Scripture: Matthew 5:21-37

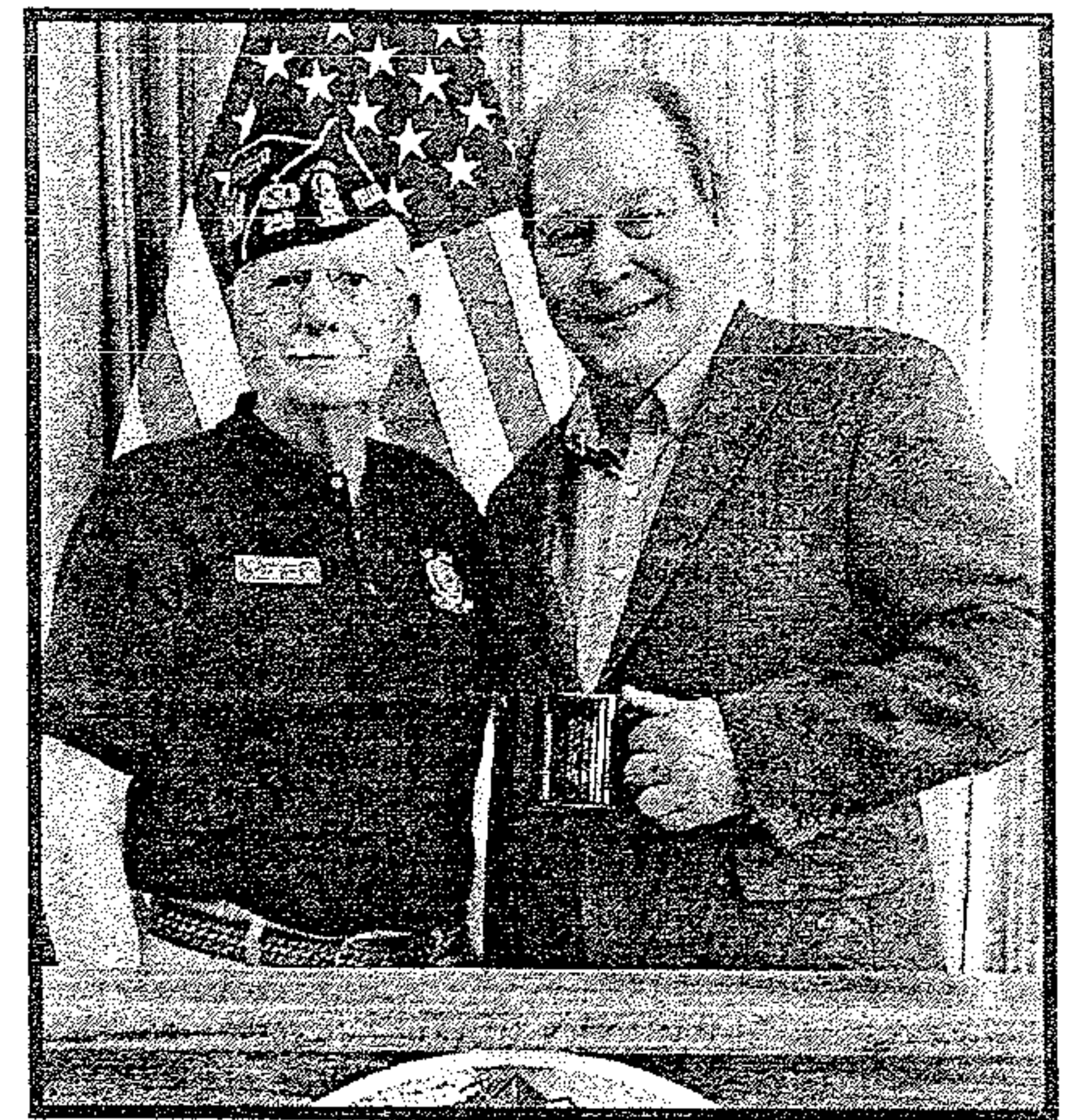

Anger, lust, divorce

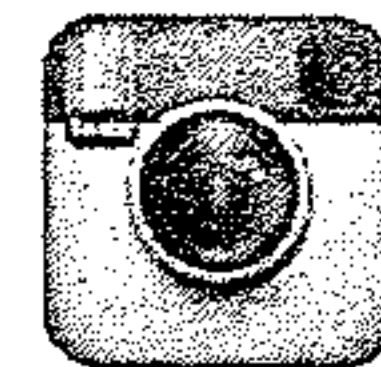

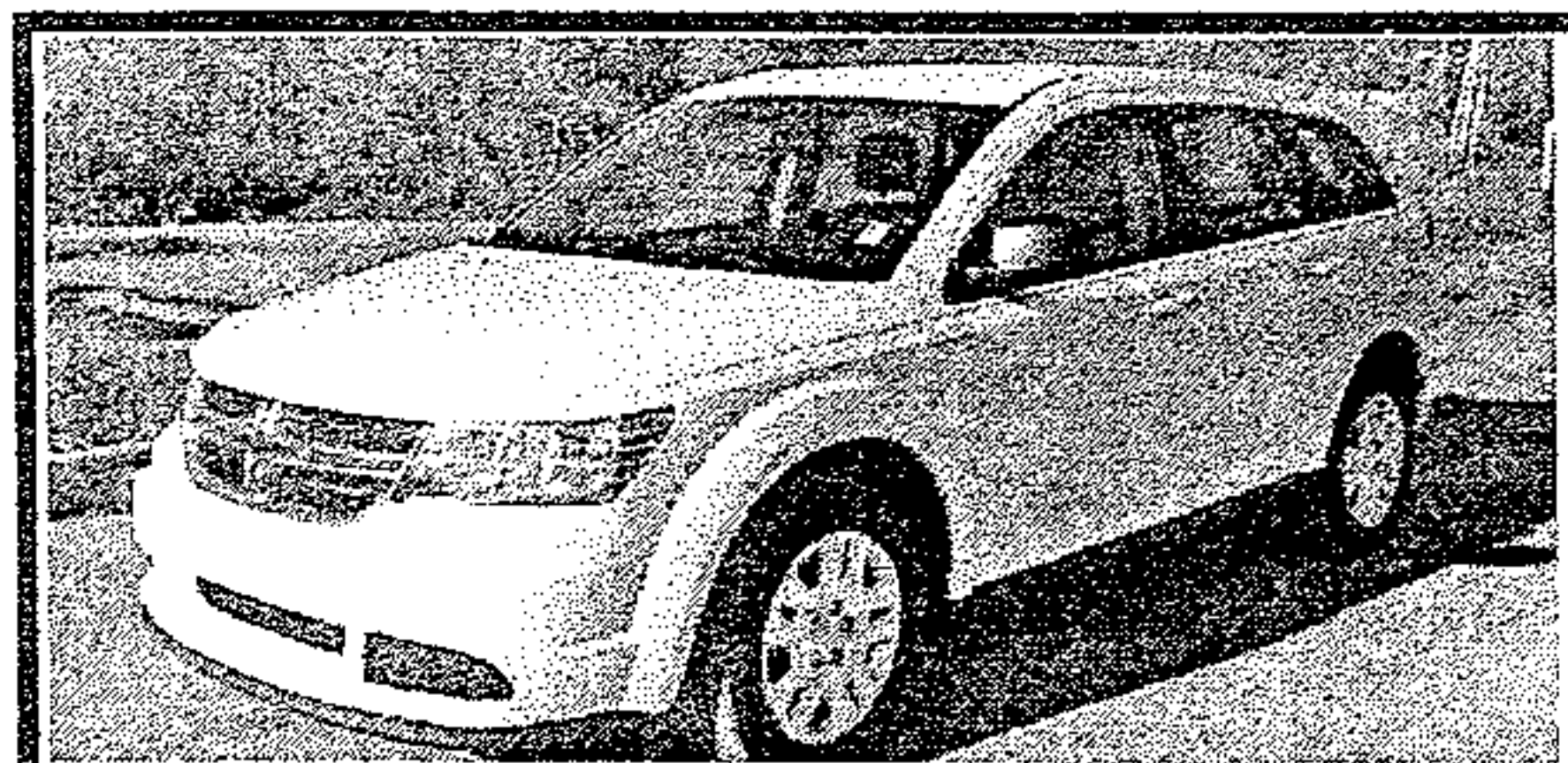

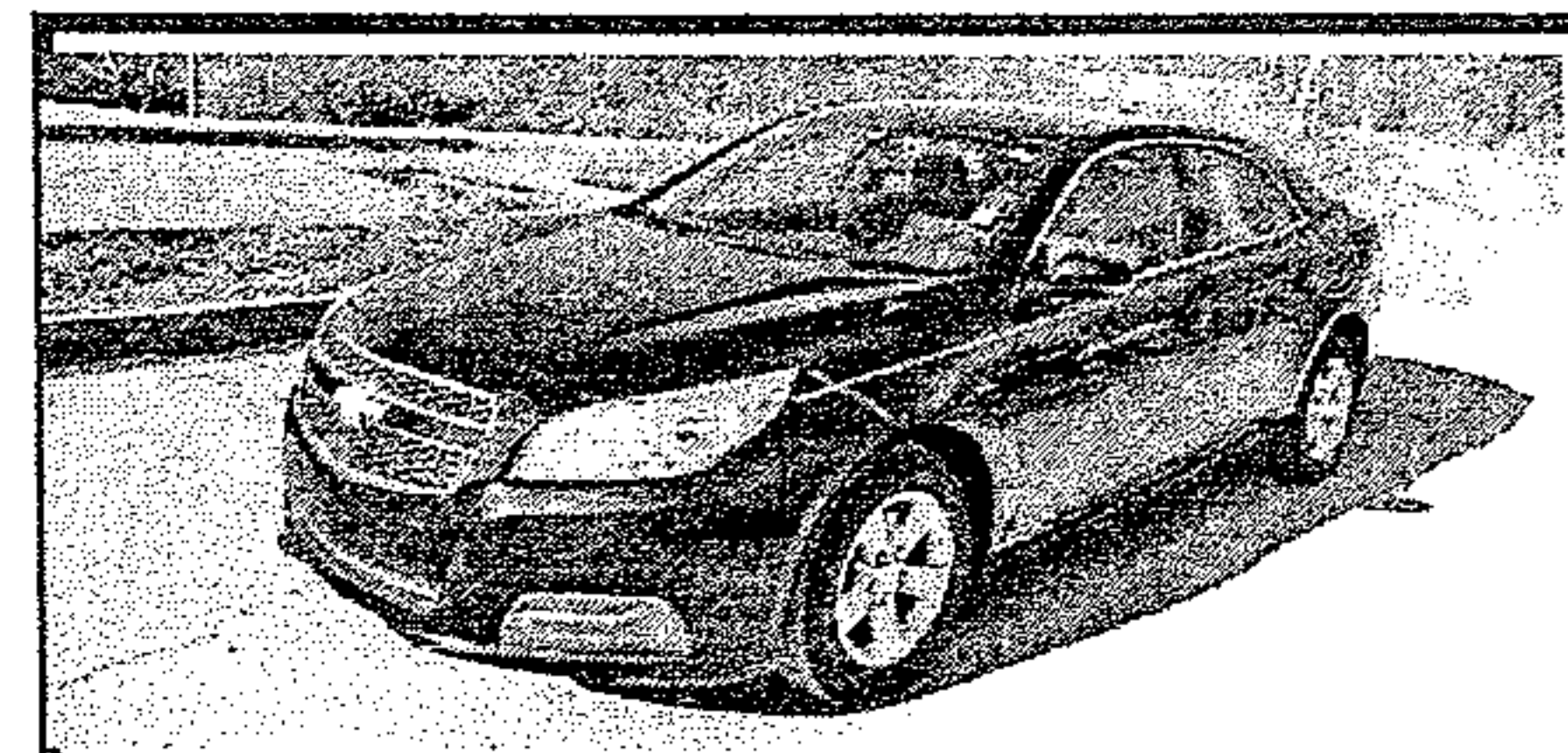
