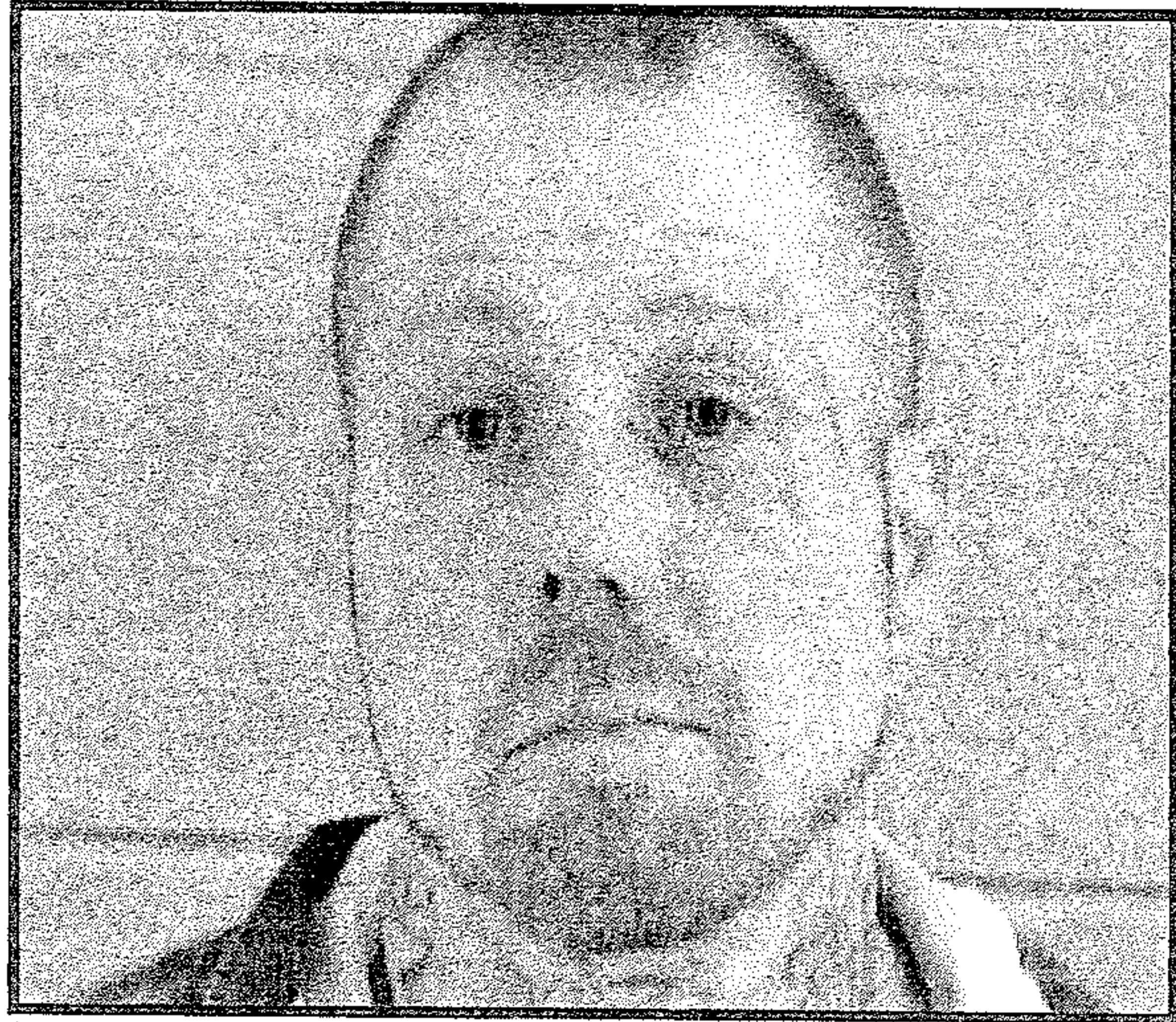

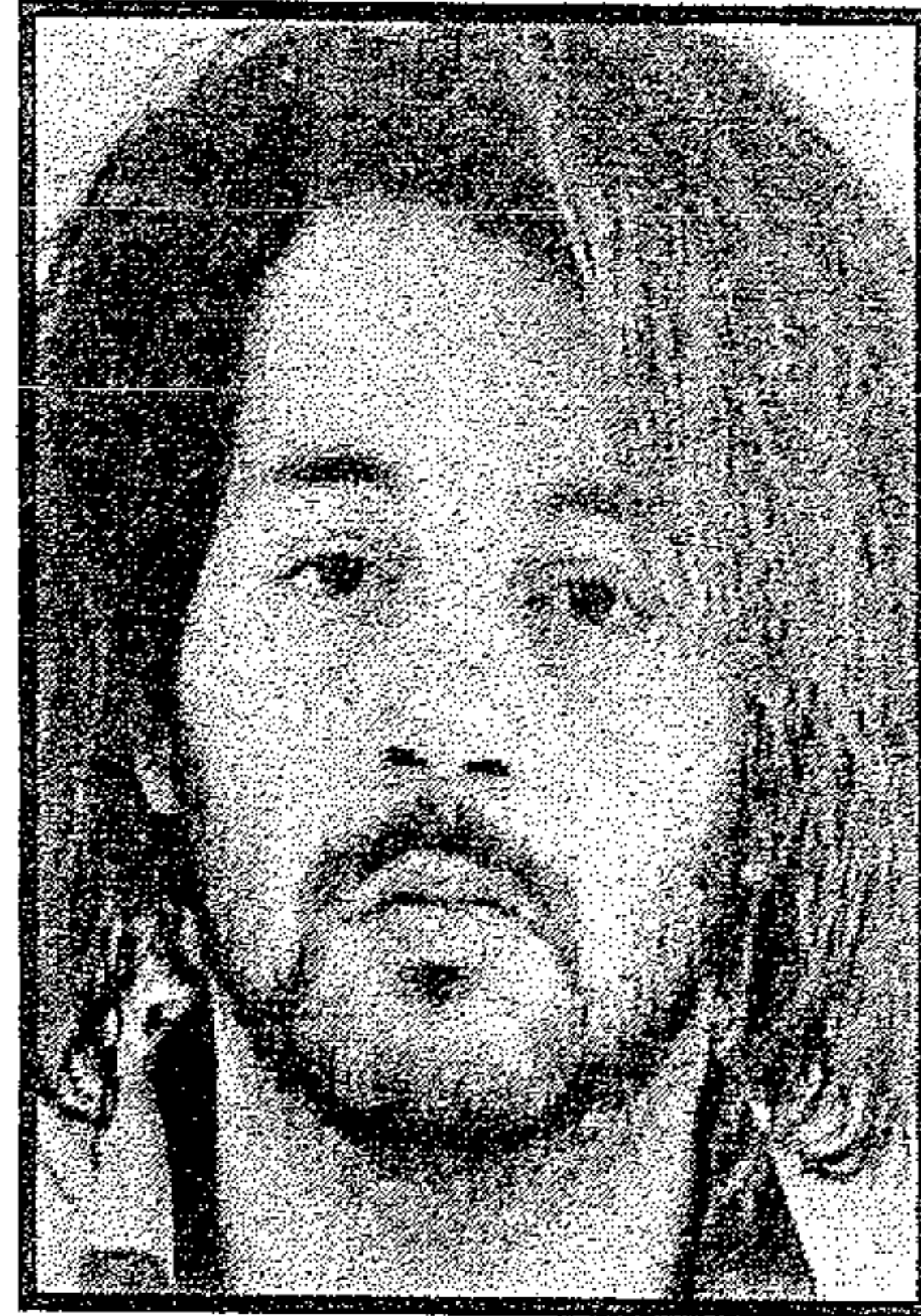
Long-Running Fraud Cost Victims Millions of Dollars

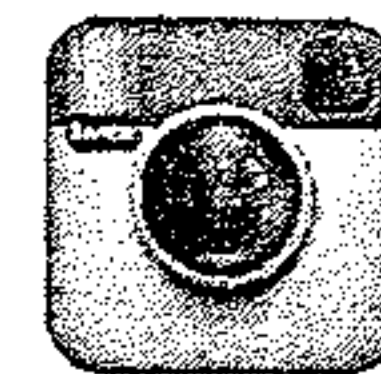

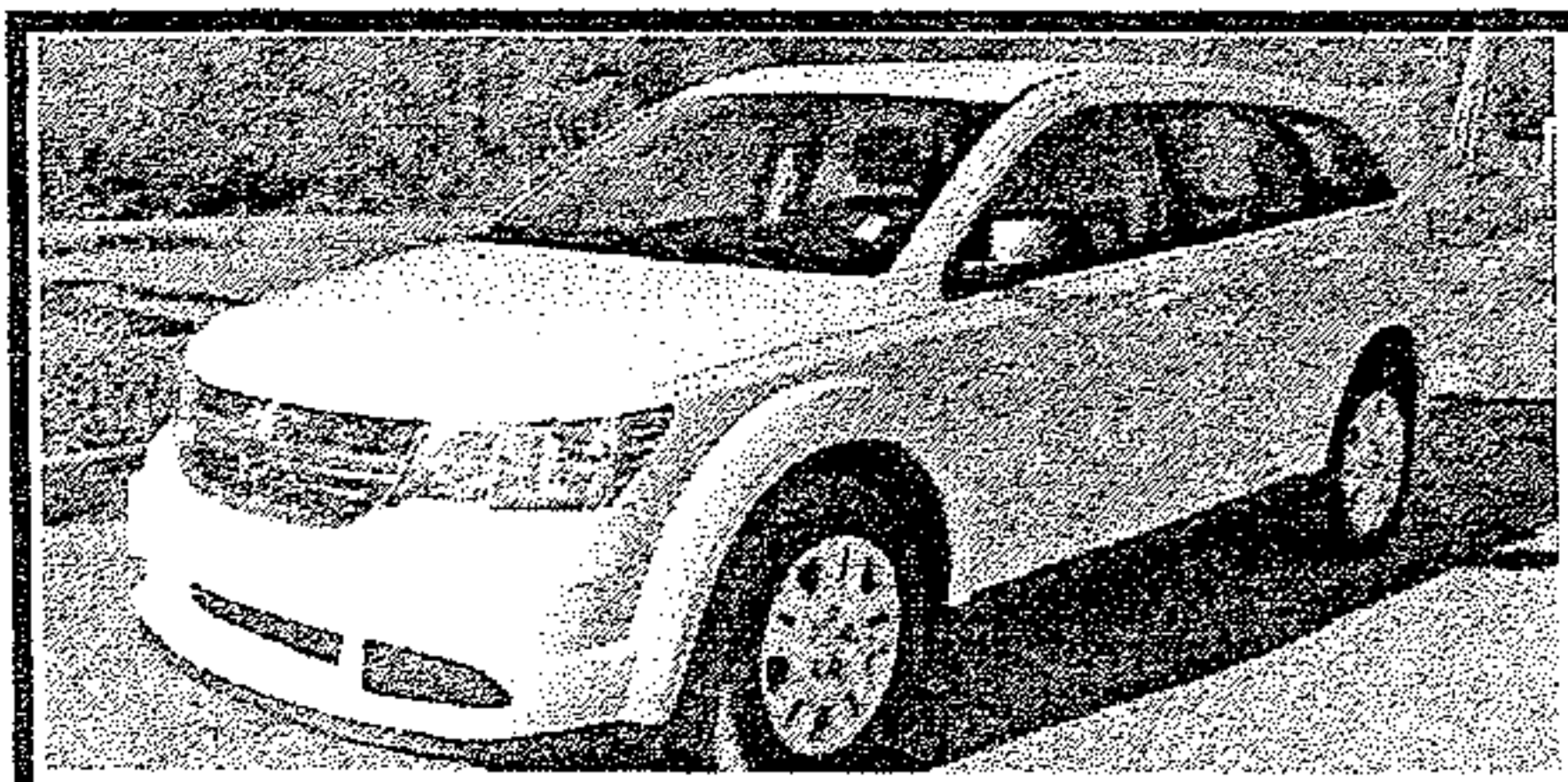
