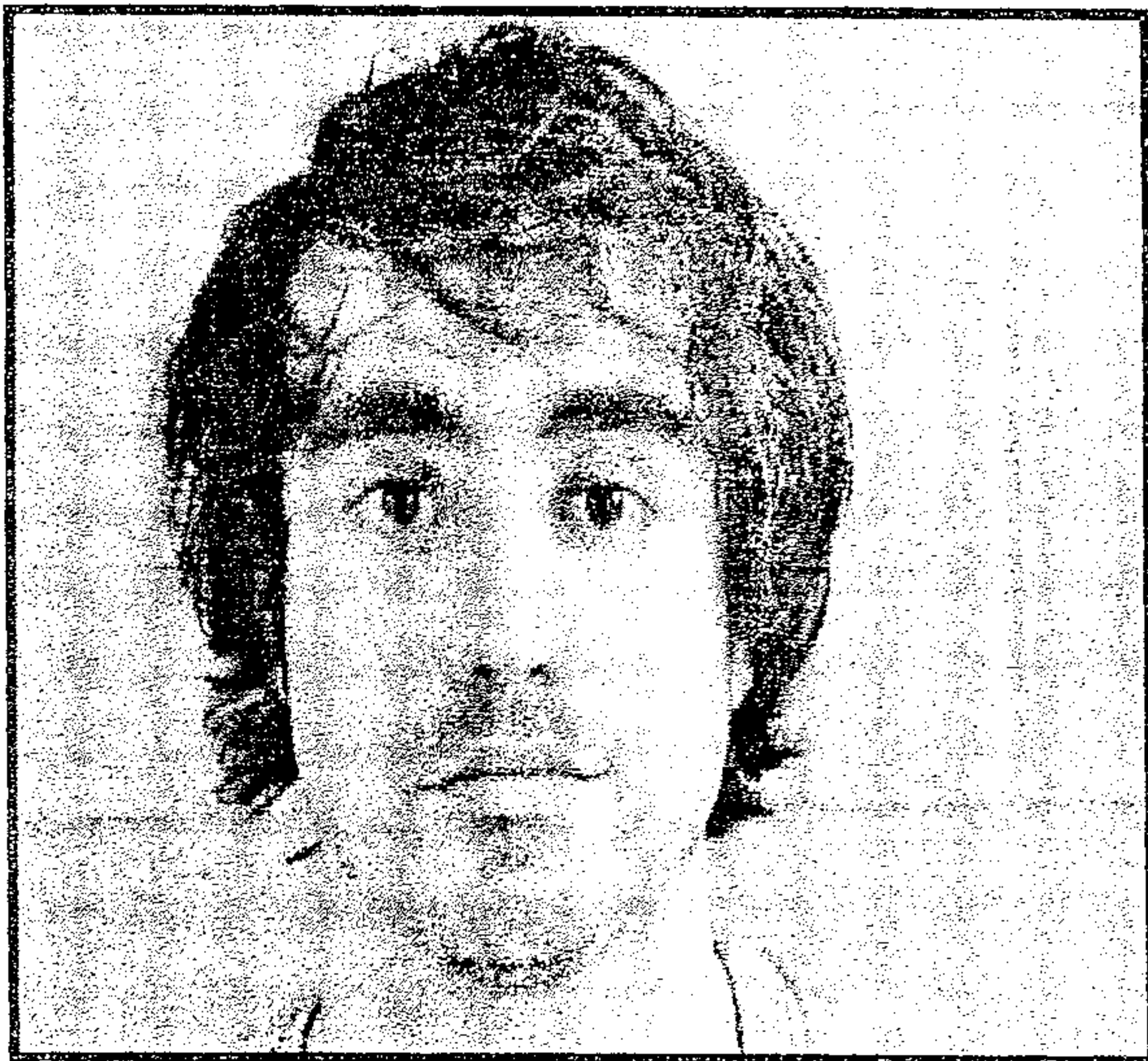

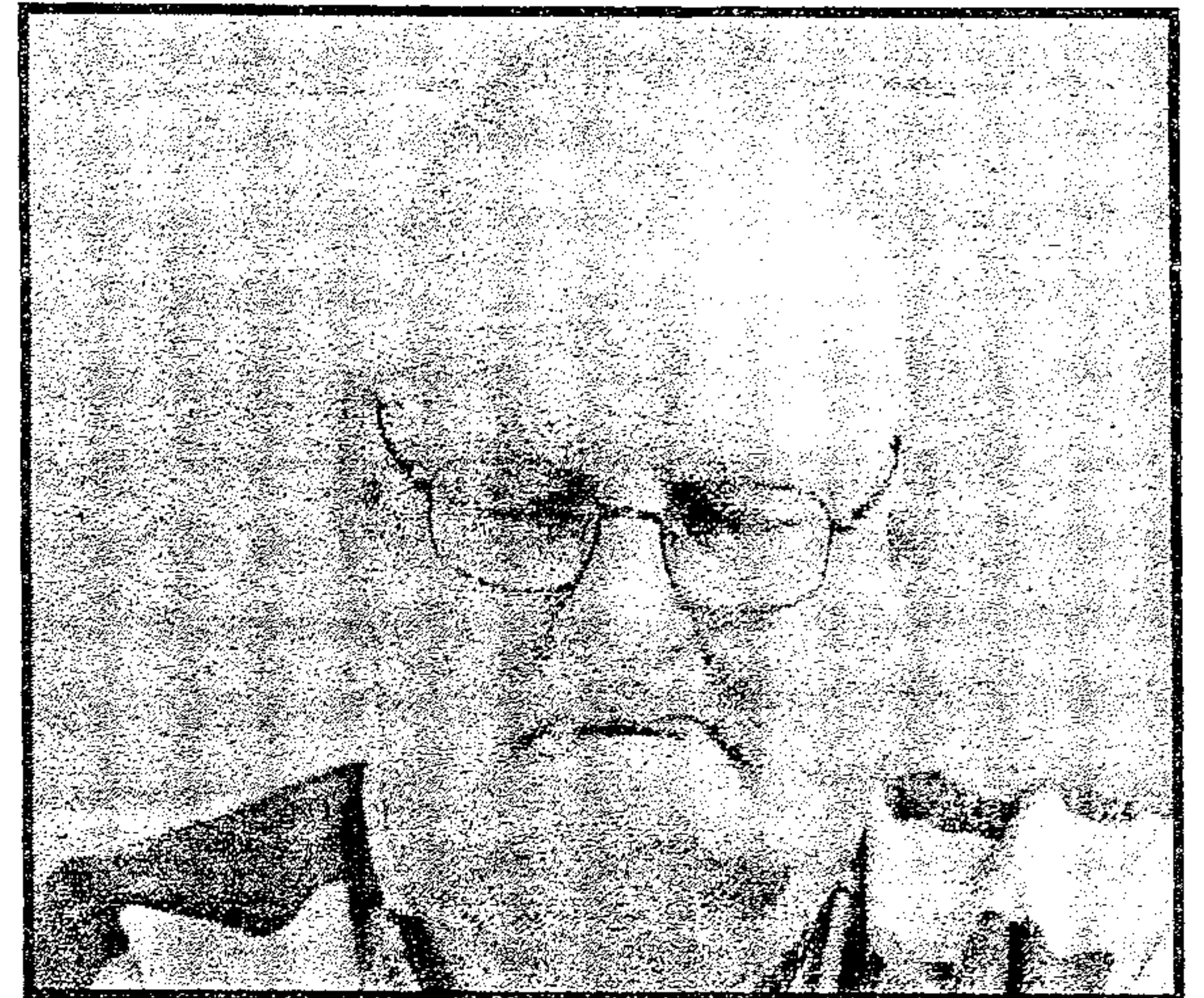

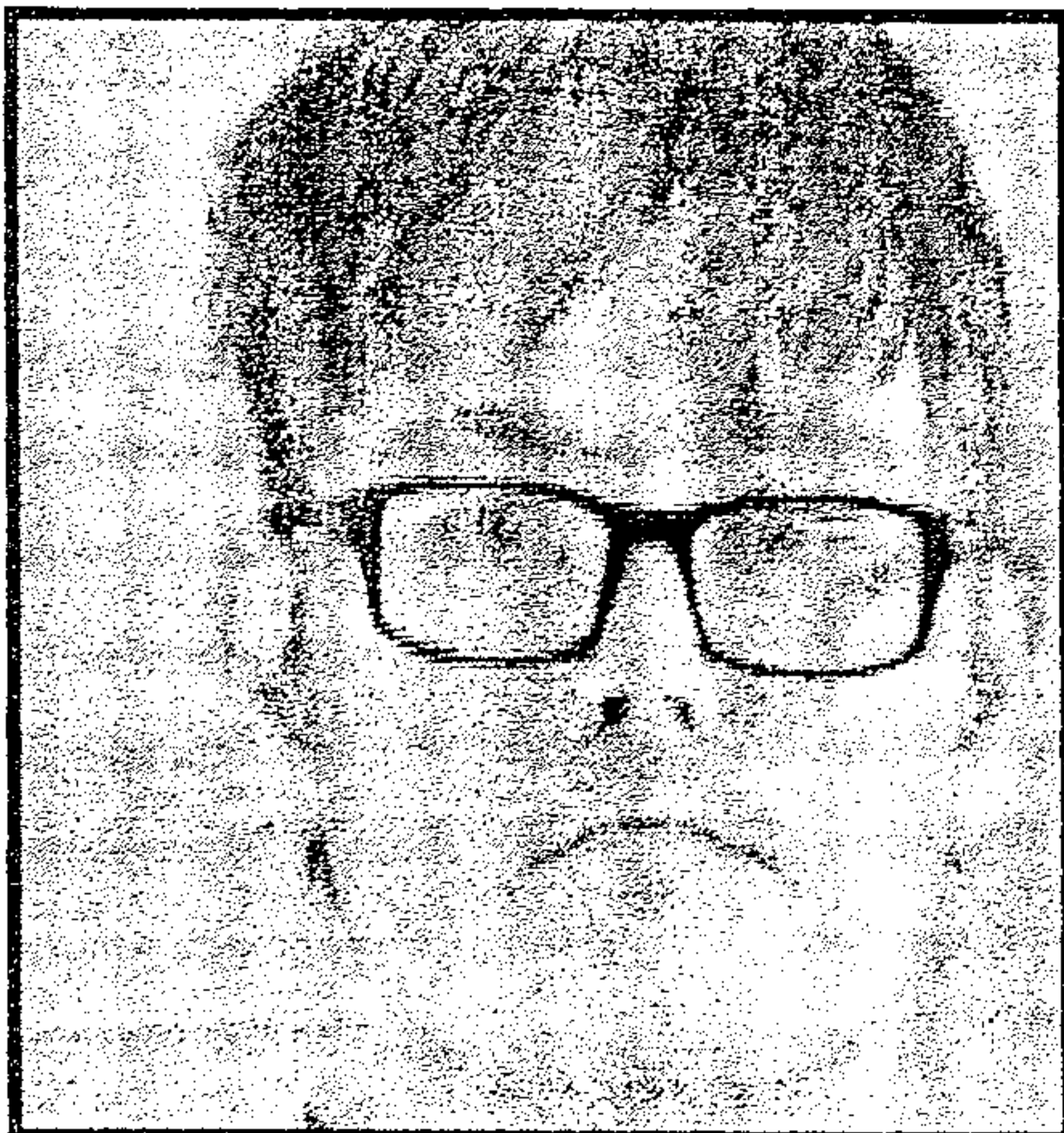

## Marshall County Solid Waste Department Hires Incarcerated Felon

Inmates Also Accessed Contraband and Worked on Private Property

An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has found numerous problems with the way inmate labor was handled within the Marshall County Solid Waste and Sheriff's Departments. Marshall County allowed jail inmates to work at the county's solid waste facility in Lewisburg.

Investigators determined the solid waste director hired an incarcerated felon as a full-time county employee at \$12.46 per hour. He

Officer Garry Kerley LPD, was dispatched to a residence located at Angel Row in Loudon concerning a domestic assault that was in progress outside at the residence. Upon arrival Officer spoke with Stephen D. Andrews, and 2 victims who were all involved in an argument that had become physical between the 3 (three) subjects.


All parties were separated and statements were taken. Officer did observe red marks and scratches on the chest and neck area of 1 victim while speaking with her at the residence. Mr. Andrews

did admit that he had assaulted victim during the conflict. Based on the physical marks and scratches on the victim and the statements given by both female subjects it was determined by officers that Stephen D. Andrews was the primary aggressor involved in this incident.


Officer then arrested subject and transported subject to Loudon County Jail and charged with domestic assault. This did occur in the City of Loudon.

received the same employee benefits as other county employees including health insurance, retirement, and sick leave. The inmate was paid a total of \$12,444.43 by the county.

The same inmate also performed seven days of work at the solid waste director's privately owned farm. At times, the inmate was left alone on the farm. Investigators noted the inmate was falsely signed out from the jail to work at the solid waste facility. The solid waste director also admitted to using inmates to deliver, set-up, and take-down equipment for local nonprofits. The director also used inmates to decorate his church for Christmas.

Comptroller investigators also found that inmates working at the solid waste facility were not properly supervised. This led to workers scavenging and hiding alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, cell phones, weapons, pornography, and other contra-

band items within the facility.

The Marshall County Sheriff discontinued the inmate work release program on January 15, 2016.

The Comptroller's 19-page investigative report includes 11 different findings, all of which have been reviewed with the district attorney general for the 17th Judicial District.

"This investigation raises numerous concerns including several instances where inmates were unsupervised or not accurately signed out for work," said Comptroller Justin P. Wilson. "While inmate work programs can be beneficial, it is important basic safeguards are put in place."

Sch 6. Deputy advised Mr. Estrada because he observed him stuff the baggy in his pocket he had probable cause to search his vehicle.

Deputy was advised by Deputy B. Smith that while he was at the vehicle he observed a baggy with pill's laying in the center console. Deputy did locate in the vehicle 2 blue pills with the imprint LMT 200 identified as Lamotrigine 200mg, a pink pill with the imprint 1111 identified

as Bupropion 200mg, 3 needles, 1.1 gram of methamphetamine, a spoon with drug residue, and a set of scales. Mr. Estrada was also charged poss of a legend drug X 2, poss of drug paraphernalia, and poss of Sch 2 for resale.

Mr. Estrada stated that he was having a panic attack in the back of my vehicle at which time Priority EMS responded to the scene. Mr. Estrada was transported from the stop location to the Fort

Loudoun Emergency Room. Mr. Estrada's vehicle was towed from the scene by Bivens Wrecker service.

This did occur in Loudon County TN.

Kevan Condra, 25, Museum Street Chattanooga, was charged with Simple Possession x2, DUI, Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, and Violation of Implied Consent.

Officer Benny Houser LPD, was dispatched to for a reckless driver exiting the interstate, a silver Toyota. Officer

made contact with the vehicle as it was pulling into the Shell parking lot. Officer then made contact with the driver Kevan Condra, and advised him why he had stopped him. Mr. Condra appeared to be impaired and couldn't sit still. Officer asked Mr. Condra for his license and he had a difficult time finding them.

Mr. Condra had what appeared to be a pill bottle sitting on his lap and he stated that it was a golf ball container. When Officer removed the lid there was a strong odor of marijuana coming from the bottle. Mr. Condra had a difficult time exiting the vehicle. Mr. Condra performed poorly on the field sobriety tests

he was given. After running Mr. Condra's license through the E911 center the status came back suspended. While inventorying the vehicle Officer discovered a plate with green plant like material believed to be marijuana. Officer also discovered a small plastic baggie in the door with small crystals in it which tested posi-

tive for methamphetamine. Officer then read Mr. Condra the implied consent and he refused. The above incident happened in the city of Loudon.

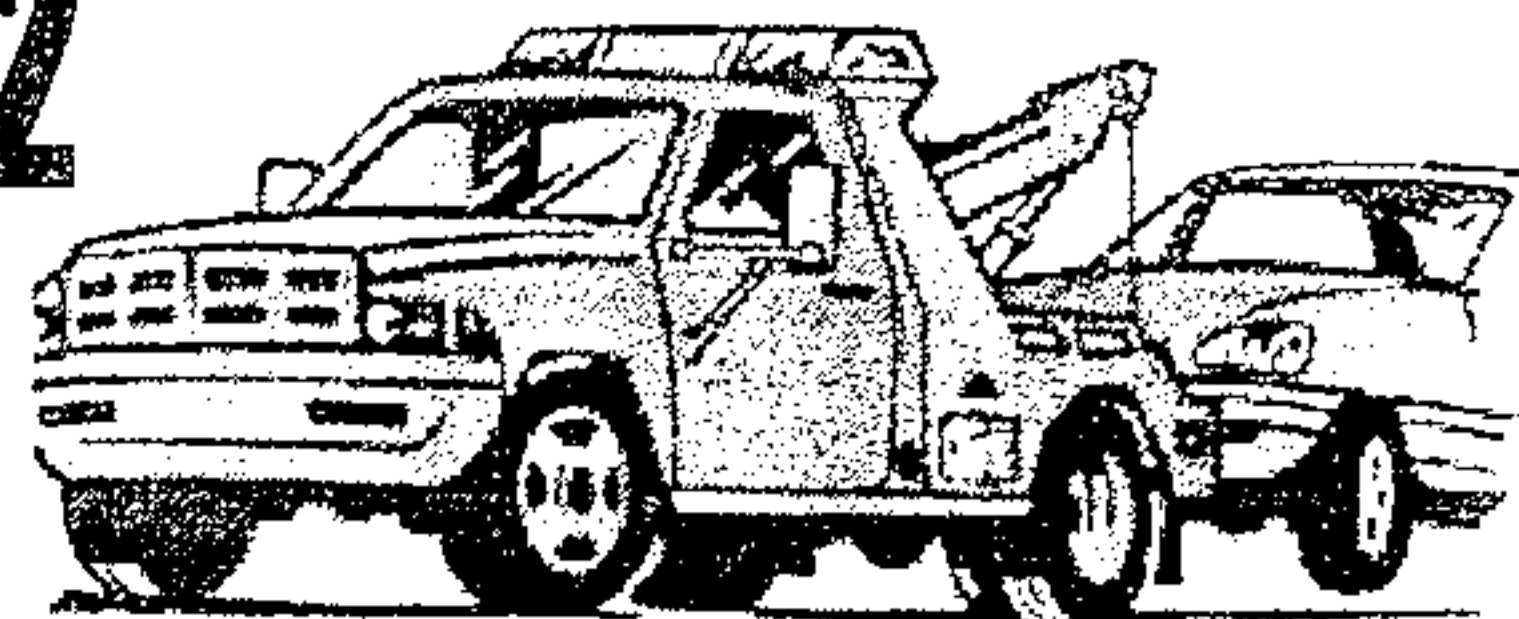
