Lots of questions remain in shootout at Bimbo's

There was an officer involved shooting in Lenoir City early Sunday morning (approximately 1:02 am EST) at the Bimbo's convenient store/restaurant/gas on Hwy 321 near the I-75 interchange involving a Lenoir City Police Officer and one deceased subject who was apparently shot by the officer multiple times. After being notified of the shooting by Lenoir City Police Chief Don White, the

9th District Attorney General Russell predicated the investigation of the incident to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation. The TBI responded immediately with a team of field agents and later with their Violent Crimes Response Team of forensic specialists to work the extend scene. The investigation of the scene continued until well after noon on Sunday.

The deceased sub-

ject is Joshua William Grubb W/M, dob 8-12-1985 of 321 Kentucky Avenue, Clinton, Tennessee. The next of kin has been notified by TBI.

The officer is Tyrel Lorenz W/M, dob 10-13-86 who has been with the Lenoir City Police Department since July of 2015 of and a law enforcement officer since 2010.

The incident resulted from a call into 911 from the Ruby Tues-

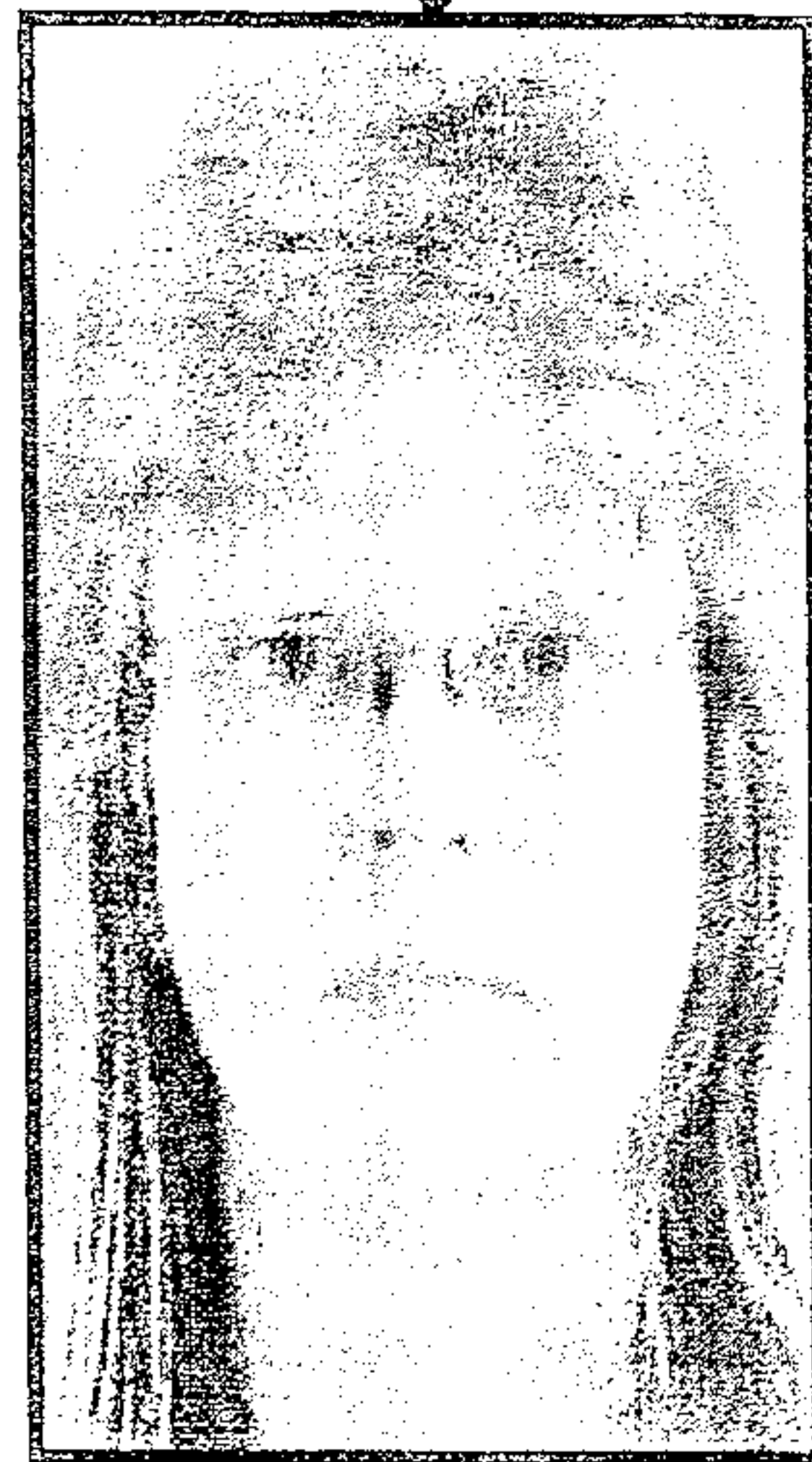

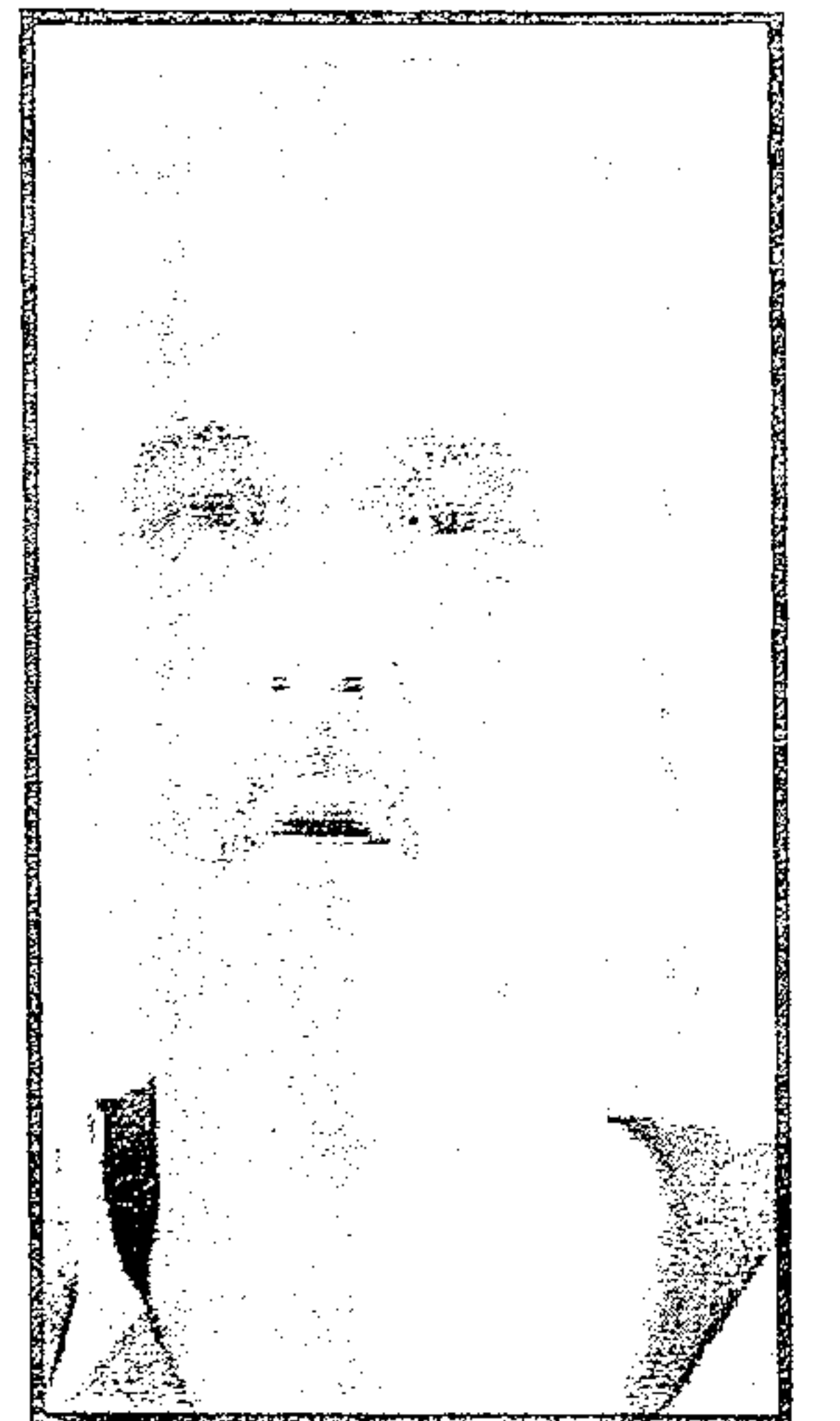

day's restaurant/bar located directly across Hwy 321 from the Bimbo's location regarding three individuals who had just left the Ruby Tuesday's parking lot in a pickup truck. Officer Lorenz was apparently questioning the three individuals in the truck who were getting gas at Bimbo's and

in fact, had placed one male individual in handcuffs when the driver began trying to drive off. Lorenz commanded the driver to stop several times before Lorenz somehow ended up in the back bed of the pickup truck. Once in the truck bed Lorenz was still yelling at the driver to stop. It was after Lorenz was in the

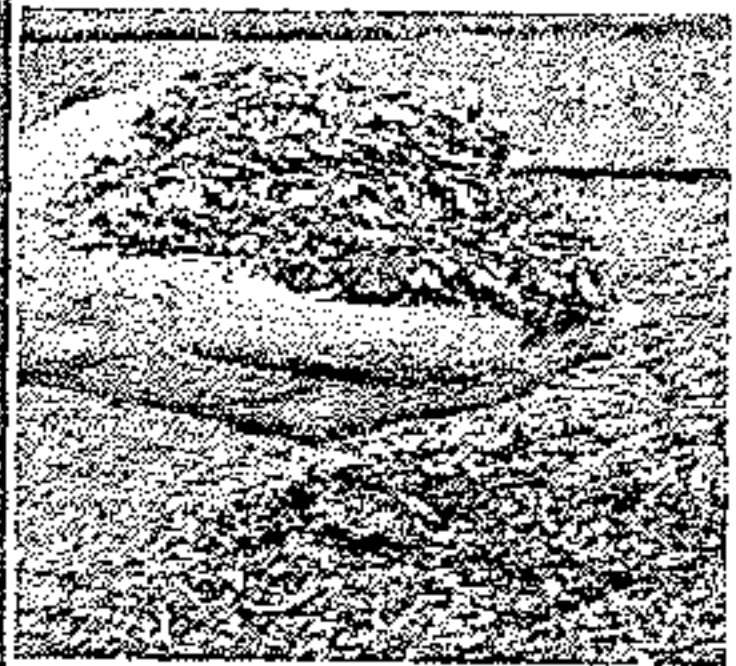
Deputy Cody Fritts LCSO, observed a Green Saturn car traveling on McCrary Street. The passenger in the vehicle did not have a seat belt on.

bed of the pickup and the truck was speeding away that Lorenz apparently shot the driver of the truck, Joshua Grubb, as it was entering Hwy 321. The truck travelled into oncoming traffic down the wrong side of Hwy 321 (a four-lane, median divided highway) where it travelled over the highway overpass

above I-75 and impacted a utility pole head-on less than a mile from the point of origin of the incident. Lorenz was apparently unharmed in the bed of the truck and immediately exited the vehicle to render aid to the driver was later pronounced deceased by EMS personnel who responded to the scene.

The other two indi-

viduals who were at the Bimbo's location with Joshua Grubb were Toni Ann Sutton W/F (dob 9-28-1975) of 1213 East Wolf Valley Road, Heiskell, Tennessee and Brandon Lawrence Taylor W/M (dob 10-30-1984) of 152 Barlow Road, Clinton, Tennessee. Sutton was charged by LCPD with possession of drug paraphernalia and Taylor was

charged with public intoxication and evading arrest.

Chief Don White says that Lorenz is on paid administrative leave pending the completion of the investigation. LCPD will be doing a critical incident debriefing with all officers who responded to the scene including Officer Lorenz later this week according to White.

The TBI investigation is ongoing (interviews are continuing, final autopsy results are pending, toxicology results are pending and a forensics analysis of the scene is not yet complete). The District Attorney is awaiting all of these results and is reviewing in car camera video, body camera video and video from Bimbo's. The present plan is to present the results of the TBI investigation to the next meeting of the Loudon County Grand Jury on Monday or Tuesday of April 11th or 12th. Therefore, since it is a pending investigation and to avoid tainting the Grand Jury's review of the case, no further information about the investigation will be released until after the Grand Jury has reviewed it

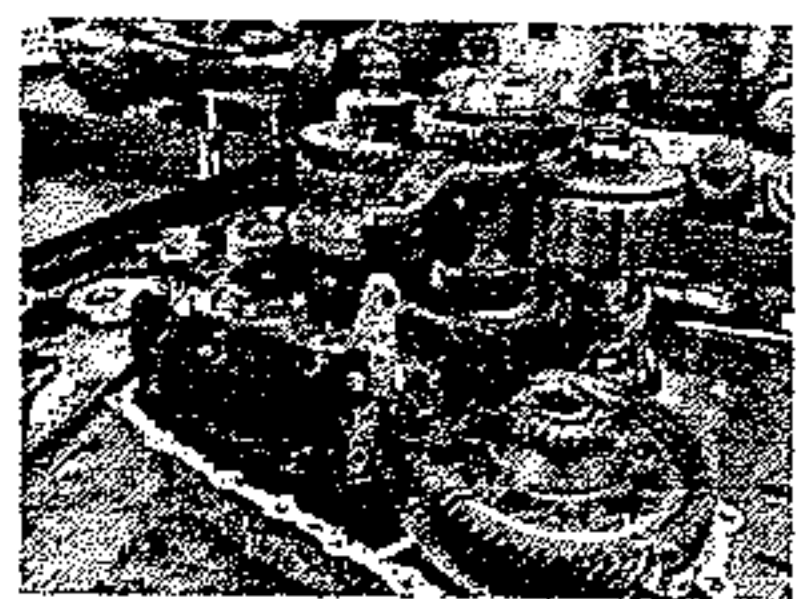

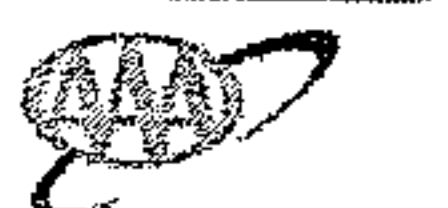

the driver. On talking with the driver identified as Selena Gribble, Deputy found out she had a suspended license.

On talking with her further Selena gave Deputy verbal consent to search her vehicle.

On searching the vehicle came across her wallet and found a corner of a baggy in it containing 6 round blue pills, identified as

Morphine Sulfate 15 mg. On further search of the vehicle found a note book in the passenger floor board with listings of pill counts and how much for how many pills and list of people and amounts to each.

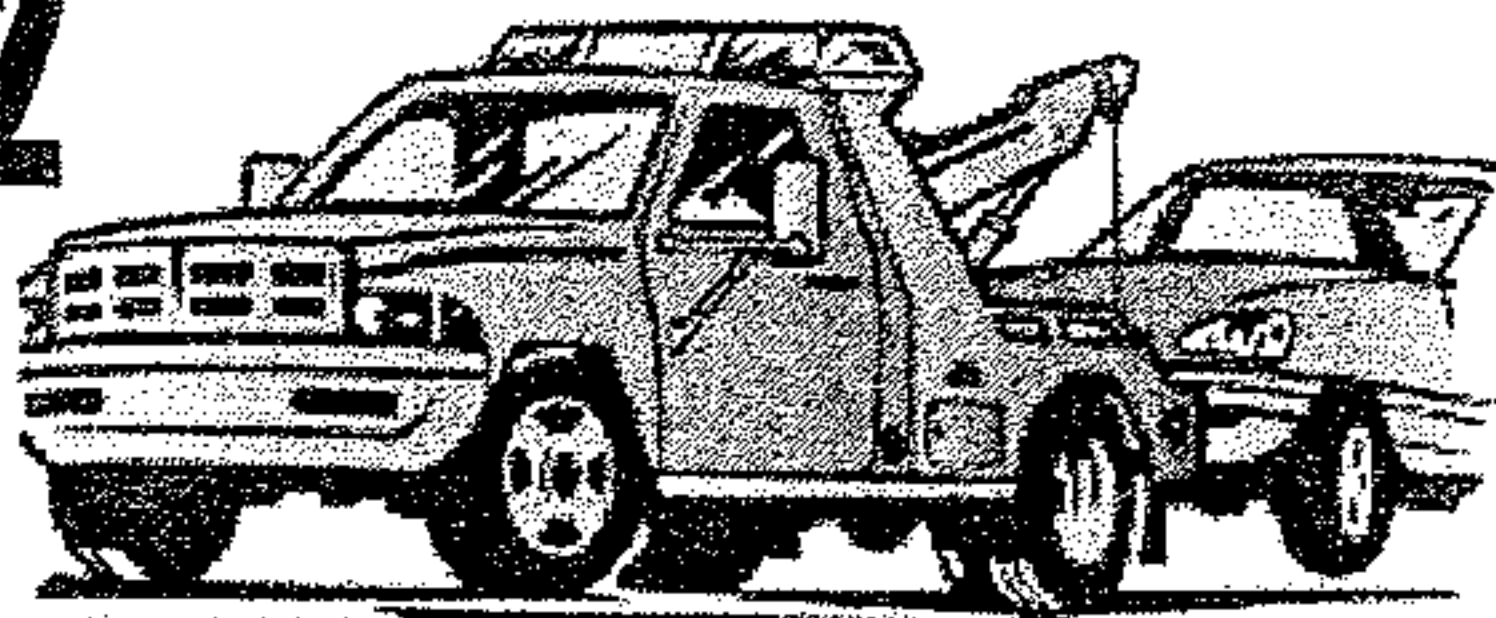

Veterans

Investigators found that Ms. Truss stole money that she collected from visitors and staff who pre-purchased meals from the Veterans' Home cafeteria. Ms. Truss admitted to taking some of the money for her personal use, falsifying accounting records, and destroying receipts.

Investigators identified Ms. Truss as a convicted felon on probation for a previous theft of property over \$60,000 in Hamilton County. While working at the Veterans' Home, she had an outstanding warrant

for her arrest because she had violated the conditions of her probation. Management was unaware of her criminal history, and is now using a different vendor for background checks.

Comptroller investigators also noted \$1,833 in questionable transactions related to residents' trust accounts which Ms. Truss assisted in maintaining.

prescription drugs that should have come to the home were missing. Just prior to Ms. Truss' resignation in August 2014, management found several opened and unopened mail pouches containing various prescription drugs located under her desk.

On March 9, 2016, Marilyn Truss was indicted by the Rutherford County Grand Jury on one count of theft under \$10,000 and one count of making false entries in books or records.

"Many of the problems noted in this investigation could have been prevented with stronger accounting

procedures and management oversight," said Comptroller Justin P. Wilson. "Our report also notes problems with the Veterans' Home purchasing process. I am pleased to see that management has taken steps toward correcting these deficiencies."
