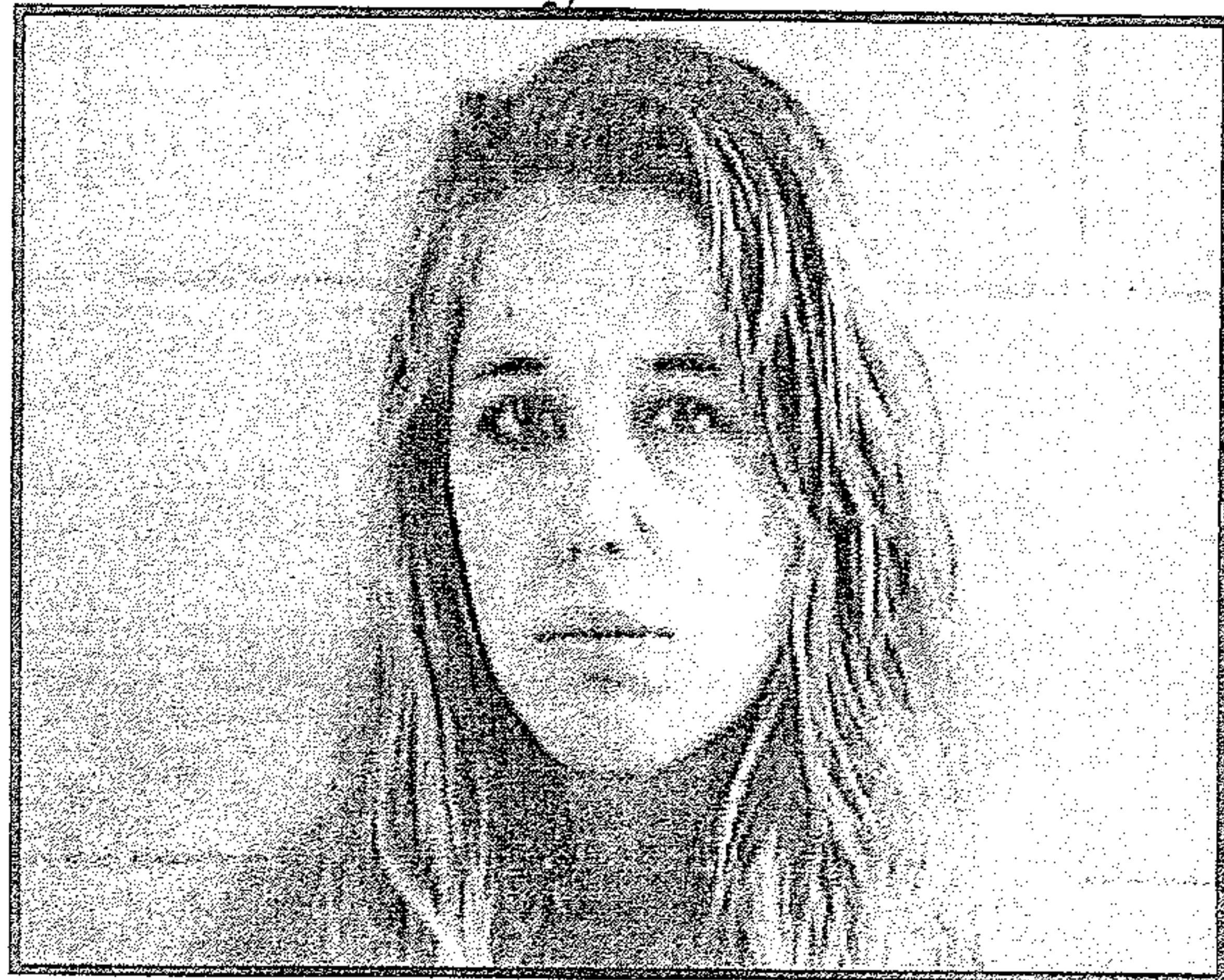

## Former Collierville Middle School Band Director Arrested for Theft

An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has resulted in the arrest of Jason Seek, the former Collierville Middle School band director, after investigators determined he stole at least \$133,064 from the band booster club.

The investigation began after Collierville Schools officials reported receiving suspi-

cious bank records from Jason Seek.

Investigators revealed that Seek used a variety of schemes to steal money from the band booster account over a five-year period from December 2011 through November 2016.

Seek withdrew cash, used the booster club's debit card, wrote checks, and transferred money from the boost-

On arrival Deputy located Jessica Osborne and a male in the roadway where they were detained. On going to the residence found that Jessica had gotten into it with her family and they were all arguing. Someone called her

Uncle to come over and help them. Jessica started arguing with the uncle and during this she pulled a black BB gun in the form of a pistol and started pointing it at him telling him to back up. She then hit him on the side of the head where it cut the side of his head. Jessica and her boy-

friend then left where Deputy found them on the roadway. On searching her bag we found a black BB Gun, several cut straws with white residue in them, two scales with mixed residue on them, several baggies with different types

er club account for his personal benefit. Investigators noted that most of the cash withdrawals coincided with trips to various gambling establishments around the country.

Additionally, Seek created at least 13 false bank statements in an attempt to conceal his theft. Seek also signed the name of a former band booster treasurer on checks and on a false financial report to the school.

Seek admitted to investigators that he used booster club money for personal expenses and created false documents. He resigned from his position at Collierville Schools on April 20, 2017.

On November 22, 2017, Jason Seek was arrested on a charge of theft of property over \$60,000.

"Booster clubs are required by law to adopt procedures for safeguarding money, but many organizations have failed to do so," said Comptroller Justin P. Wilson. "For most of the five-year period, the former band director was the only person who handled the booster club's money. When one person has total control, it invites the possibility of wrongdoing."
