had all been drinking. Chris became irate when neighbor refused to buy him narcotics. The neighbor and other parties were all at the fire. They stated when Chris became angry, they returned home. A short time afterwards, Chris busted the windows out of neighbor's kitchen with a 4x4 piece of lumber and slashed the right side tires on neighbor Chevrolet Blazer with a knife. Chris also busted the windows out of his own ve-

hicle and his own kitchen windows. At some point while Chris was destroying property, he hit an object with a maul which caused it to bounce back striking him in the face which caused his injuries. Chris White was taken into custody on the scene then transported to the Loudon County Jail. Once at the Jail, Mr. White was taken to Ft. 

Lakin Norman, 24, Hwy 321 N Lenoir City, was charged with Domestic Assault.

Deputy Craig Brewer LCSO, responded to Friendship Road Lenoir City Tn. to a report of a disturbance. While in route we located Lakin Norman walking off friendship Road onto Highway 321. Found out that she was part of the disturbance from the Friendship Road. On Deputy going to the residence he found the victim there. On talking with him and his mother found that victim had met Norman in Lenoir City and took her to the Econo Lodge and got her a room. He was trying to leave and she jumped into the back of his truck and went to his mother's residence where he also resides. On getting to the residence she started trying to beat the windows out of his vehicle. She then has clawed his arms and neck and bit him on the body, cut

the seats up in his truck with a knife and threw a cooler and other items out of the vehicle. Norman then slammed her hand in the door of the truck and then left and was found walking down the roadway. Victim mother and another witness was on the scene during all of this at the residence. Both Parties have a relationship for the past few months. This did happen in Loudon County Tn.

Murder for Hire

Alaska Man Wanted Federal Agents Killed

Chris Guy Mannino, a former chiropractor and gun and explosives dealer who lived in Fairbanks, Alaska, had scores to settle—and murder was how he planned to settle them.

After a messy divorce that did not go his way—in part because he had filed for bankruptcy and was under felony indictment for weapons charges—Mannino hired a hit man to kill his wife's attorney. When the would-be killer turned out to be cooperating with the FBI, Mannino later hired a second individual to kill

the original hit man. And his murderous intentions didn't stop there.

"He had a hit list," said Special Agent Derik Stone, one of the investigators who worked the case from the FBI's Anchorage Division. That list included federal law enforcement personnel, including an FBI agent and two agents from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF).

"He wanted to kill the FBI agent, the main witness in the weapons case, and the individual he initially hired as a hit man," Stone said. "He also wanted to kill a bankruptcy attorney and both ATF agents who investi-

gated his case."

Instead, the 57-year-old Mannino is in prison, having been recently sentenced to a 17-year term on a number of charges related to the murder-for-hire plot. Mannino's problems began with financial issues. "He got in over his head and decided to file for bankruptcy," Stone said. "But he tried to hide assets, including guns, in his wife's name. And he also transferred an unregistered machine gun to another person without proper paperwork, which is a felony."

The one-time president of the Alaska Machine Gun Association was in-

Danny Gentry, 66, Stinnett Road Lenoir City, was charged with Domestic Assault.

Deputy Kenneth Palmer LCSO, was dispatched to a very heated domestic at Stinnett Road. Deputy was advised by dispatch that the victim was leaving the residence and going to the suspects fathers residence. Dispatch

advised that they could hear the suspect yelling at the female and was very upset. When Deputy arrived on scene he made contact with Mr. Danny Lynn Gentry. Deputy asked Mr. Gentry what was going on. Mr. Gentry stated that he and a girl that stays with him got into an argument because he would not cater to her. Mr. Gentry stated that she started yelling at him and giv-

ing him down the road. Mr. Gentry stated that he had enough so he told her to get out of his residence. Mr. Gentry stated that she then set down in a chair and refused to leave. Mr. Gentry stated that he then got upset because she would not leave so he tried to pull her out of the chair and put her out of his residence. Deputy C. Brewer responded to Avery Circle to make con-

tact with the female. Deputy C. Brewer advised me the victim stated that the suspect just went off on her and they began to argue. Deputy C. Brewer stated she told him that Mr. Gentry then tried to pull her out of the residence at which time he called 911 because he could not get her out. Deputy C. Brewer stated that he did observe red marks on victim arm where Mr. Gentry

tried to pull her out of the residence. Deputy C. Brewer stated that victim didn't want to cooperate and refused to write a statement. Mr. Gentry stated the female lived with him at time's and they had been in a ongoing relationship. Deputy determined Mr. Gentry to be the primary aggressor at which time he was placed under arrest of domestic assault.

dicted by a federal grand jury in August 2013 for a number of charges related to the unlawful possession and transfer of prohibited weapons, including a machine gun and silencers. In 2014, while awaiting trial on those charges and others related to his bankruptcy, Mannino hired a hit man to murder the attorney.

After the plan unraveled and he was in custody at the Fairbanks Correctional Center, Mannino attempted to hire another hit man—a fellow prisoner about to be released to a halfway house—to kill the original hit man and carry out the other murders. He told that individual where to find a cache of explosives, instructed him on how to shape explosive charges for maximum effect, and drew a map of the FBI office in Fairbanks. He made specific and gruesome requests. He wanted the hit man to travel to Tennessee, for example, to kill one of the ATF agents and then rig the graveside with a bomb so it would kill everyone else who came to the funeral.

Fortunately, the second would-be hit man contacted authorities.

Mannino was federally indicted again in 2015, this time for soliciting murder. After a four-day trial in February 2016, he was found guilty. Imposing his sentence in June,

a federal judge in Fairbanks noted the jury's conclusion that Mannino intended for the murders to actually occur, rather than his conduct simply being "jail house talk" between inmates as Mannino had contended.

"He was angry, and he was serious about the killings," Stone said. "He had the tools and capabilities to do what he said he was going to do."
