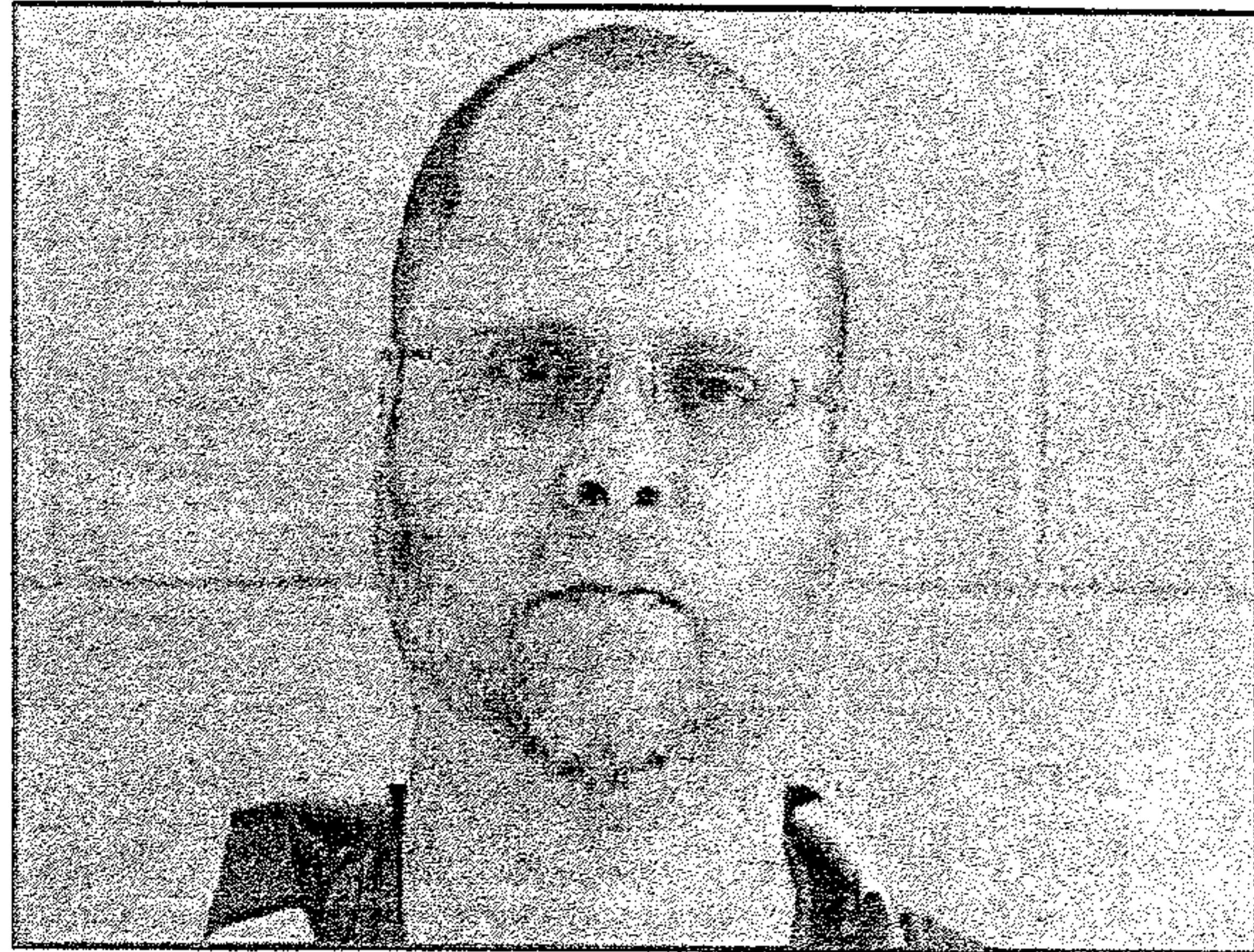

Nathan Shelton, 38, Abbott Road Lenoir City, was charged with Sexual Battery.

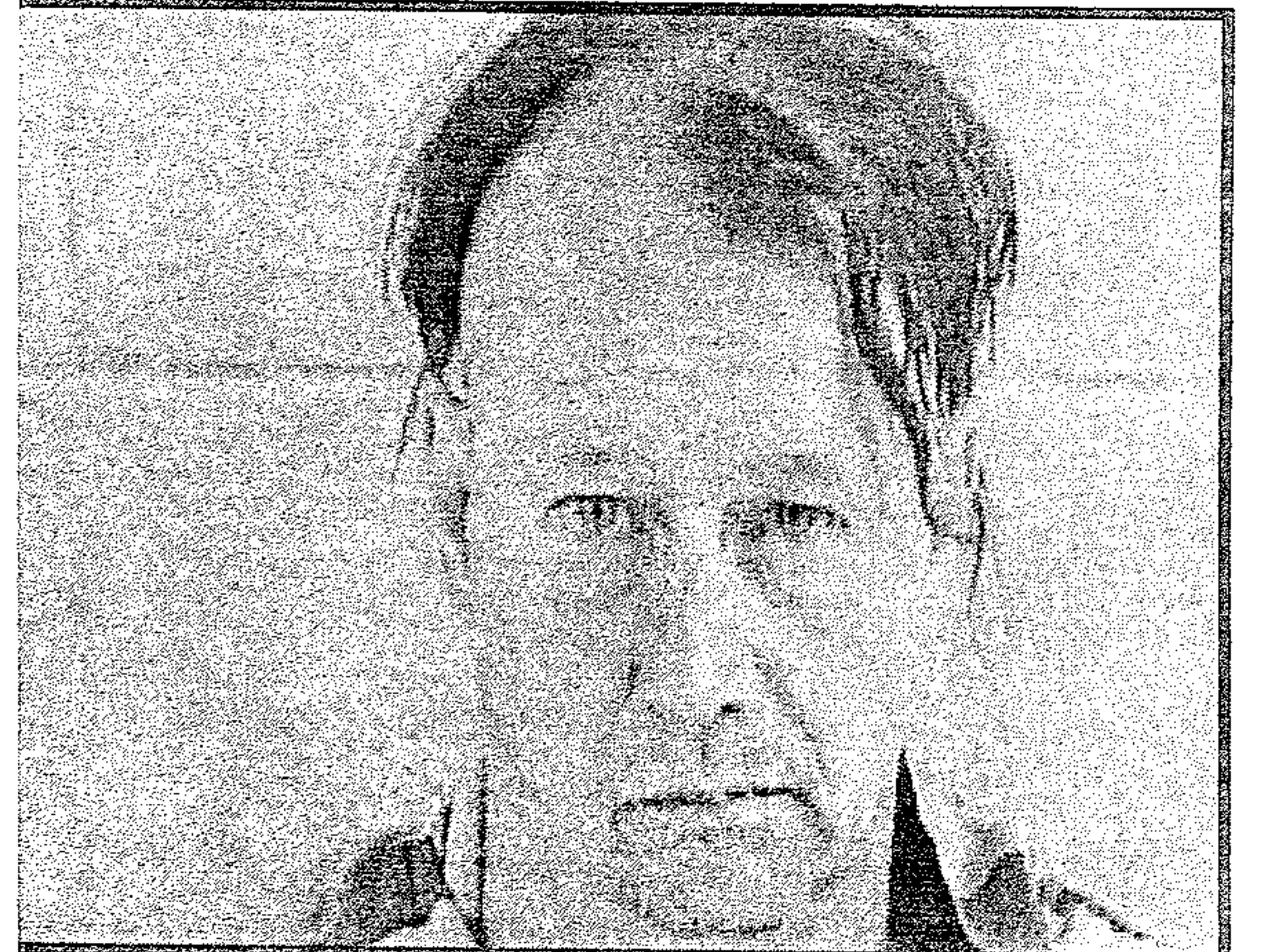

A Man was fishing off of Australia's east coast when the shark leaped out of the ocean and into his small boat

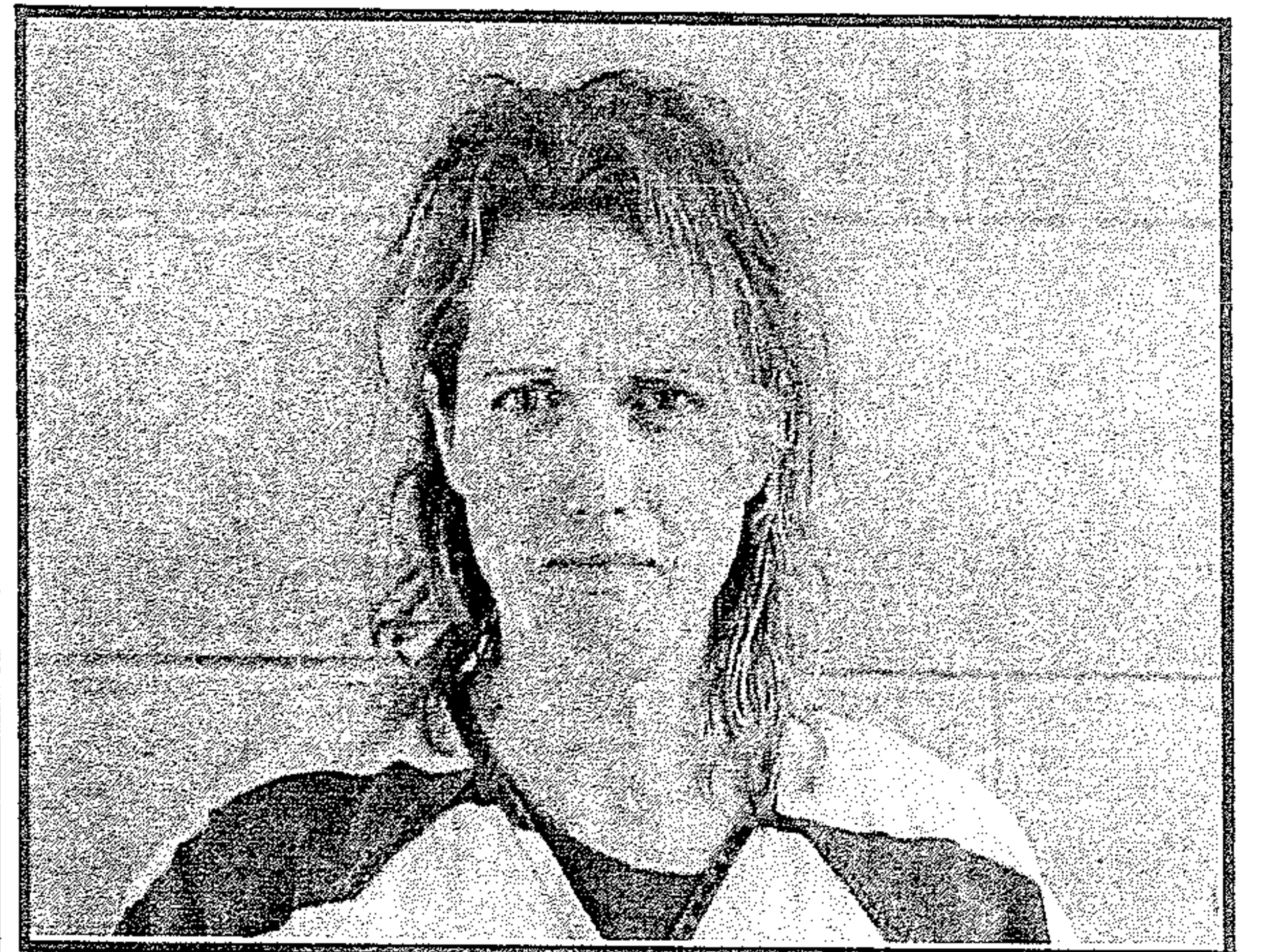
Fisherman: "He knocked me off balance, of course, and I just fell on my hands and knees"

Fisherman Terry Selwood, 73, is still trying to wrap his head around how it all happened.

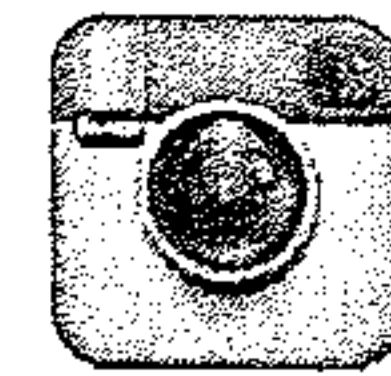

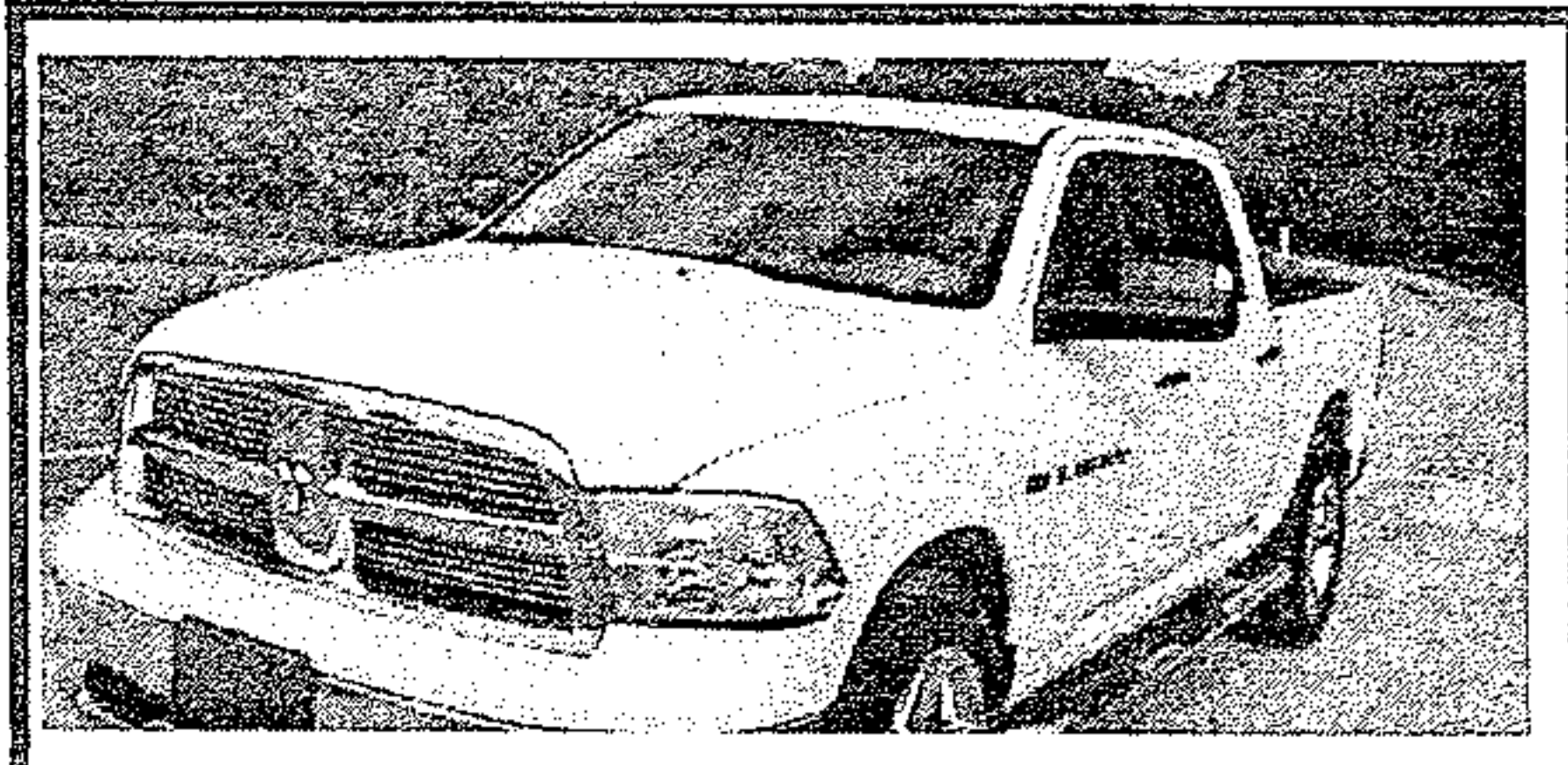

DUI

Rachel Evans, 34, Little Dug Gag Road Louisville, was charged with DUI.

Deputy Billy Lewis LCSO, was dispatched to the Grizley Pig gas station for a possible wreck. Upon arrival Deputy made contact with the driver of a Silver Chevrolet Impala Mrs. Rachel Evans. While speaking with her Deputy observed disabling damage to the front and right side of the Vehicle.

Mrs. Evans advised that she was going to see a friend in Knoxville stating she was coming from her home in Louisville Tennessee off Topside Road.

Mrs. Evans stated that she currently takes Suboxone 8mg along, Xanax 1mg, Keppra 1000mg. Deputy found three open Suboxone Strips and four unopened Suboxone strips in the vehicle which Mrs. Evans stated was hers. Mrs. Evans stated she is supposed to take 2

Suboxone strips daily stating she had only taken one about Suboxone that morning and stated that she took the Xanax about 30 minutes prior stating that she just wanted to take it. While Deputy was speaking with Mrs. Evans Deputy Smith was able to find the location of Mrs. Smiths wreck on Pond Creek Road which was about 1 mile away. Deputy Smith was able to match the grille from the wreck seen to the Chevrolet Impala Mrs. Evans was driving.

Deputy then requested Mrs. Evans to attempt Standardized Field Sobriety at which time she failed. Deputy Billy Lewis took Mrs. Rachel Evans into Custody for Driving under the Influence. Mrs. Evans consented to Tennessee Implied Consent and was taken to Fort Loudon Emergency Room for Blood Draw. Deputy then transported Mrs. Rachel Evans to the Loudon County Jail without further incident. This did happen in Loudon County Tennessee.

Shark

Selwood was fishing off of Evans Head on Australia's east coast on Saturday when a great white shark suddenly leaped out of the ocean beside him.

"The bloody thing just jumped in my boat," Selwood told ABC News Australia. The shark was later measured at almost 9 feet (2.7 meters) long.

"As he was coming down, he hit me on the arm. He knocked me off balance, of course, and I just fell on my hands and knees," said Selwood. "I looked there to the side and ... (thought) 'this is a bloody shark.'"

Despite being stunned and bloodied, the fisherman reacted quickly.

"He was just doing the mad dance and he was thrashing everywhere, so I got up as quick as I could, I grabbed the rocket launcher up the top, and I climbed up on the gunnel," Selwood said. Then he called for help on his radio.

The Evans Head Marine Rescue Unit said it launched a res-

cue boat after receiving a distress signal late Saturday afternoon. A rescue helicopter also was dispatched.

When rescuers arrived, they found Selwood "covered in blood with numerous lacerations on his right fore-

arm," according to a statement released by the Evans Head Marine Rescue Unit. "A large shark was also found in the cabin of the not so large fishing boat."

Brendon Sokol, 31, Giles Road Lenoir City, was charged with Driving on Revoked License, Habitual Motor Offender, and Leaving the Scene of

an Accident.

Deputy Lance Anderson LCSO, responded to Giles Rd. in reference to a hit and run that occurred on Hwy 11 E at Davis Rd. The victim, from the crash gave a tag

number and a detailed description of the driver fled the scene. Upon arrival Deputy made contact with the run vehicle parked behind the residence with damage matching the victim's state-

ment. The front door of the residence was open and Deputy observed a male, matching the driver's description, unresponsive on the couch.

Deputy loudly announced myself but

the male never moved. Deputy made entry into the residence to check the male's welfare and was able to wake the him up. Deputy identified the male as Brendon Sokol, the offender.

Deputy asked the offender about the earlier crash and he refused to answer any questions. The offender also stated the vehicle was broken and had not been moved in six months, however the vehicle's hood was still warm to the touch and his wallet laying in the center of the floorboard. The victim was able to positively identified the offender by the offender's TN ID photo. Dispatch advised me the offender was revoked for DUI and a habitual motor offender.

The offender could not provide proof of auto insurance. The vehicle was seized and towed by Malone's Towing. The offender was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail without incident. All occurred in Loudon County, TN.

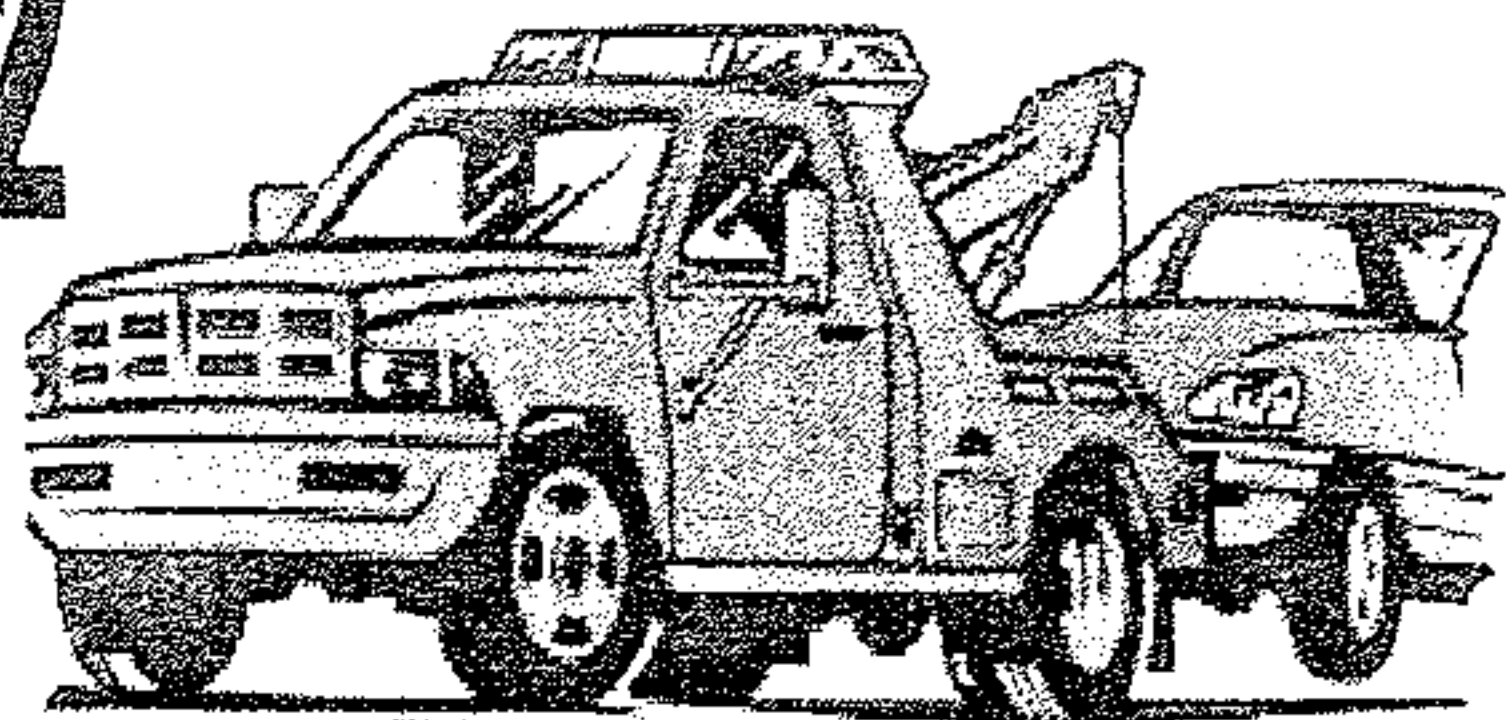

Shark

transferred to the rescue boat, where he received treatment for his injuries.

While en route to shore, Selwood told rescuers he was sitting on an ice chest in the center of his boat when the shark jumped out of the water, cleared the boat's engine and landed on the deck, where it began violently thrashing about.

Fisherman Terry Selwood said the airborne shark struck him with a pectoral fin as it landed.

While trying to get to his feet and as far away from the shark as possible, Selwood "was relentlessly knocked about the

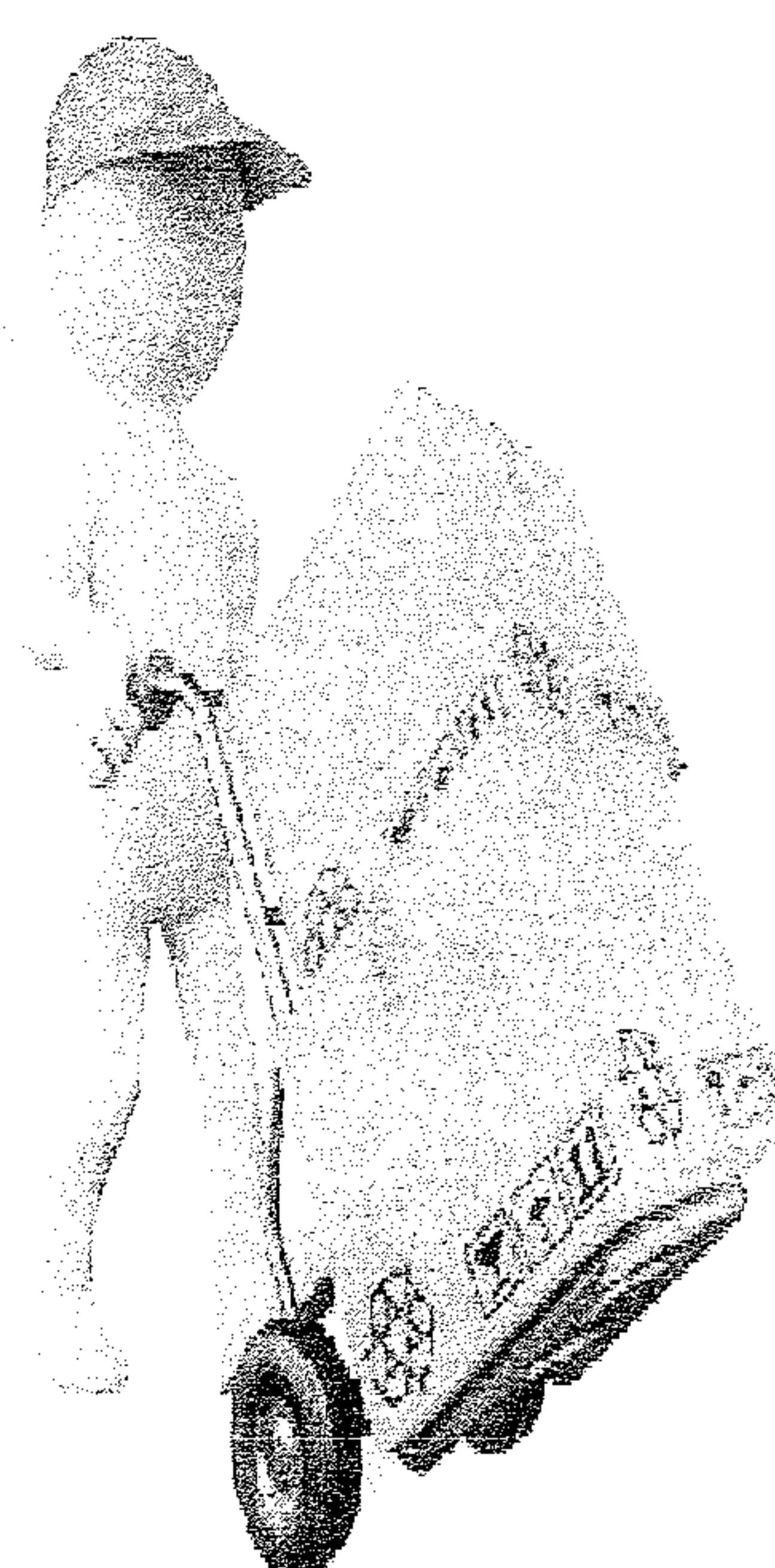
deck and cabin, which is where he sustained most of his injuries," the statement said. Eventually, he managed to climb onto the port-side gunwale of the boat, where he remained while the shark continued to thrash about on the deck.

The shark was later handed over to the Department of Primary Industries where it will be analyzed and used for research. On Monday DPI verified it as a great white shark, according to the statement.

And although he received a few stitches, rescuers joked that Selwood "now has an amazing survival story of 'the one that didn't get away.'"

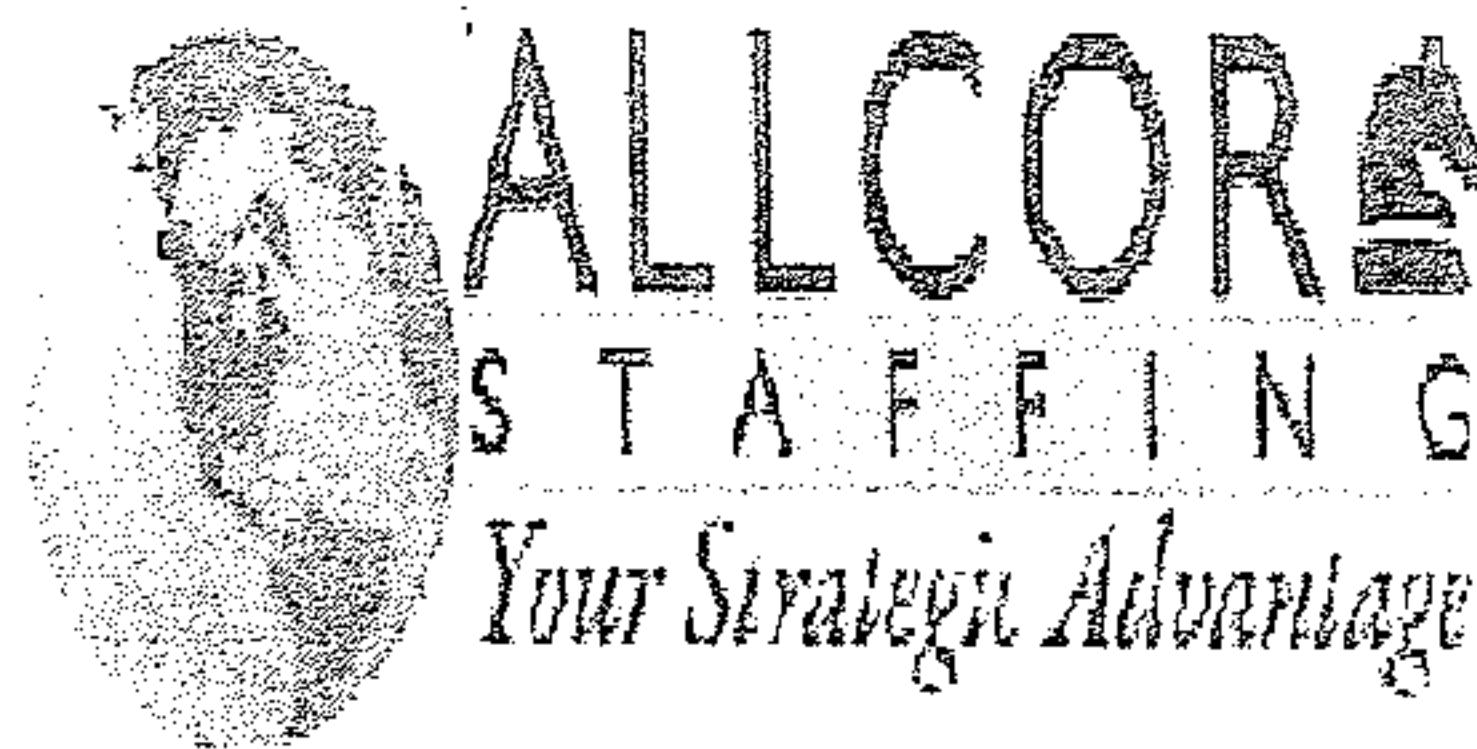
