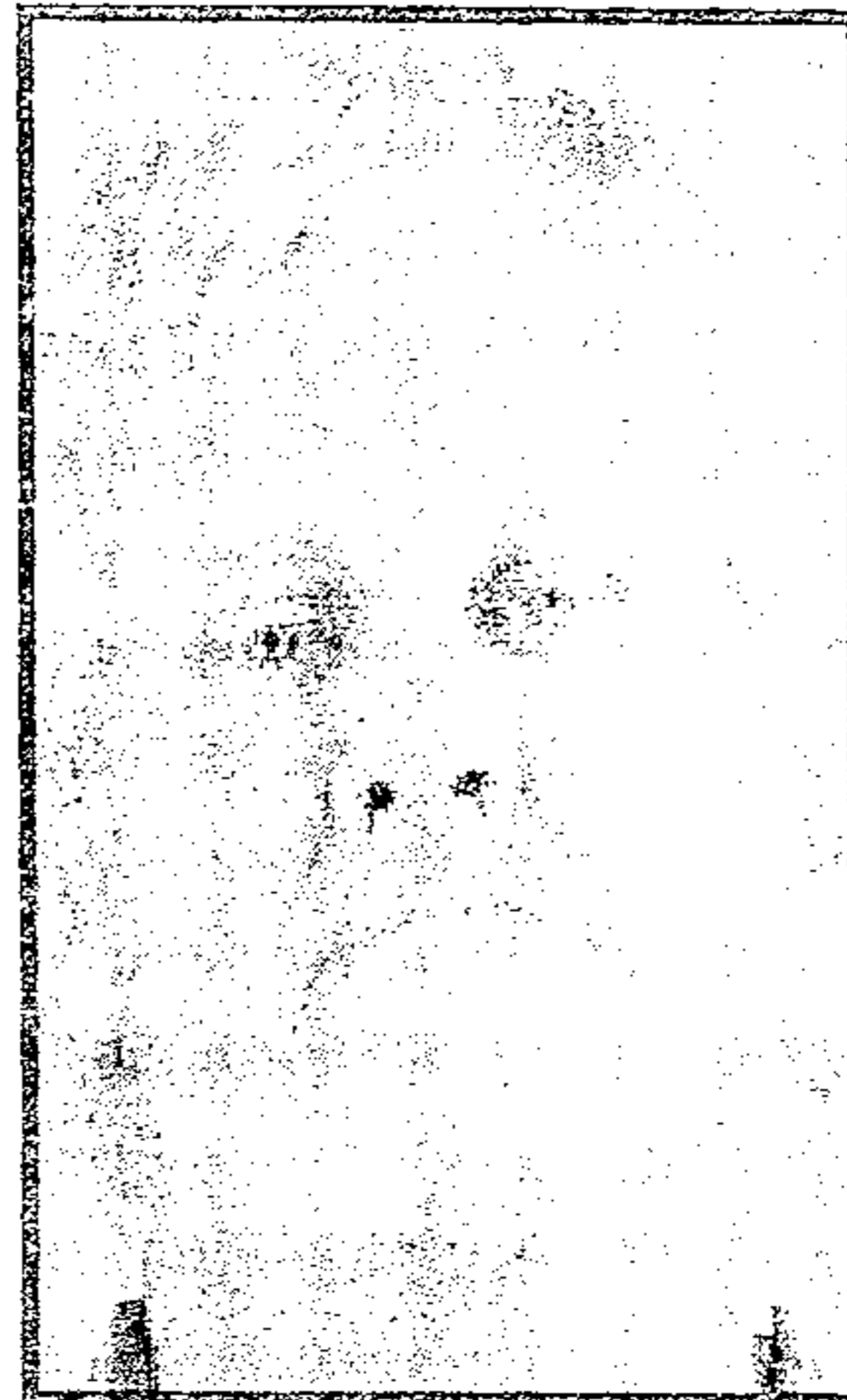

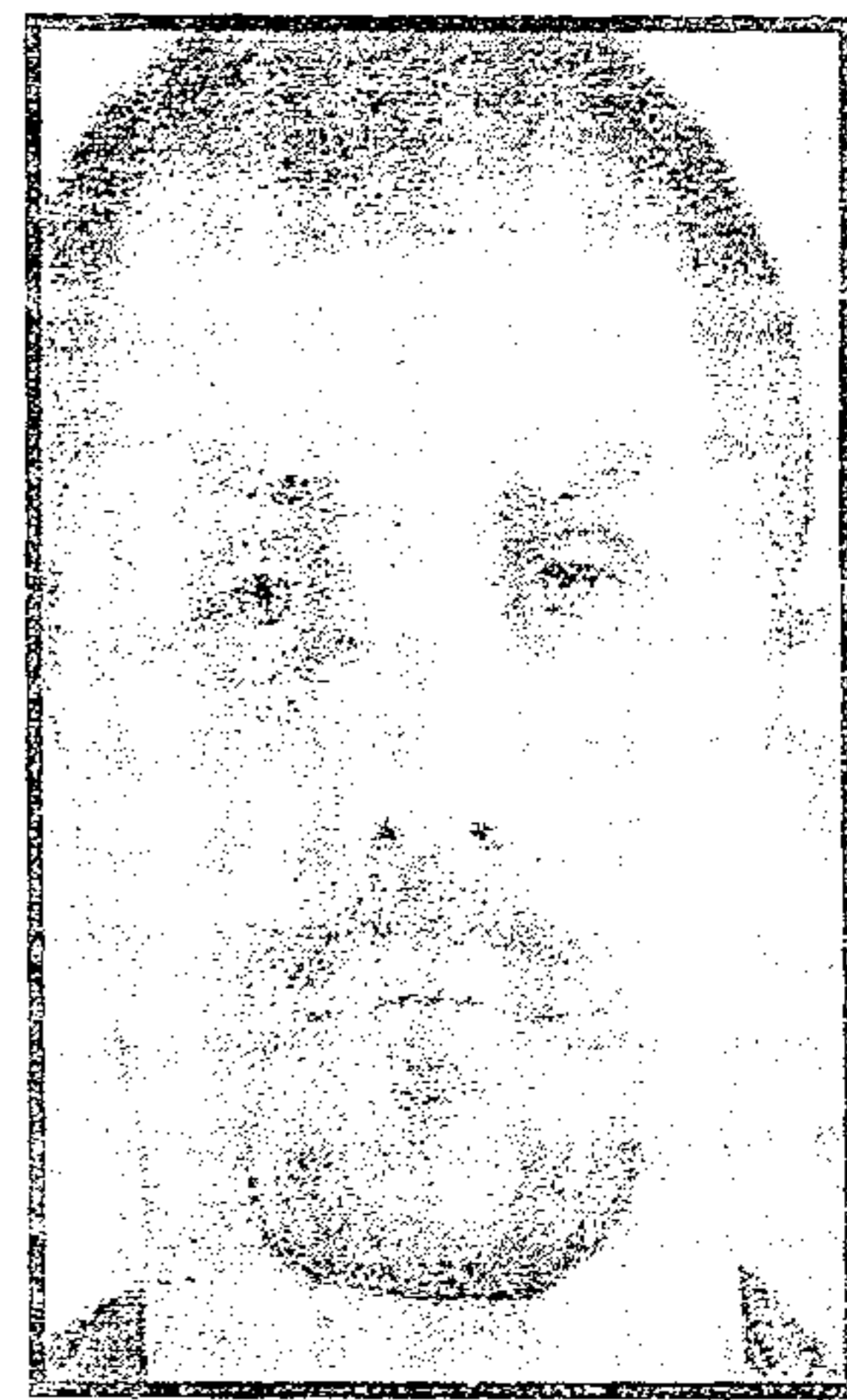

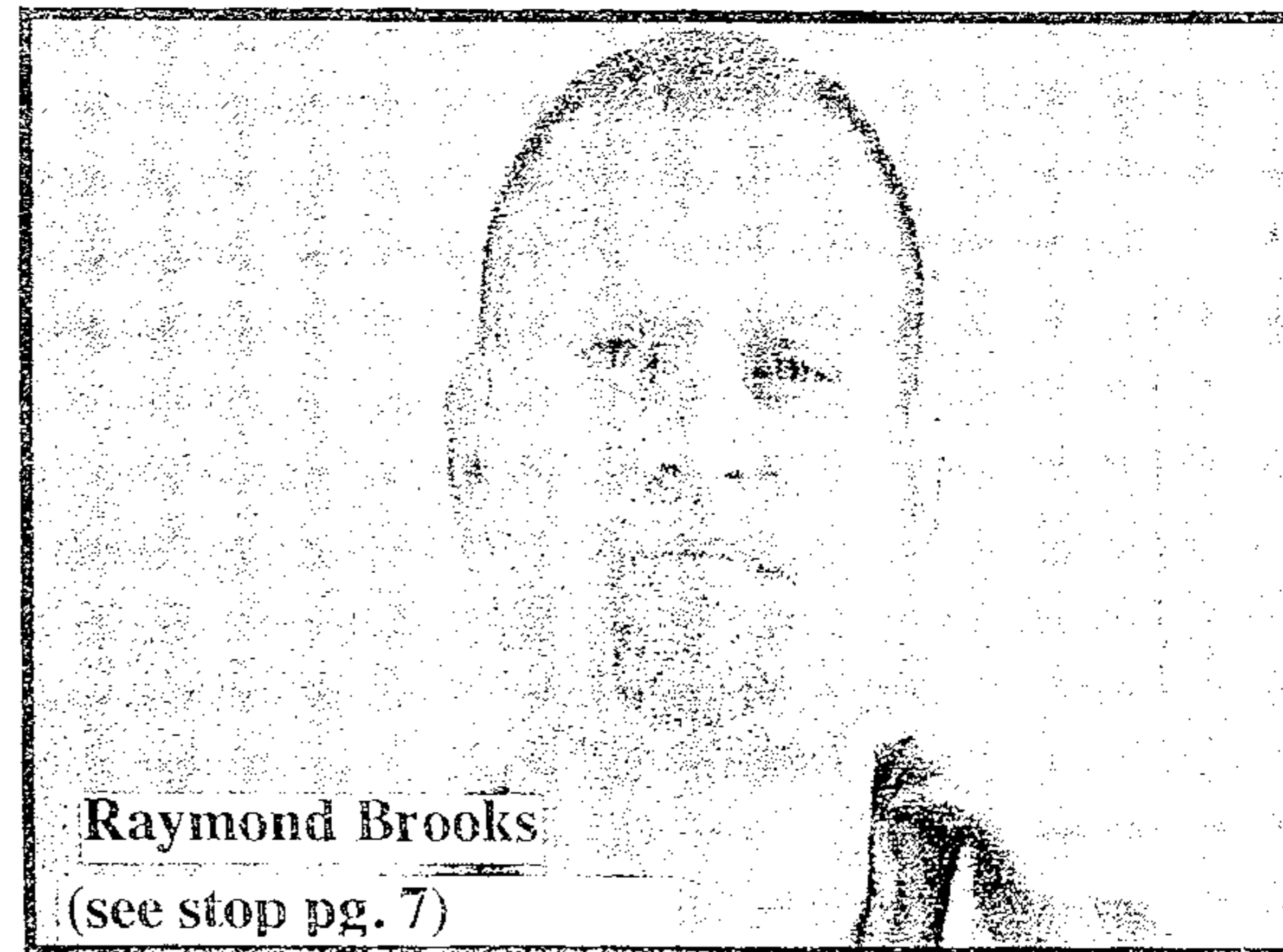
NC Couple sentenced for government contract fraud

On Oct. 3, 2016, Ricky Anthony Lanier, 49, and his wife Katrina Reshina Lanier, 43, both of La-Grange, N.C., were sentenced to serve federal prison terms of 48 months and 30 months, respectively, for conspiracy to commit wire fraud, wire fraud, and major fraud against the United States. The couple were found guilty of these offenses on Dec. 17, 2015, following a 13-day jury trial in U.S. District Court.

According to evidence presented at trial, the Laniers conspired

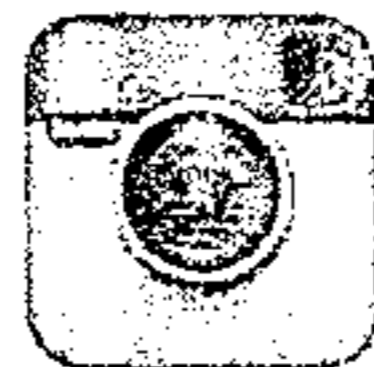

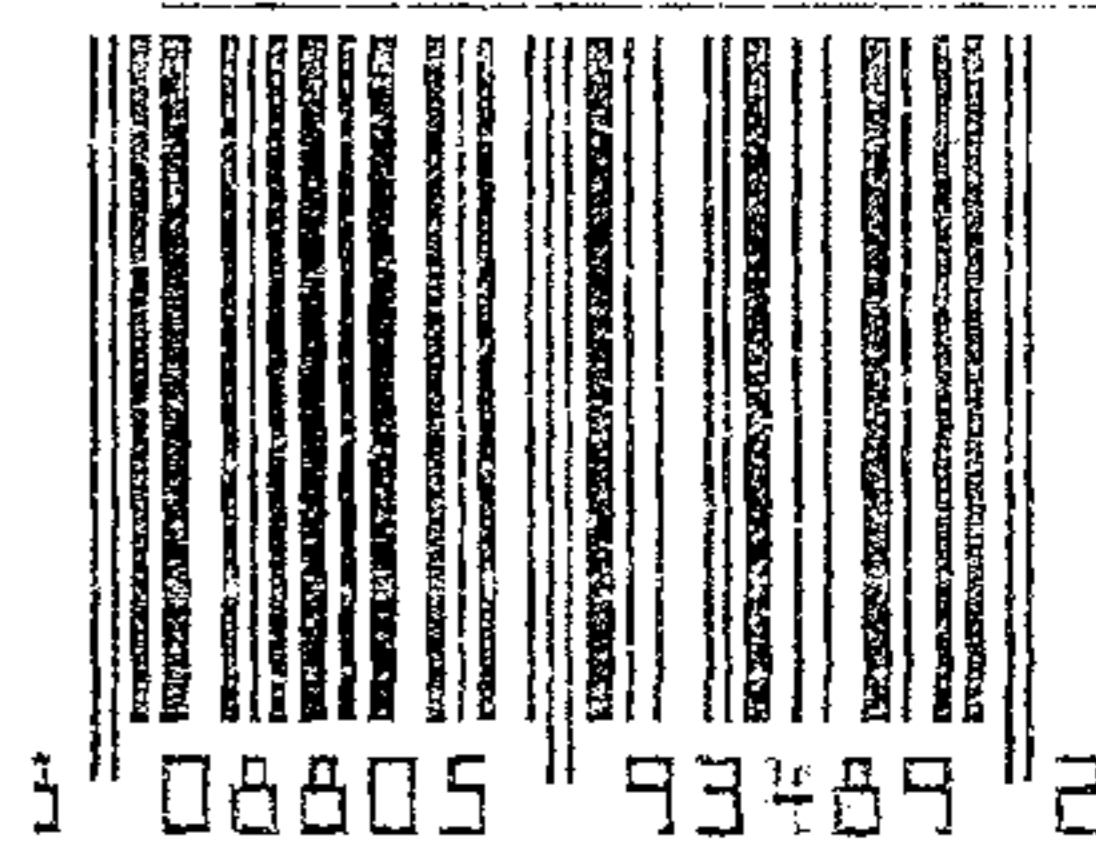

 from November 2005 to April 2013 to defraud the United States government through a scheme to fraudulently obtain federal contracts intended to be awarded to businesses lawfully participating in the Department of Veterans Affairs' (VA) Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) program and the Small Business Administration's (SBA) 8(a) Business Development program. They falsely represented that JMR Investments was eligible as an 8(a) business and Kylee Construction was eligible as an SDVOSB and an 8(a) business.

Ricky Lanier, who had previously owned and operated an 8(a) business receiving government contracts,

became ineligible to participate in the 8(a) program after that business graduated from that program in 2008. Lanier used a friend and service-disabled veteran as the purported owner of Kylee Construction, representing that the friend was involved in the daily management of the business, even while the friend was working for a government contractor in Afghanistan. The Laniers used a business owned by Ricky Lanier's college roommate, JMR Investments, as a front to obtain construction contracts from the National Park Service and other federal agencies under the 8(a) program, misrepresenting the friend's involvement in the management and operation

of the business. The scheme also involved sub-contracting out all or almost all of the work on the contracts in violation of program requirements.

Ricky Lanier also defrauded the National Park Service in connection with a contract to replace a wastewater treatment facility at the Tremont Institute in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, falsely representing subcontractor costs by over \$400,000, resulting in the award of a \$1.1 million contract for work on the

project that was actually performed by a subcontractor for only \$550,000. Lanier also fraudulently obtained a \$1.3 million construction contract at the James H. Quillen VA Medical Center which had been set aside for SDVOSBs.

As a result of the false representations, Kylee Construction was awarded over \$5 million in government contracts and JMR Investments was awarded over \$9 million in government contracts. The Laniers received almost \$2 million in

financial benefit from the scheme, using accounts of the shell companies for payment of personal expenses.

Law enforcement agencies participating in the joint investigation which led to indictment and subsequent conviction of Ricky and Katrina Lanier included the VA-Office of Inspector General (OIG), SBA-OIG; and Department of the Interior, OIG, with assistance from the U.S. Secret Service. Former Assistant U.S. Attorney Neil Smith

April Rymer, 43, Country Lane Lenoir City, was charged with Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, and Contraband in Penal Institution.

Deputy Lance Anderson LCSO, along with Deputy Malone, observed a black 1998 Lexus ES 300 fail to come to a complete stop at a posted stop sign on Jones Rd. @

Hwy. 321 N. Upon traffic stop Deputy made contact with the driver, April Rymer. Dispatch advised Ms. Rymer's TN drivers license was suspended for driving while suspended (04/25/16). The driver was taken into custody and transported to the jail without incident. Citation # 14451 was issued. Malones towed the vehicle.

Upon entry into the jail Correction officer

Bevins discovered a medicine bottle containing 19 whole and 4 half orange oval pills with imprints b 973 on one side and 20 on the other, in a small lunch cooler that was brought in with the driver. The pills are believe to be Amphetamine and dextroamphetamine 20mg, which is schedule 2 narcotic. Ms. Rymer stated the pills were Adderall and she did not have a pre-

scription for them. The pill were place in evidence for analysis. All occurred in Loudon County, TN.

some Syringes. Mr. Moser retrieved 3 Syringes from the driver side change compartment and 2 syringes from the middle cup holder area. Deputy asked Mr. Jones if he had anything illegal on

him and he stated no. He then pulled rolling papers from his jean pocket and stated he used them to roll a Marijuana Cigarette earlier in the morning.

Upon searching the vehicle found in a backpack in the back seat were a Silver canister with brown powder residue, a tin can with three baggies, and 2 syringes.

Mr. Moser stated the backpack and the items belonged to him. Found under the passenger seat in a L&M cigarette pack were five baggies with white powder residue and 1 baggies with Crystal Meth (.3). Mr. Jones and Mr. Moser were taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County jail. This did happen in Loudon County

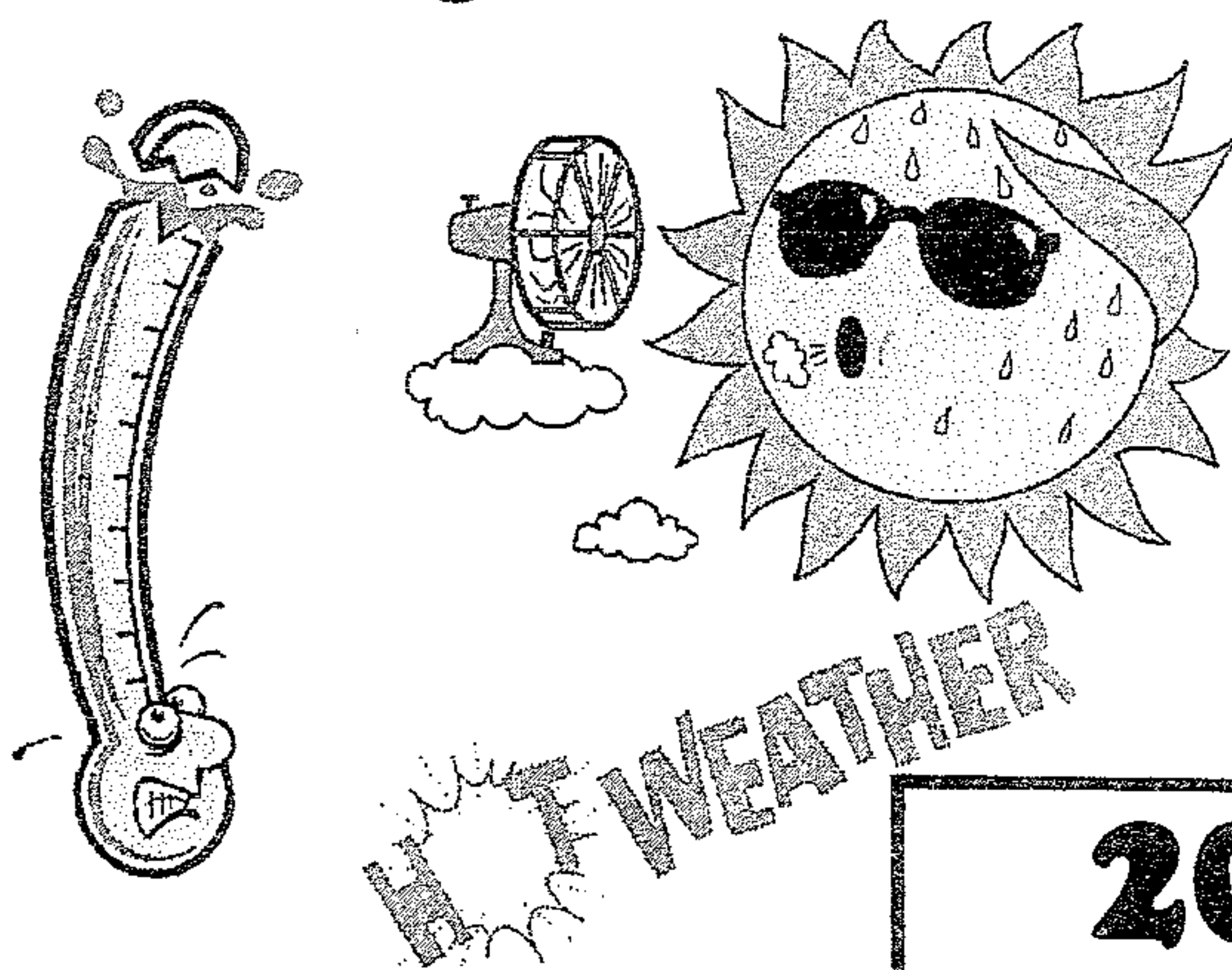

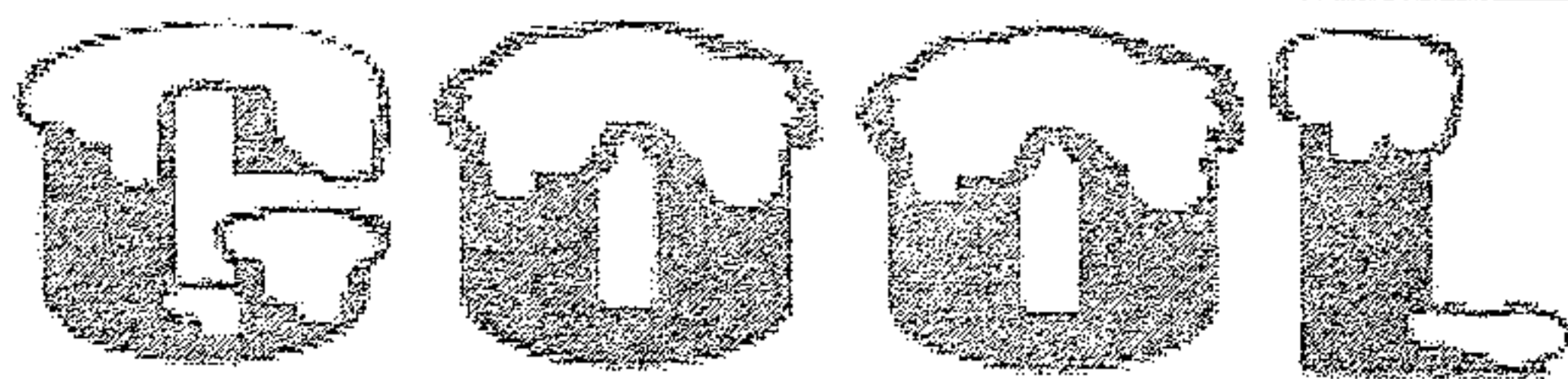

senger as Jennifer Bahr and the back seat passenger as Joel Lynn. Ms.McIntosh did not live on Cemetery Rd. and all the occupants were acting nervous and they had different stories about their travel plans. Ms.McIntosh also advised me that her license was suspended. Deputy asked Ms.McIntosh verbal consent to search her vehicle and she stated "Yes". Deputy asked Ms.Bahr to step out and then he asked Mr.Lynn to step out of the vehicle and Deputy noticed he was sitting on a bag that contained approx. .05 grams of Meth. Deputy searched the vehicle and in the glove

box there was approx. 2 grams of Meth in a makeup bag that had Ms.McIntosh's bank card with her name on it. Ms.McIntosh also said the bag was hers, but the Meth was not. In the trunk Deputy brought out some bags and Ms.Bahr stated that they belonged to her. The following items were in a makeup bag: 6 needles, 1 straw, 1 spoon, 1 bag of baggies, 2 strings bag of meth (less than .05 grams). Ms.Bahr stated to Officer Yates she had one Meth pipe in her bra. Deputy arrested all three subjects. Once we got to the jail Ms.Bahr was searched and she had 6.5 yellow pills in her private area. The pills

were identified as 2mg Alprazolam. Deputy returned to his car were Mr.Lynn was and Deputy noticed that he was reaching down the back of his pants. Deputy got him out and he had a closed fist that had approx. 2 grams of meth. There was also one meth pipe that was under the back of my seat were Ms.Bahr was sitting. These above actions occurred on a public roadway in Loudon County, Tn.
