## Con Man

### FBI Impersonator Preyed on Women

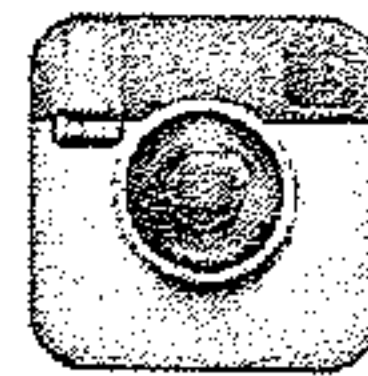
Anthony Jones was a con man. The 46-year-old Jacksonville, Florida resident impersonated an FBI agent and an investment adviser—and made a habit of preying on women. But like so many scam artists, his lies and deceptions finally caught up with him.

The tawdry tale of Jones and the women he victimized be-

gan for Special Agent Steve Burros one January night in 2013, when a Jacksonville Sheriff's Office detective contacted him and said that Jones had impersonated an FBI agent in an attempt to solicit free sex from a prostitute.

Jones had requested a date from an on-line escort service and

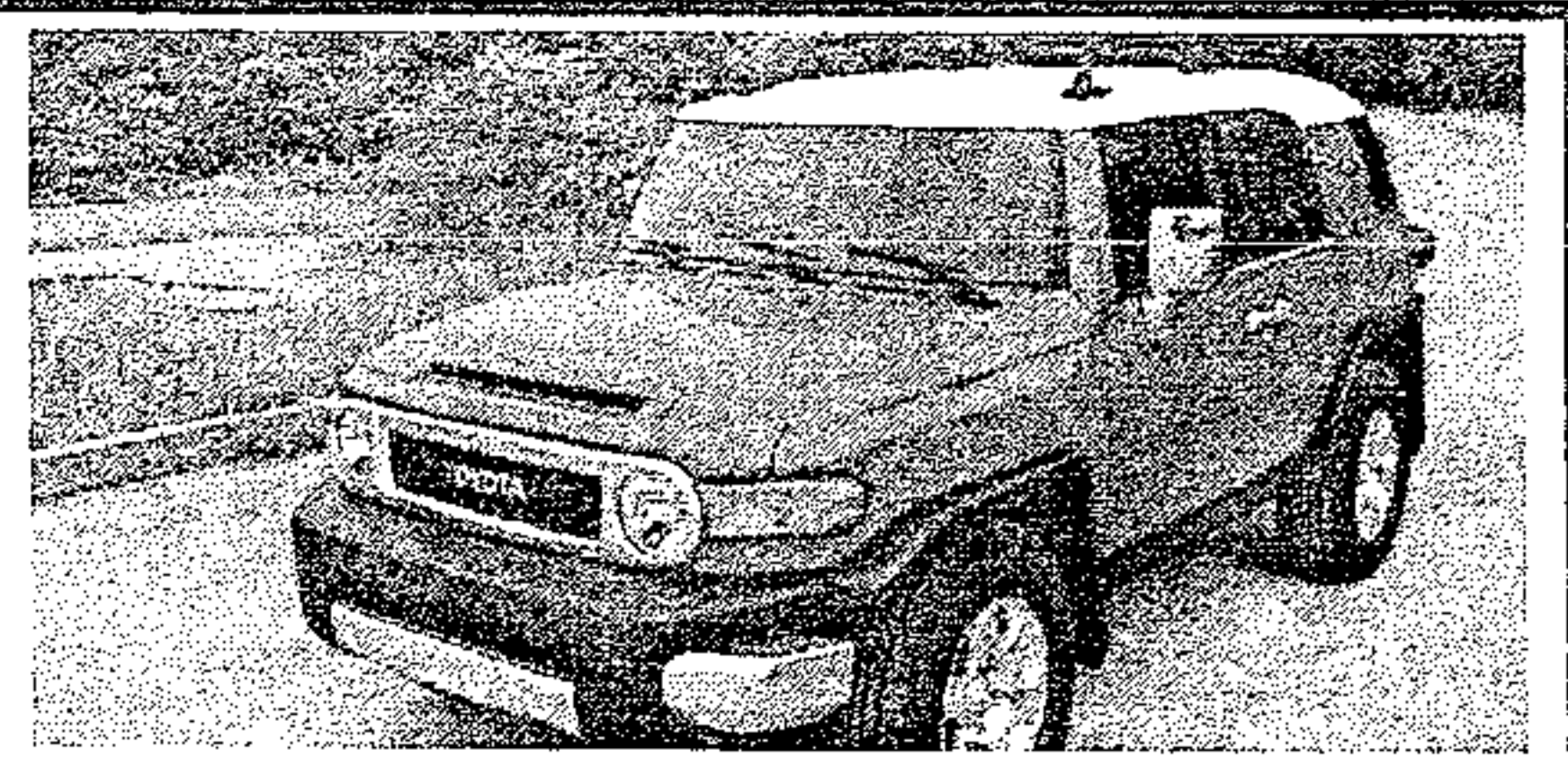
ibly under the influence, after speaking to Mrs. Cooper Deputy observed in her purse a crack pipe, 2 burnt spoons, then located 6 1/2 Clonazepam (blue pill E/64 Schedule 4), and 3 Suboxone strips (Schedule 3) she was then taken into custody. Contact

was made with the (driver) Andrea Duff who was still inside the vehicle in the drivers seat where she was unable to get out of the vehicle. Mrs. Duff was unsure exactly how she wrecked but she had ran off the opposite side of the roadway where she (see wreck ctd. pg. 3)

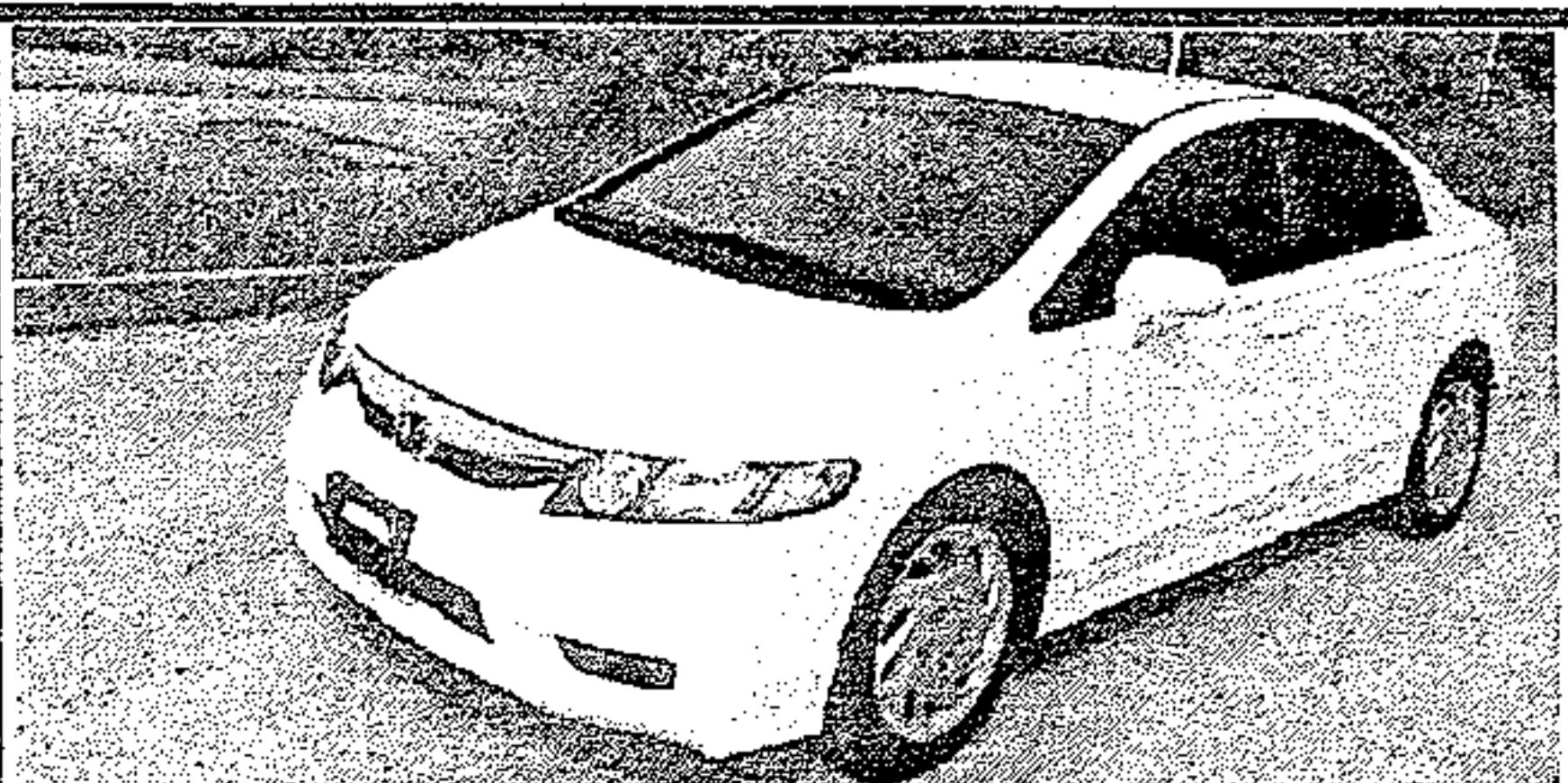

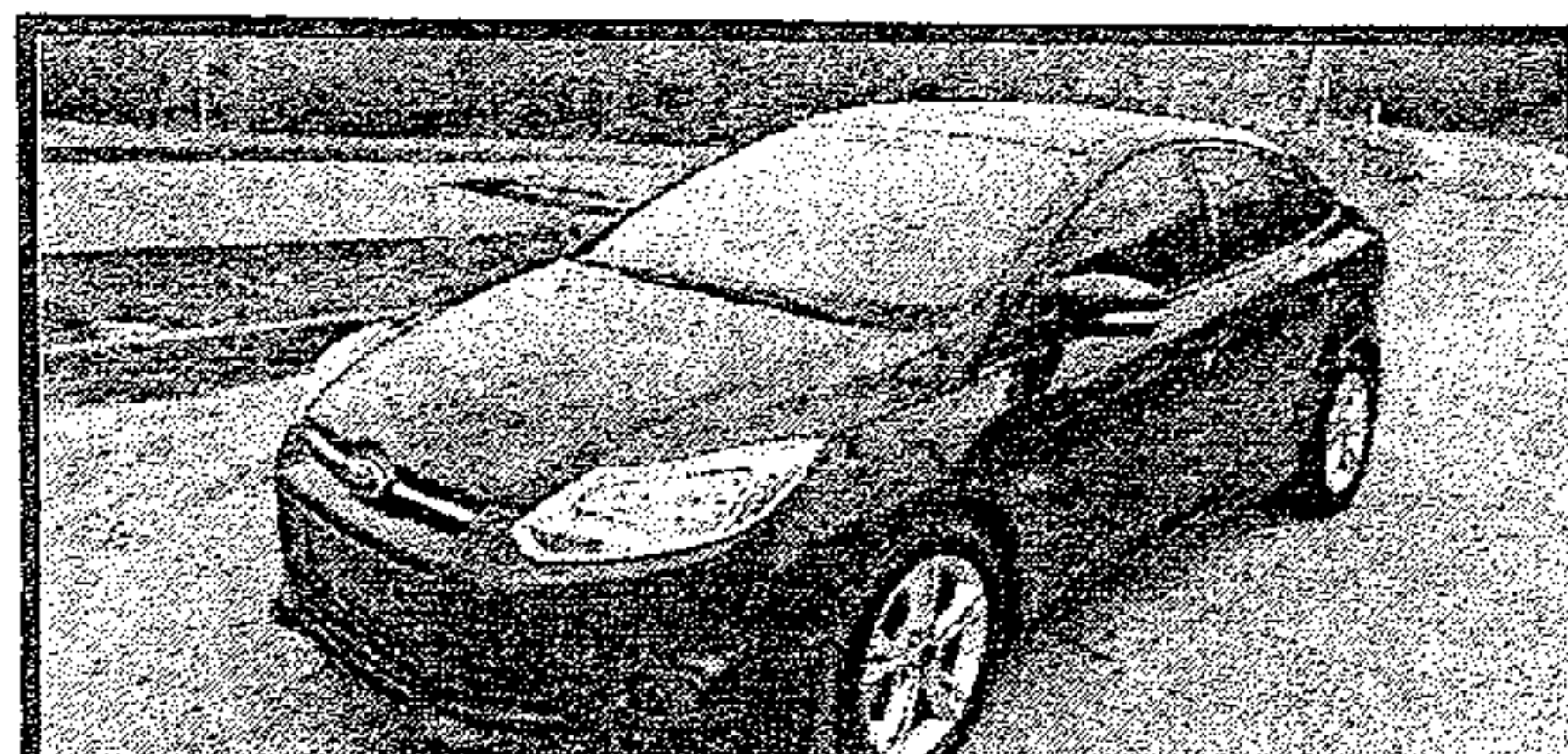

went down an embankment. She stated her face was hurting from the airbag however she clearly was visibly under the influence as well.

After observing Mrs. Cooper's

behavior Deputy checked her eyes where she had lack of smooth pursuit, HGN, also her pupils were constricted and she had Lack of Convergence. In fact while checking her eyes multiple times she appeared to be falling asleep on the deputy. Due to the deputy's training he reported it appeared she was on some sort of Depressant by her being drowsy, droopy eyelids, lethargic, and disoriented along with the presence of HGN and Lack of Convergence how-


ever she also had constricted pupils which would indicate a presence of Narcotic Analgesics with the Depressant being Psychoactive (most influential presence). She was taken to Fort Loudon ER via EMS where she agreed to give blood and was released into Deputy custody. Mrs. Duff was charged with Simple Possession (1 Suboxone in her purse), Driving Under the Influence and cited for No Insurance. Mrs. Cooper was

promised to pay \$200. The prostitute arrived at his apartment, where Jones lived with his wife and three children. "This was all happening in the middle of the day," Burros said. "The wife was at work and the kids were in school."

Shortly after the prostitute arrived, she asked for the money. That's when Jones said he was an FBI agent and that if she didn't have sex with him for free, she would be arrested. When the woman balked, Jones called an accomplice on the phone, who was working from a script.

"He puts the phone on speaker and says, 'Hey, I got another one for you. I'm just now finishing up the other two warrants,'" Burros said. "And so now, the prostitute believed him." Jones also pointed to a smoke detector in the bedroom and said the woman was being monitored by a hidden camera.

Afterward, though, when the prostitute told her roommate what had happened, the two realized she had been scammed, and they went to Jones' residence to collect the money. The heated ar-

gument that ensued led to a police intervention, and Jones ended up being charged with receiving a sex act through force or coercion—and Burros was called in to investigate the FBI impersonation

allegation.

Meanwhile, the accomplice on the phone during the prostitution incident was a young woman who knew she was part of a scam but didn't know Jones was trying to get free sex. She had a child with Jones but had no idea he was married and living with his wife and three other children. She, too, was a victim of Jones' many cons.

It turned out that the young woman—the mother of Jones' child—had lost both her parents in a car accident and received a settlement of about \$35,000 from the insurance company.

Jones lied and told her he was an investment adviser and that he owned fast food restaurants and would invest the money for her.

"She thought he was investing her money," Burros said, "but instead he was depositing it in his wife's account and spending it on himself." The young woman had no idea what Jones had done until Burros discovered the fraud.

Jones was arrested on January 9, 2013 on the prostitute coercion charge and released on bond subject to electronic monitoring. The following April—

Crystal Brown, 34, Donaldson Road Philadelphia, was charged with Domestic Assault.

Deputy JC Schultz LCSO answered

a physical domestic call at Donaldson Rd. in Philadelphia, TN. Upon arrival Ms. Crystal Marie Brown was standing in the yard screaming at the victim.

Ms. Brown had

threatened victims with a golf club that she was holding. Ms Brown stated that she had threatened to hit her parents because they were disciplining her child. Ms. Brown was acting confused,

had bloodshot eyes, and was obviously under the influence of a intoxicant. Ms. Brown stated that she had been drinking rubbing alcohol and she had used ice and it had killed her broth-

er. The victim stated that Brown threatened to hit him with a golf club and was on drugs and needed court ordered drug rehabilitation. Victim stated that he was afraid of his daughter and did not want her around his home any longer.

Ms. Brown was arrested for domestic assault and when asked if she had anything on her person, she volunteered that she put a "point" (syringe) inside her private parts. Ms. Brown was transported to The Loudon County Jail by this Deputy where a syringe was removed from her.

Ms. Brown stated the syringe had ice inside it. This did occur in Loudon County, TN.

aware that Burros was on to his additional financial fraud—Jones cut off his ankle monitoring bracelet and fled. He was on the run for more than two years, until he was captured in August 2015 by the U.S. Marshals Service in Jacksonville.

As for the FBI impersonation, "Jones was not a first timer," Burros noted. He had previously been arrested for passing himself off as an agent to get work done on his house.

In 2016, Jones pleaded guilty to impersonating an FBI agent, wire fraud, and failure to appear. In February 2017, a federal judge sentenced him to five years and six months in

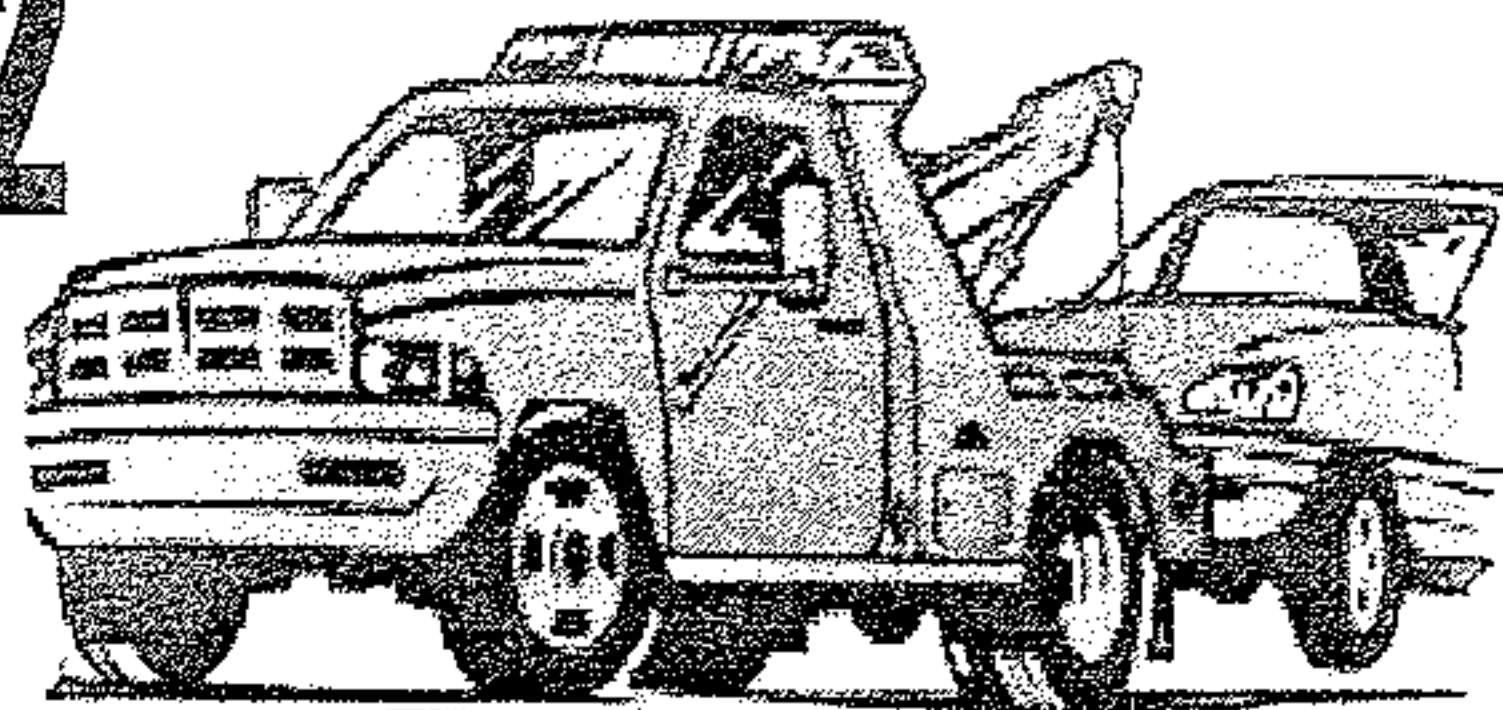

Stanley Matlock, 54, Loudon Ridge Road Lenoir City, was charged with Simple Possession, and Driving on Revoked/Suspended License.

Deputy Kevin Dailley LCSO, observed a 2002 white Ford Taurus on Loudon Ridge Rd at Crock Rd cross the center line multiple times as well as not having the correct tag on the vehicle. Upon traffic stop at Loudon Ridge Rd and Sugarlimb Rd Deputy came in contact with the driver Stanley Matlock who was unable to provide registration to the vehicle or his license due to his wallet being in the trunk of his

car. Mr. Matlock exited the vehicle to retrieve his wallet which was inside his boot in the trunk where Deputy observed a small baggie inside his wallet. He did state that inside his wallet he did have Marijuana along with some Crack Cocaine (1.10 gm), which Deputy did locate in two separate baggies. prison. Upon release, he has been ordered to pay restitution of nearly \$22,000 to the young woman whose insurance settlement he fraudulently gained access to. If he doesn't pay, he could be sent back to jail.

"Anthony Jones was truly a con artist," Burros said. "The money he scammed from this poor young woman was a significant sum for her, and now she is living with her grandparents and raising the child she had with Jones—and so far he has never given her a dime."
