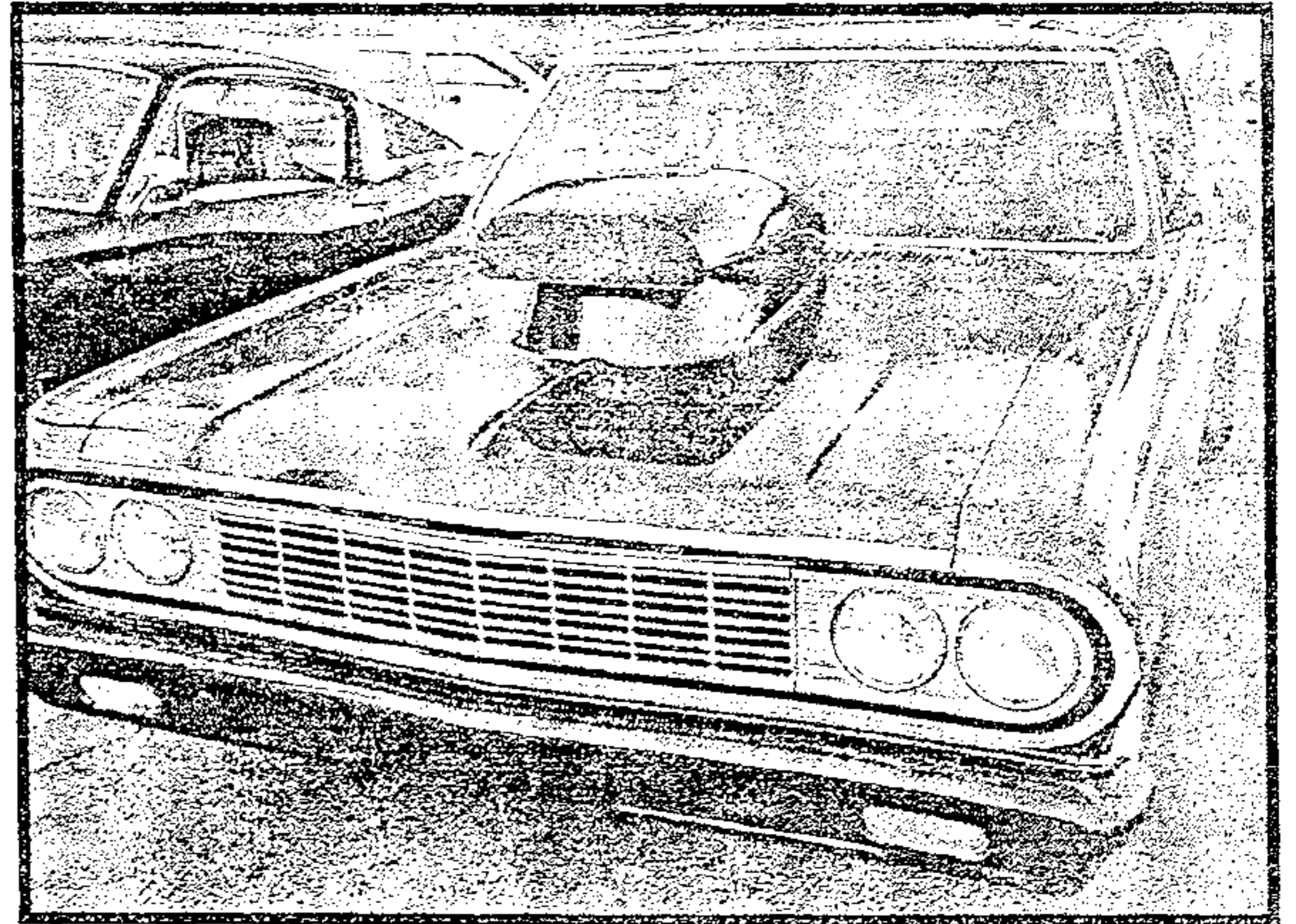

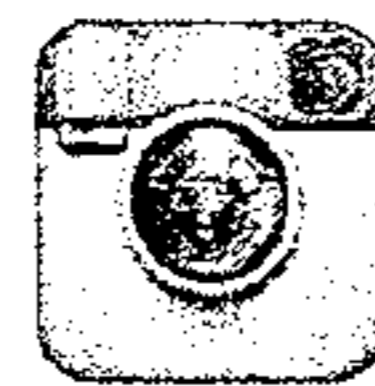

away, but quickly taken into custody.


Deputy then located multiple small bag and one baggie with crystal meth 2.0 grams. Deputy Kevin Dailey LCSO, made the arrest.

Spring into Summer Learning: Brain-Building Activities for Your Child

Visit zoos and museums, or go on a hike. Turn these adventures into brain-building activities by asking questions and discussing what you see with your child.

Enroll children in a summer learning program, like a science or art camp. A good summer learning program will allow flexibility in your schedule and offer your

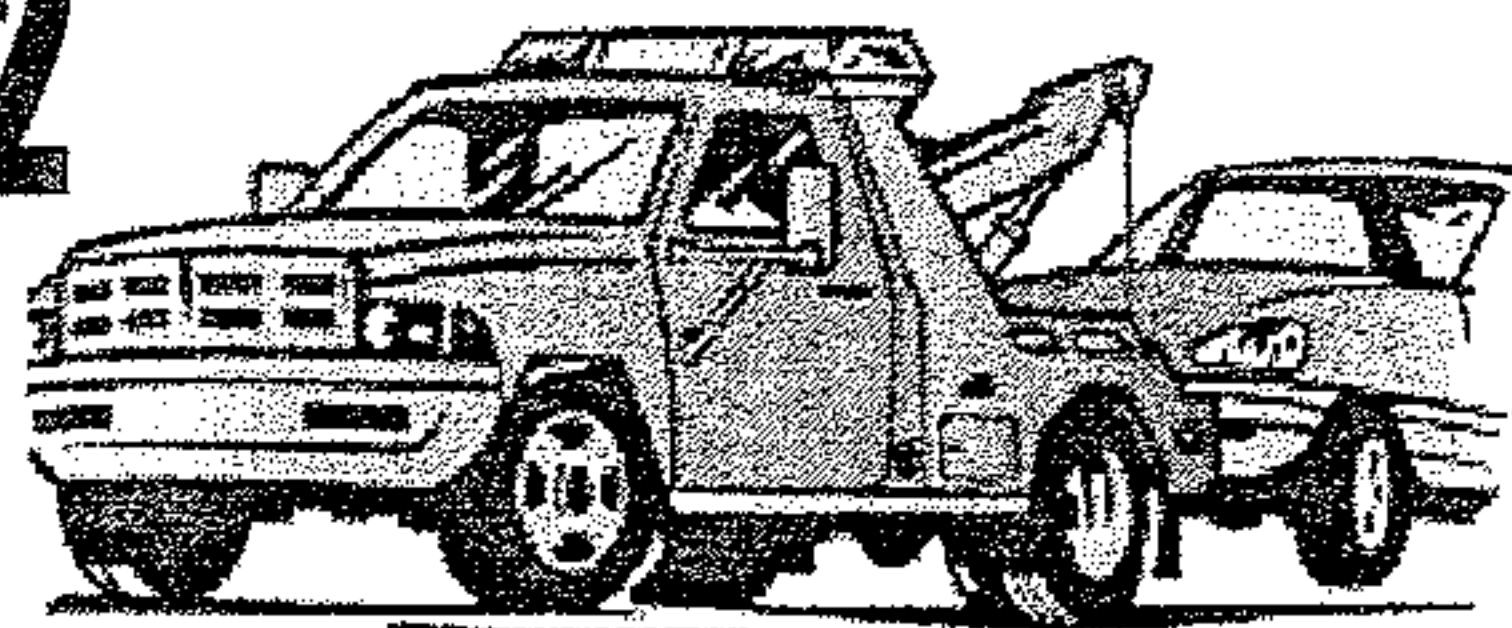

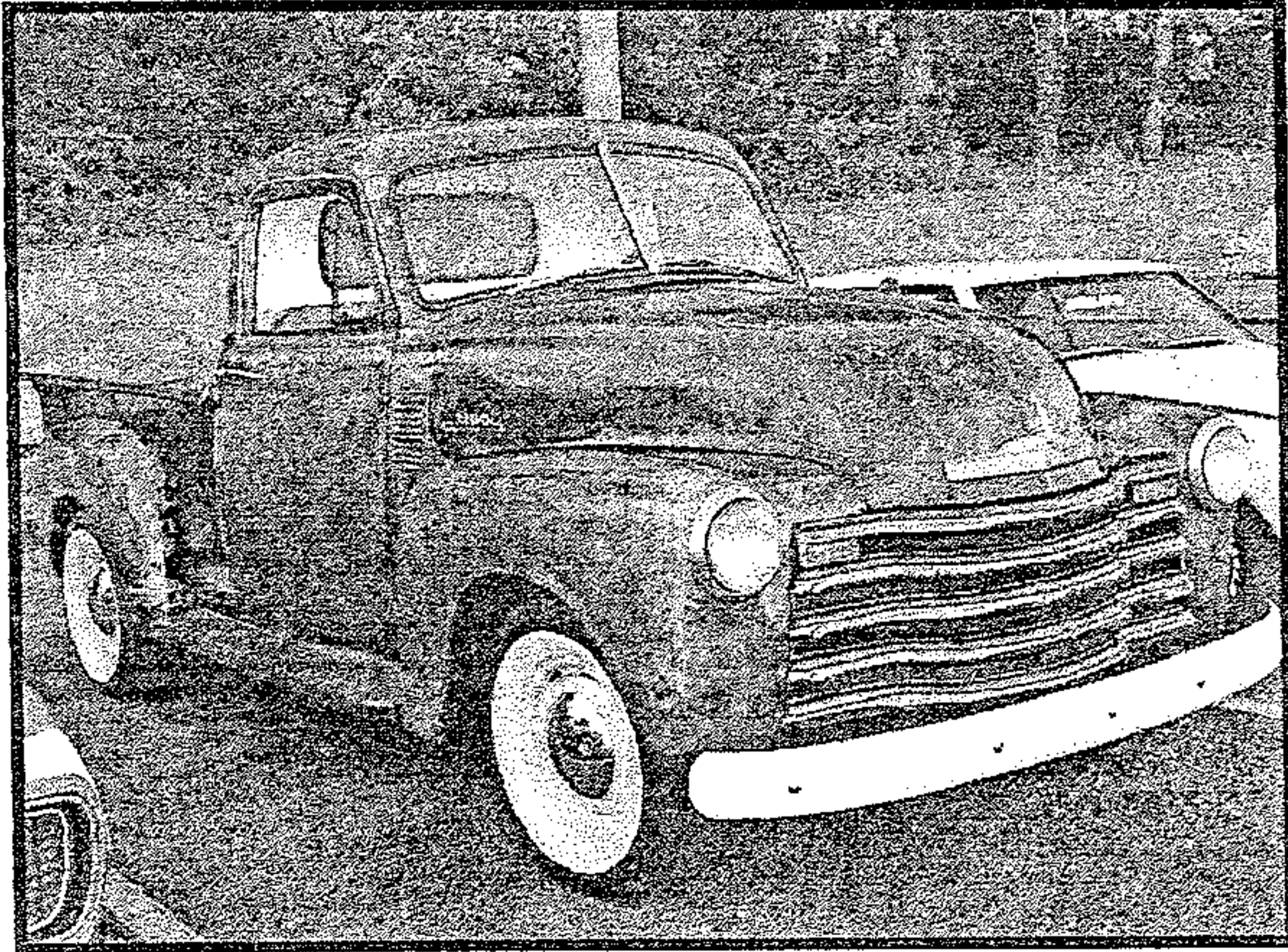

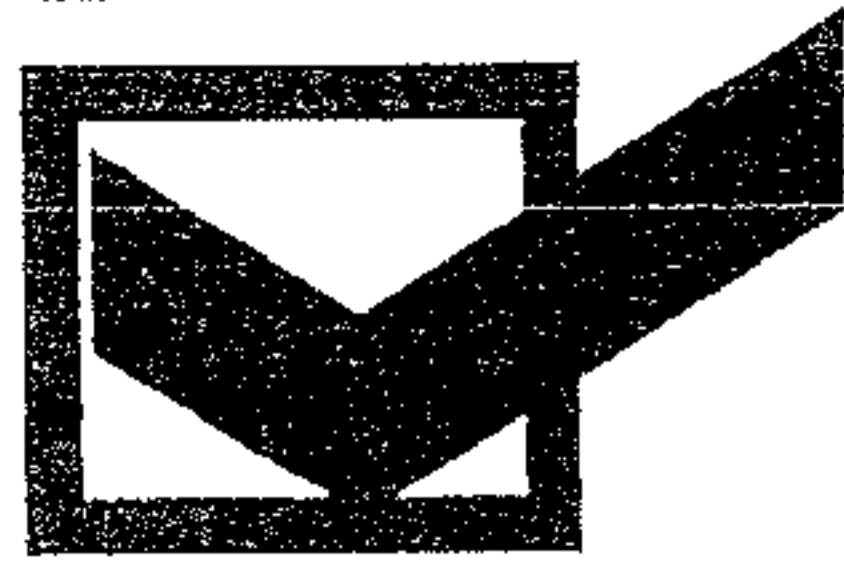
