
Ms. Forsythe was very nervous and shaky. Deputy asked Ms. Forsythe if she lived at the residence and she stated no. in Loudon County.

This initiative is part of Operation Wellspring (OWS), launched in 2013, and combines the efforts of the FBI and its state and local law enforcement partners to attack the threat of cybercrime by focusing on crimes such as internet fraud, which directly impact individual citizens across the nation.

There are currently ten FBI field offices that have Cyber Task Forces (CTFs) that participate in OWS to combat this growing crime. The CTFs connect state and local law enforcement officers and government offices with federal cyber investigative resources. Once the IC3 receives a complaint filed by a victim, the analysts uses this data to create intelligence documents targeting a threat within the area that a CTF covers. This information

The following FBI Divisions have Cyber Task Forces that are part of OWS: Albany, Buffalo, Kansas City, Knoxville, New Orleans, New York City, Phoenix, Oklahoma City, Salt Lake City, and San Diego.

The three major fraud types that were reported in 2015 were Business Email Compromise (BEC), Email Account Compromise (EAC), and ransomware.
