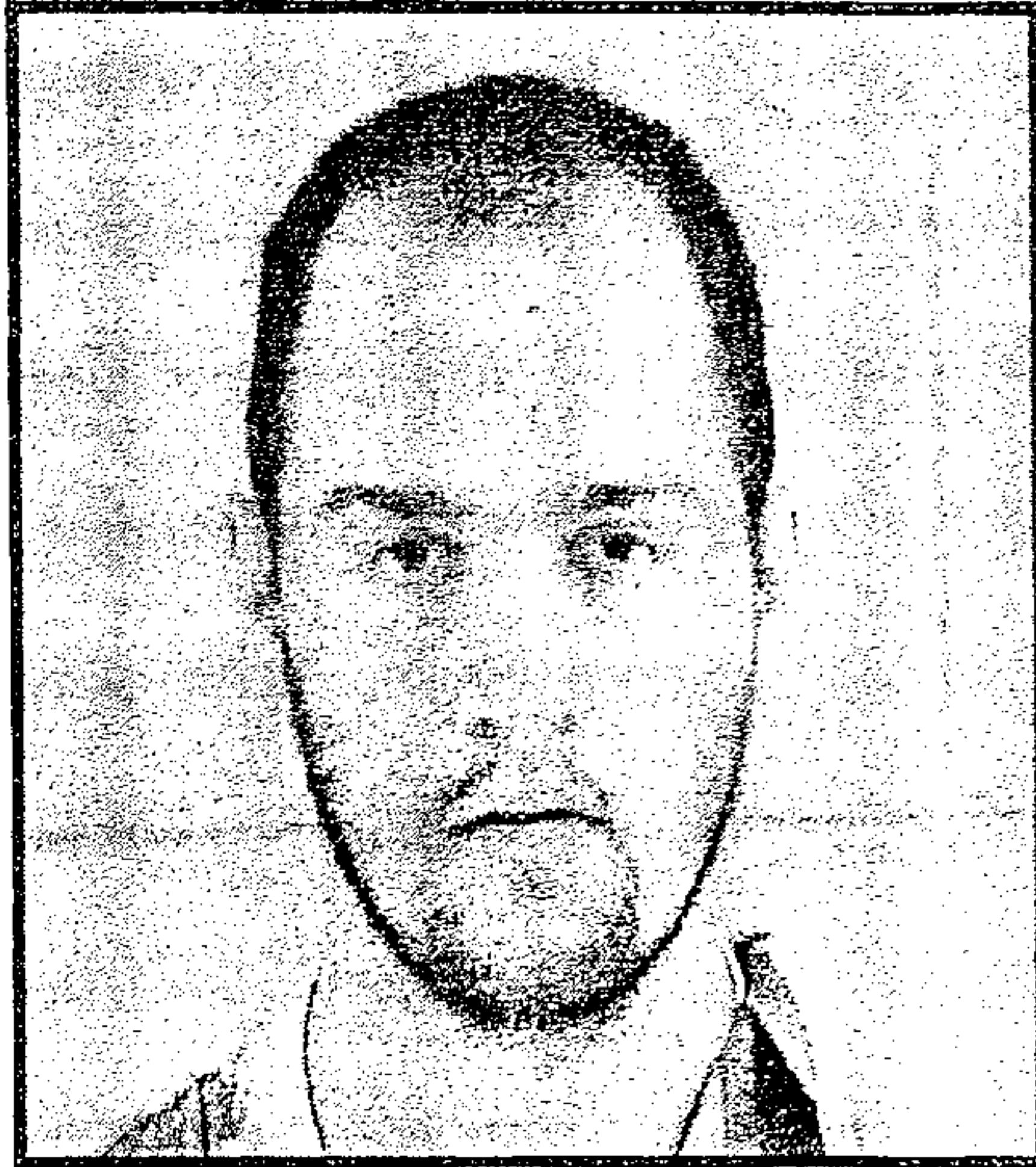
## Loudon Basketball Coach On His Way Out

small and ineffectual, they lift up the other and contribute to the common good. Amen.




