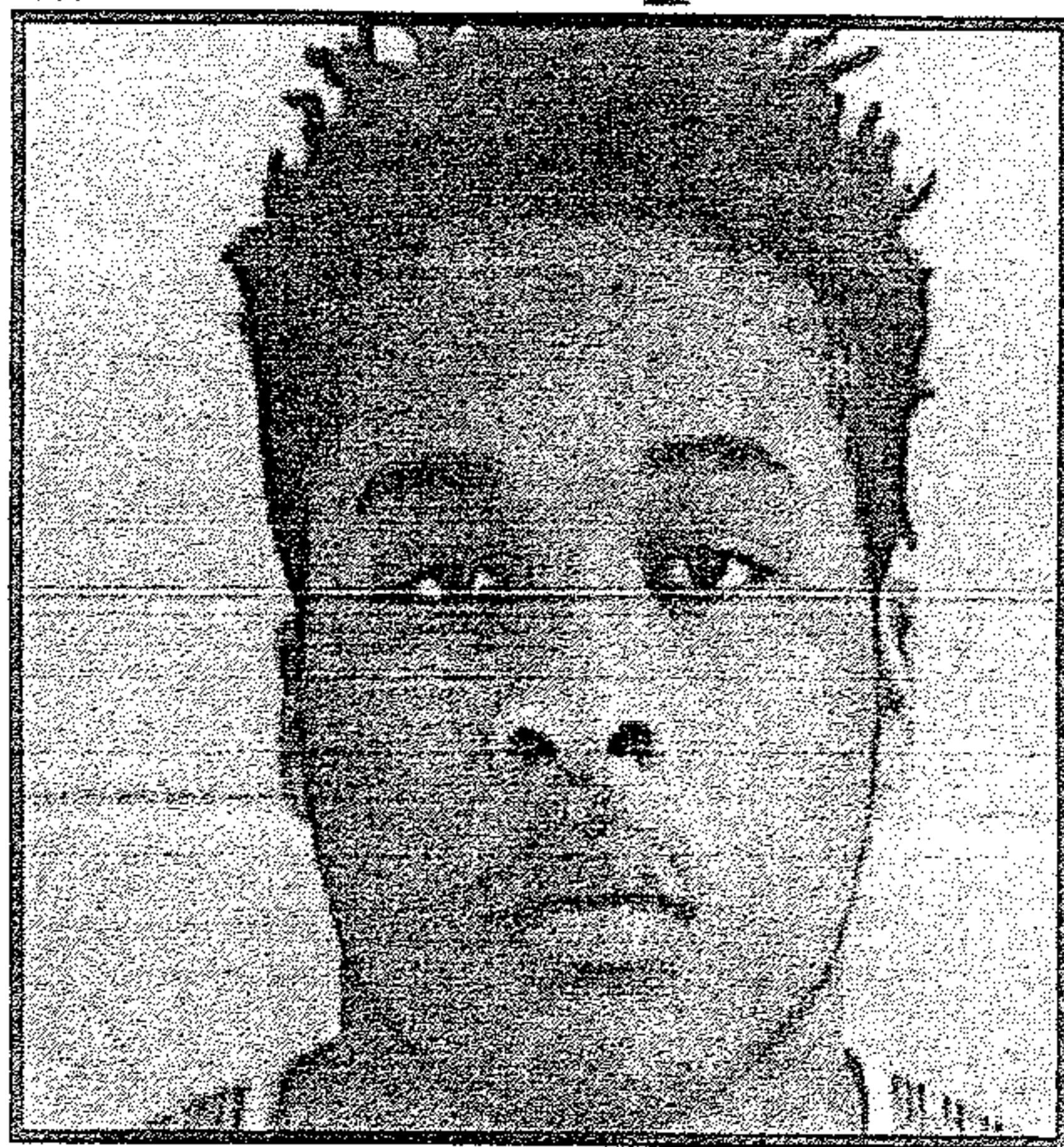

## Eclipse: Who? What? Where? When? and How?

**Total Solar Eclipse**  
On Monday, August 21, 2017, all of North America will be treated to an eclipse of the sun. Anyone within the path of totality can see one of nature's most awe-inspiring sights - a total solar eclipse. This path, where the moon will completely cover the sun and the sun's ten-

uous atmosphere - the corona - can be seen, will stretch from Lincoln Beach, Oregon to Charleston, South Carolina. Observers outside this path will still see a partial solar eclipse where the moon covers part of the sun's disk.

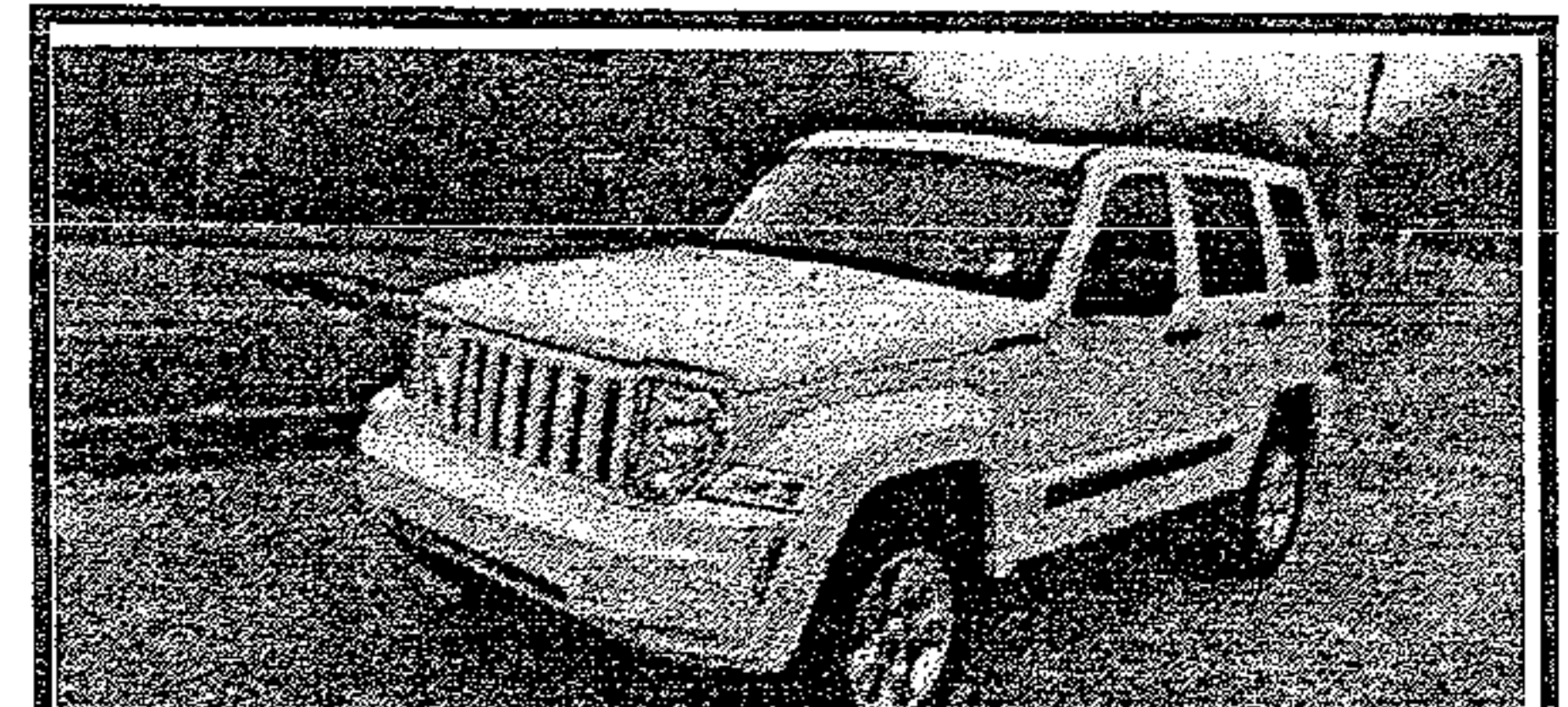


Enjoy your weekend! Be safe! Plan ahead! The traffic is going to be unreal and you won't be getting any-

**Who Can See It?**

Lots of people! Everyone in the contiguous United States, in fact, everyone in North America plus parts of South America, Africa, and Europe will see at least a partial solar eclipse, while the thin path of totality will pass through portions of 14 states.

**What is It?**

This celestial event is a solar eclipse in which the moon passes between the sun and Earth and blocks all or part of the sun for up to about three hours, from beginning to end, as viewed from a given location. For this eclipse, the longest period when the moon completely blocks the sun from any given location along the path will be about two minutes and 40 seconds. The last time the contiguous U.S. saw a total eclipse was in 1979.

**Where Can You See It?**

You can see a partial eclipse, where the moon covers only a part of the sun, anywhere in North America (see “Who can see it?”). To see a total eclipse, where the moon fully covers

the sun for a short few minutes, you must be in the path of totality. The path of totality is a relatively thin ribbon, around 70 miles wide, that will cross the U.S. from West to East. The first point of contact will be at Lincoln Beach, Oregon at 9:05 a.m. PDT. Totality begins there at 10:16 a.m. PDT. Over the next hour and a half, it will cross through Oregon, Idaho, Wyoming, Montana, Nebraska, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, Illinois, Kentucky, Tennessee, Georgia, and North and South Carolina. The total eclipse will end near Charleston, South Carolina at 2:48 p.m. EDT. From there the lunar shadow leaves the United States at 4:09 EDT. Its longest duration will be near Carbondale, Illinois, where the sun will be completely covered for two minutes and 40 seconds.

Ian Baker, 20, Dunleith Way NC, was charged with Simple Possession, and Poss. of Drug Para.

Justin Sharpe, 20, Cedar Ridge Way NC, was charged with Man/Sell/Poss. of Controlled Substance Sch. I, x5, and Poss. of Drug Para.

Agent Brendan DeBoer of the 9th JDTF was parked in the parking lot of Moe's Southwest Grill in Lenoir City, TN. While parked a black Hyundai pulled up beside him occupied by two white males. The males began acting suspiciously by hiding their actions and hunching over and smoking something. Agent exited his car and immediately could smell the odor of marijuana coming from the smoke emanating from the partially open window of the Hyundai. Agent made contact with the occupants and identified them both. Agent asked the driver, Justin Sharpe, if there was any marijuana in the vehicle and he stated there was a jar in the trunk. Agent asked each

occupant to exit the vehicle and searched there person. The passenger Ian Baker had a small amount of Dab or Hash oil in his left front pocket. Upon search of the driver Agent found 4 glass vials of suspected Hash oil. A search of the vehicle was conducted based on Probable Cause and consent of the driver Justin Sharpe. A search of the trunk revealed a large black bag with numerous glass vials of suspected hash oil, 2 jars of marijuana, blotter paper believed to have 2-CE on it (A schedule I substance). Both individuals were read their Miranda Warnings and stated that they understood. Justin Sharpe stated the bag belonged to him and that the glass vial contained LSD and later identified the substance as

2-CE. Sharpe stated that there was approximately 100+ hits of the substance. Also located in the bag was a plastic bag containing Pyschedelic mushrooms also a schedule I narcotic. There were numerous other glass vials one of which containing a substance suspected to be DMT (Schedule I narcotic) and several pills believed to be MDMC (a controlled substance). The amount of substances present and quantity justify possession for resale. The additional substances will be sent to the lab for identification. Ian Baker also had a glass pipe and piece of blotter paper with an unknown substance. This occurred in Loudon County.
