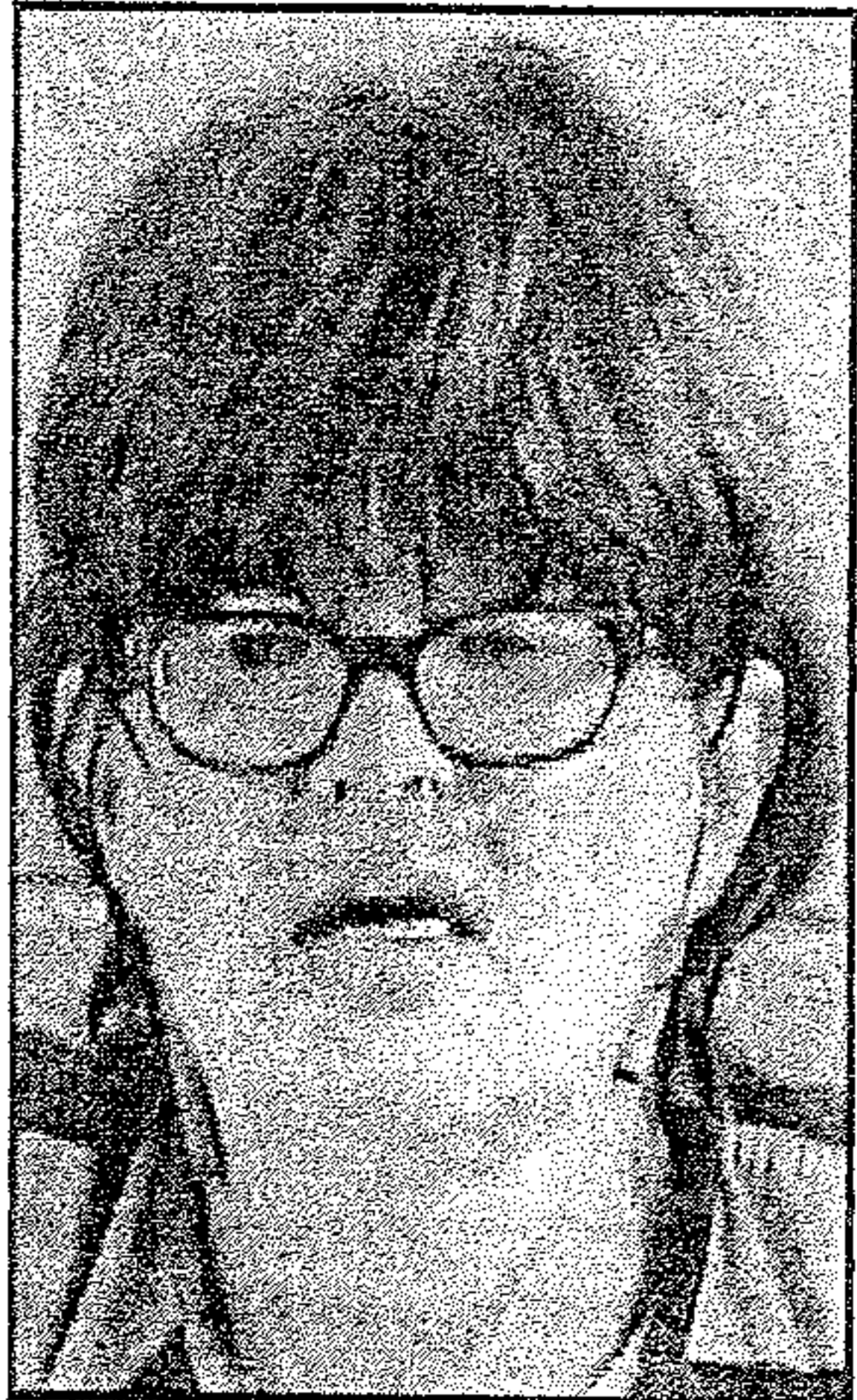

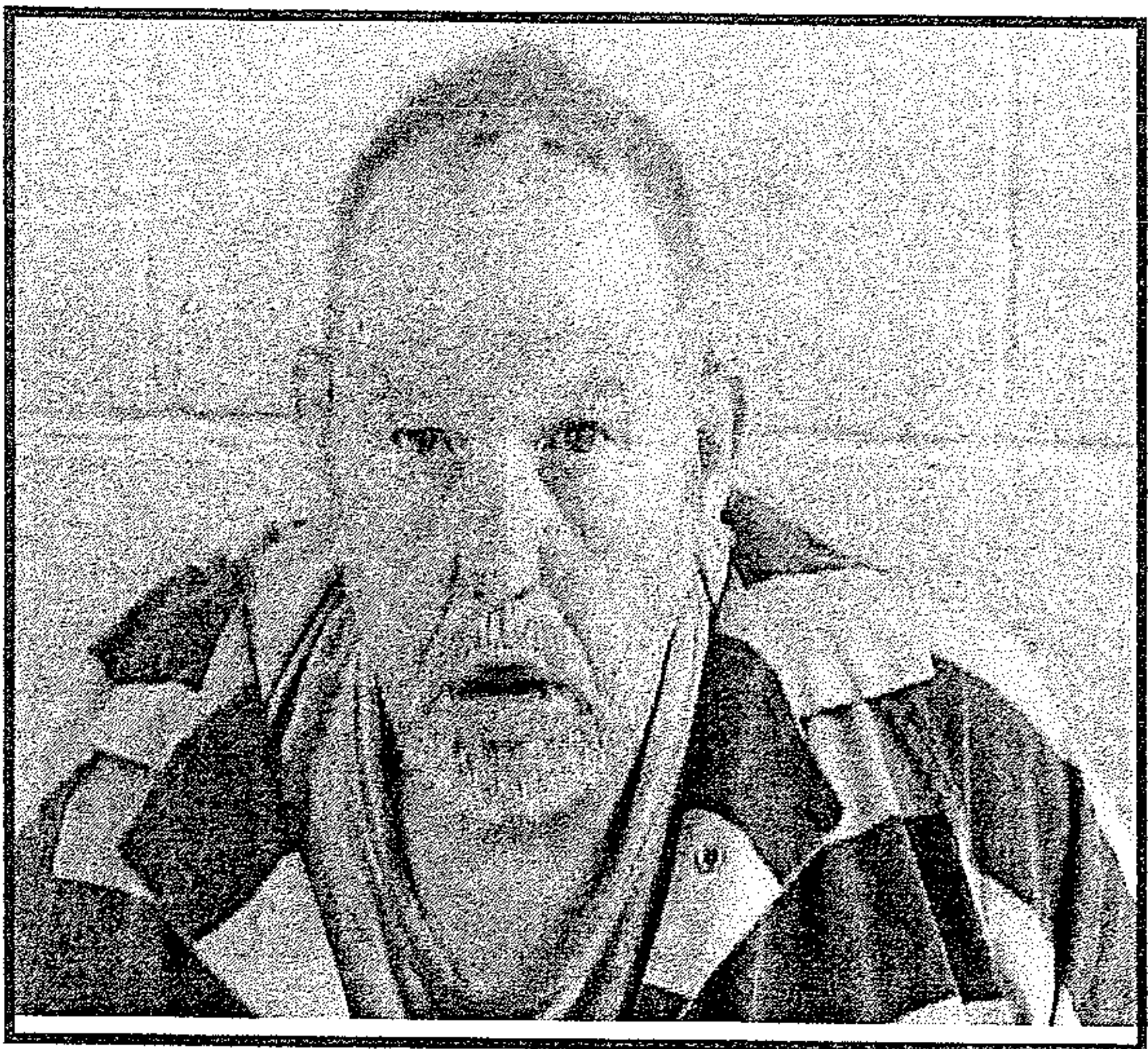

## Updated Interactive Map Provides Legislators with School Information

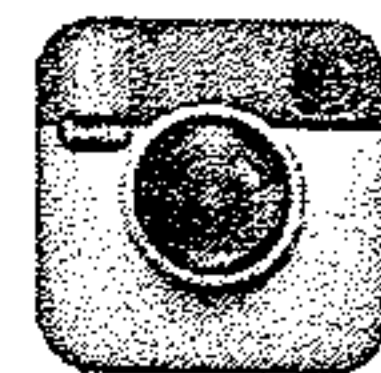
The Tennessee Comptroller's Office has created new and updated interactive maps featuring a wide range of education data at the school and school district levels.

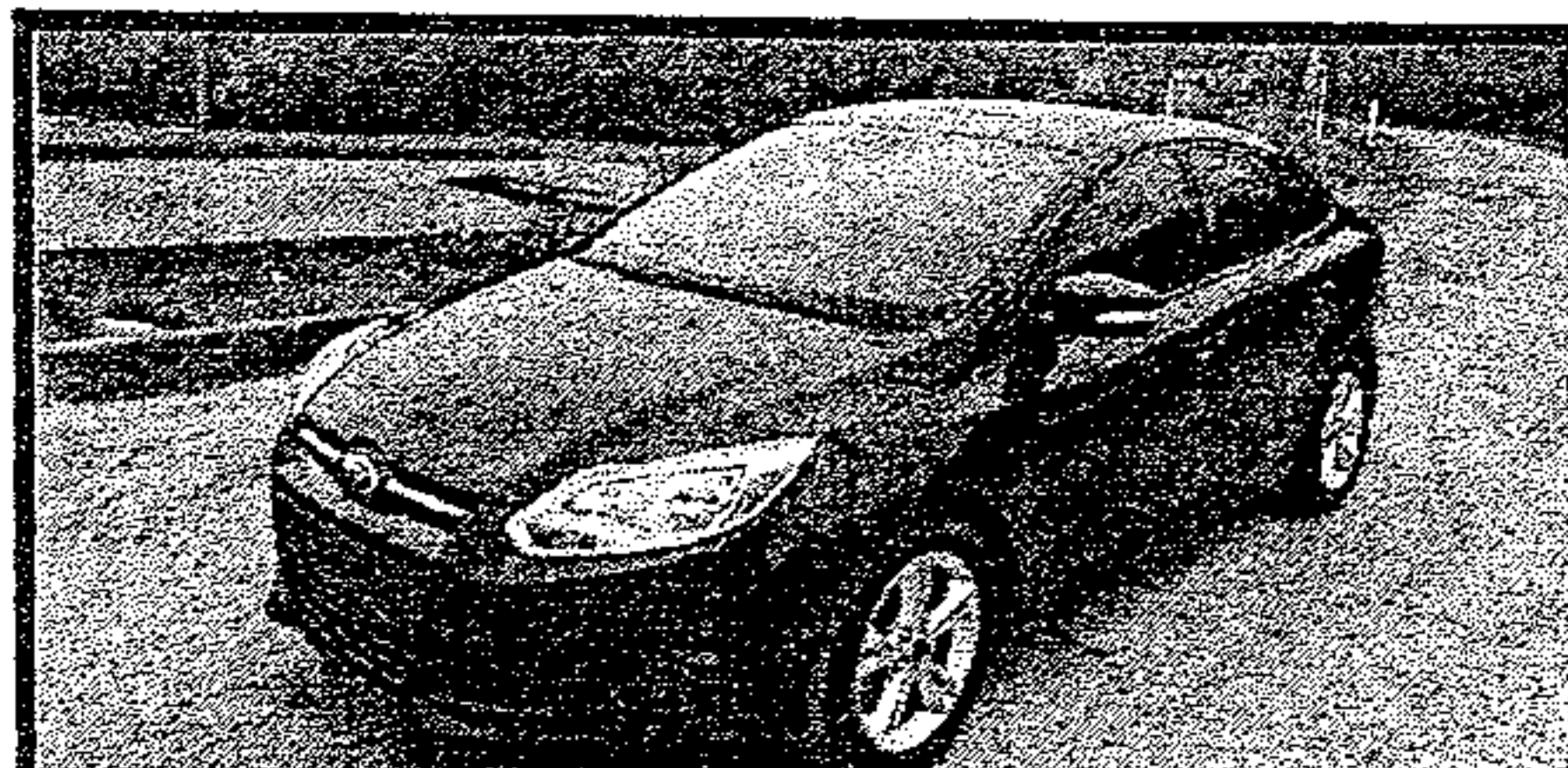

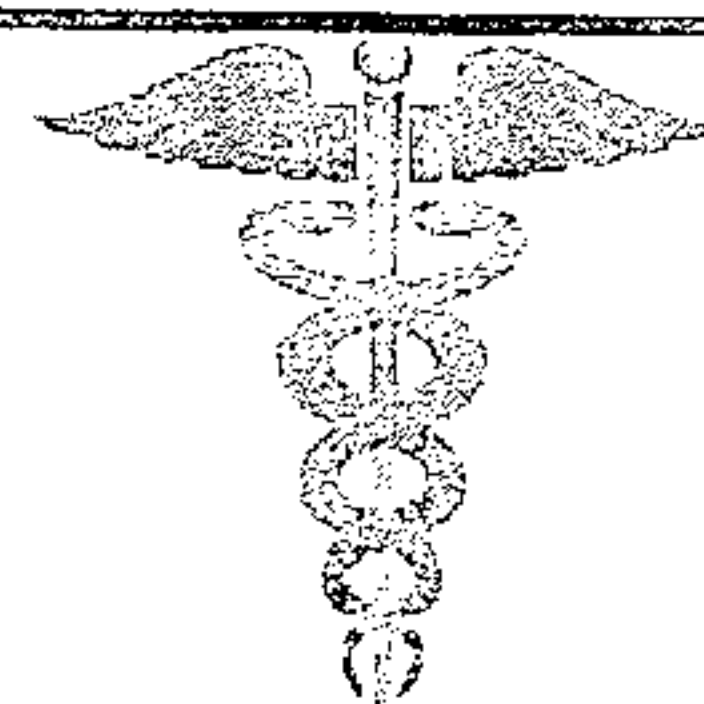

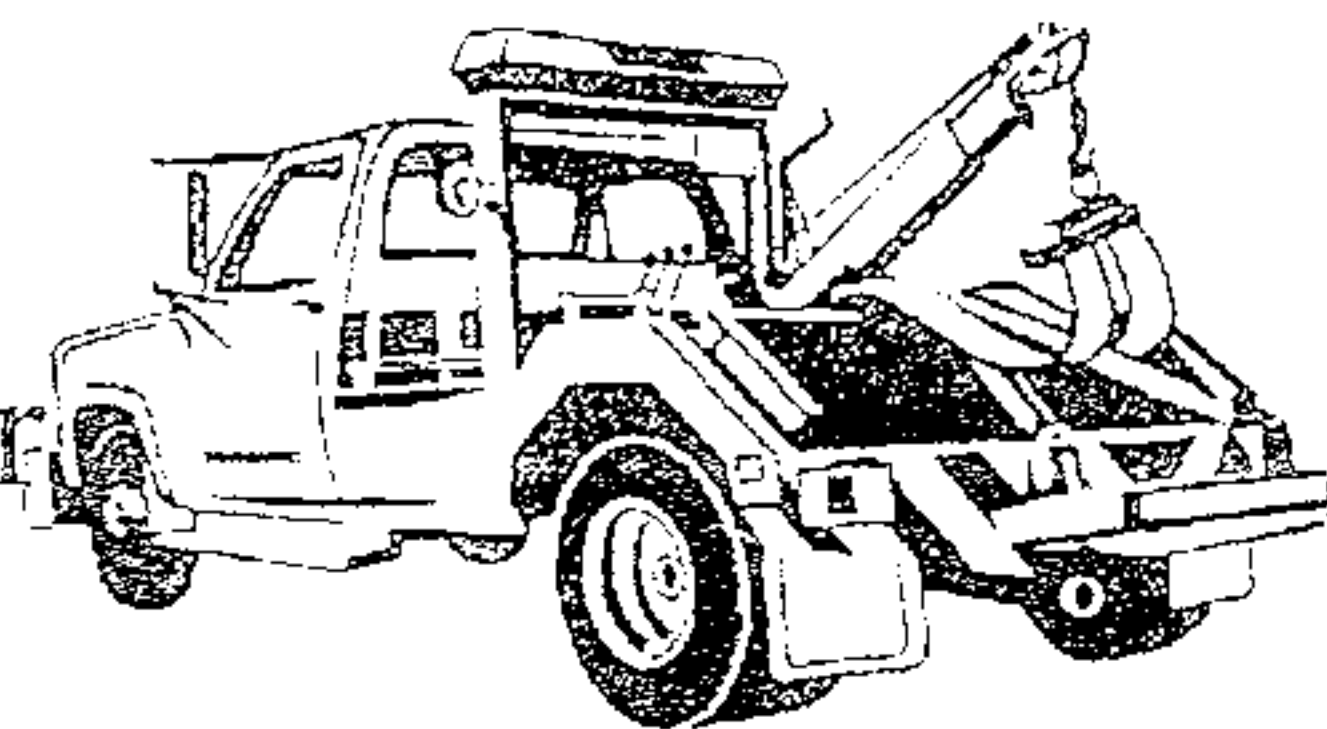

inside the center console. There was seven peach pills with the imprint 345/Mylan inside Ms.Messer purse. The pills were identified as 5mg Diazepam.

Ms.Messer did not have a script for those medications and later stated that she had bought them. Inv. Ketter asked Ms. Smith to search her purse for illegal narcotics and she stated yes.

There was one white pill with the imprint g76, in her purse. The pill was identified as 15mg Oxymorphone. Ms.Smith did not have a script for that medication. Ms.Smith also had \$880.00 in

her purse. Ms.Smith stated that she did not have anything else illegal on her person. She was advised that she would be searched at the jail when we got there. Ms.Smith then pulled out three bottles

from her waistband. One bottle had the label peeled off and had (9) 15mg oxycodone and (15) 10mg oxymorphone. The second had (4) green pills with the imprint a214 and (3) green pills labeled U23 both pills were identified as 15mg Oxycodone. The third bottle was empty and was labeled with Ms.Smiths and was suppose to contain (60) 15mg oxymorphone. Ms.Smith and Ms. Messer were arrested and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

The Narcotics Unit has been surveilling Ms.Smiths home for drug activity.

Several vehicles would pull into her driveway throughout the day and the driver or passenger would go inside and come back out in less than ten minutes. Ms.Messer also stated that she would drive Ms. Smith to several locations.

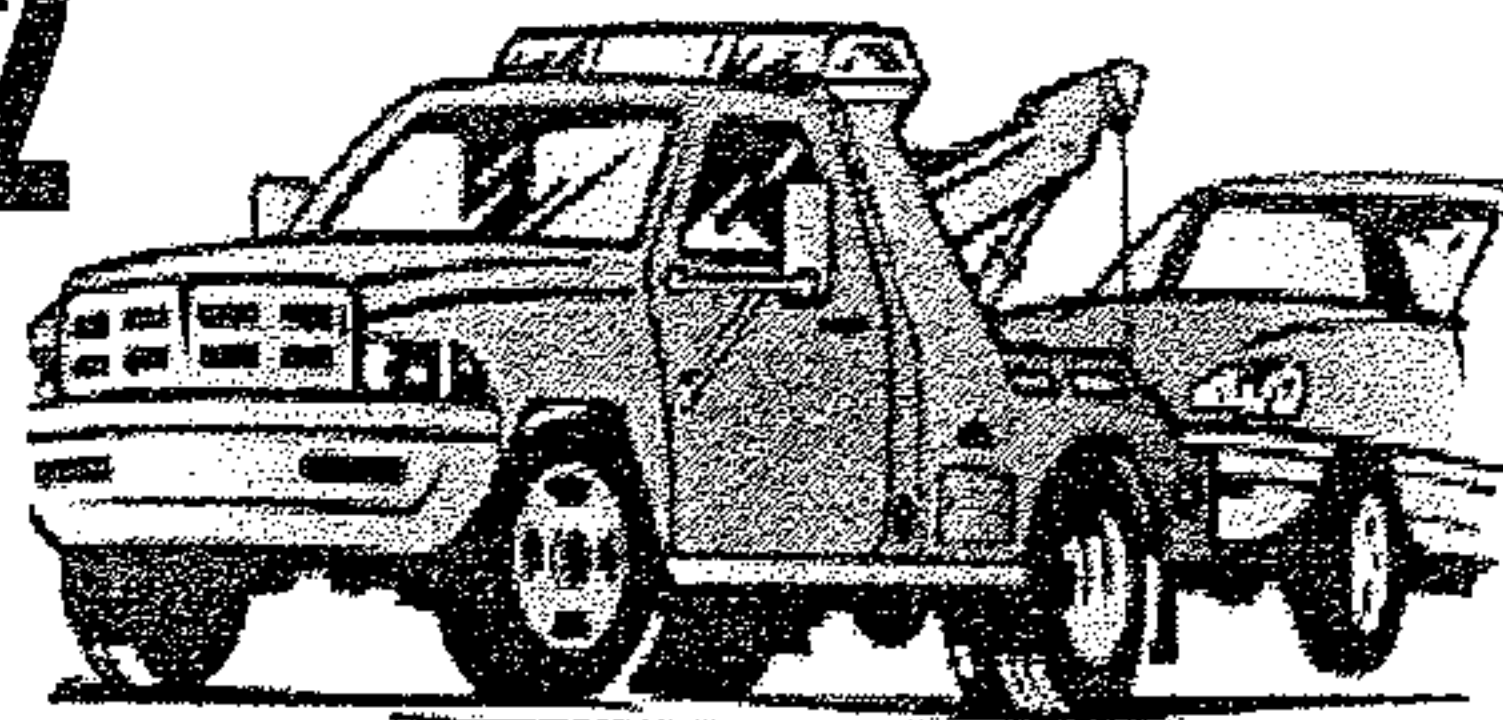

David Williams, 55, 4th Ave. Lenoir City, was charged with Driving without a valid License, and Simple Possession.

Cpl. Rondel Branam LCSO, was flagged down by another motorist that a green vehicle in front of them was driving all over the roadway. Deputy made contact with the vehicle on Hwy 11 near the Red Top Market.

Deputy observed the vehicle make a wide turn onto Tinnel Road, and then a turn onto Crisman Road. The vehicle left the road way when on Crisman Road, Deputy initiated his emergency lights to stop the vehicle.
