## Comptroller Releases Q & A on Student Data Privacy Law

The Comptroller's Office of Research and Education Accountability (OREA) has released a report that answers some com- mon questions about student data privacy in Tennessee. The Q & A provides information on state and federal laws that protect K-12 students' privacy.

In general, student data privacy refers to

efforts to maintain the confidentiality of information that iden- tifies individual stu- dents. The term "stu- dent data" is broad, encompassing almost anything that a student creates in school or that identifies an indi- vidual student.

Student data is not limited to social se-

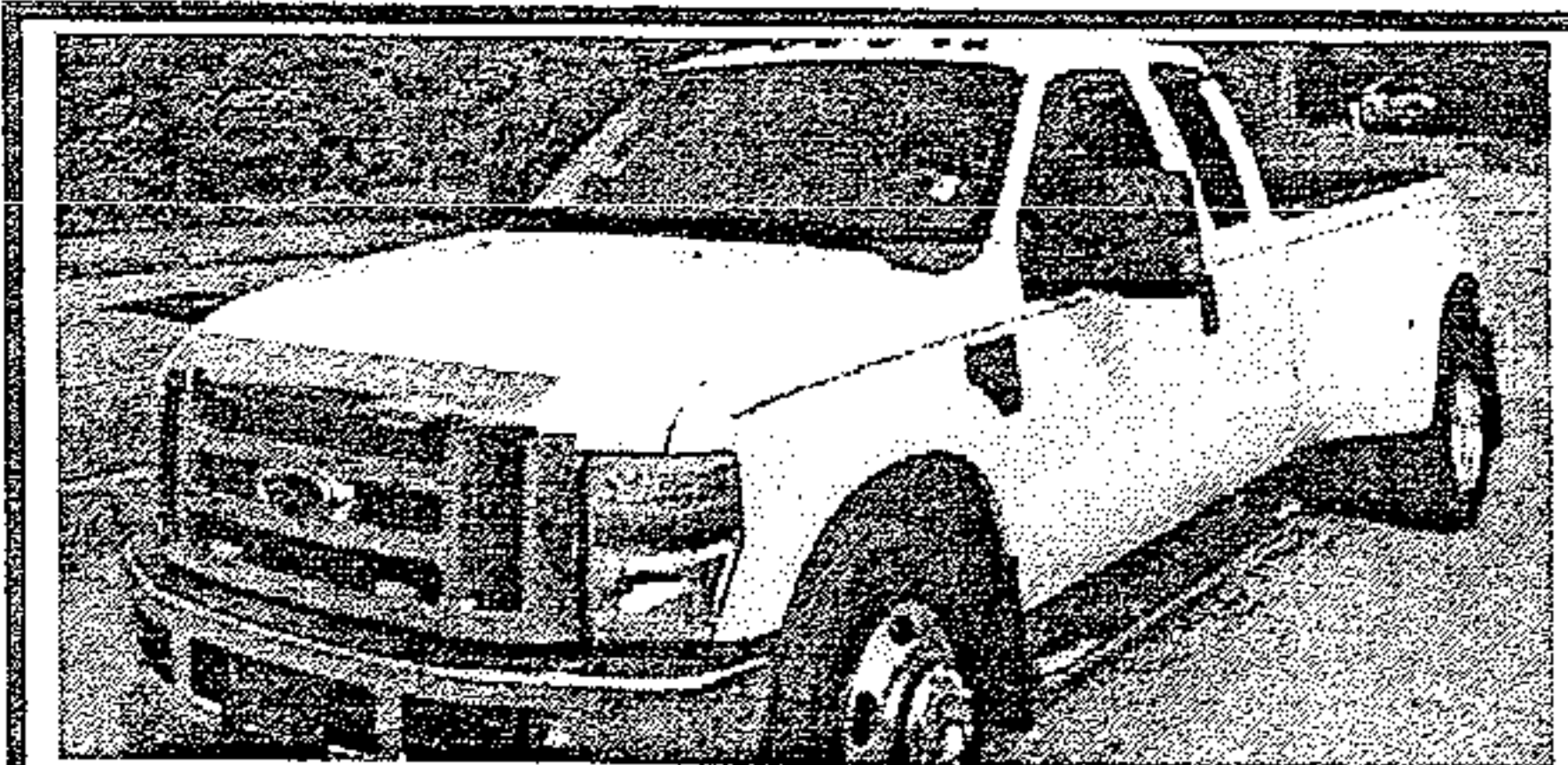

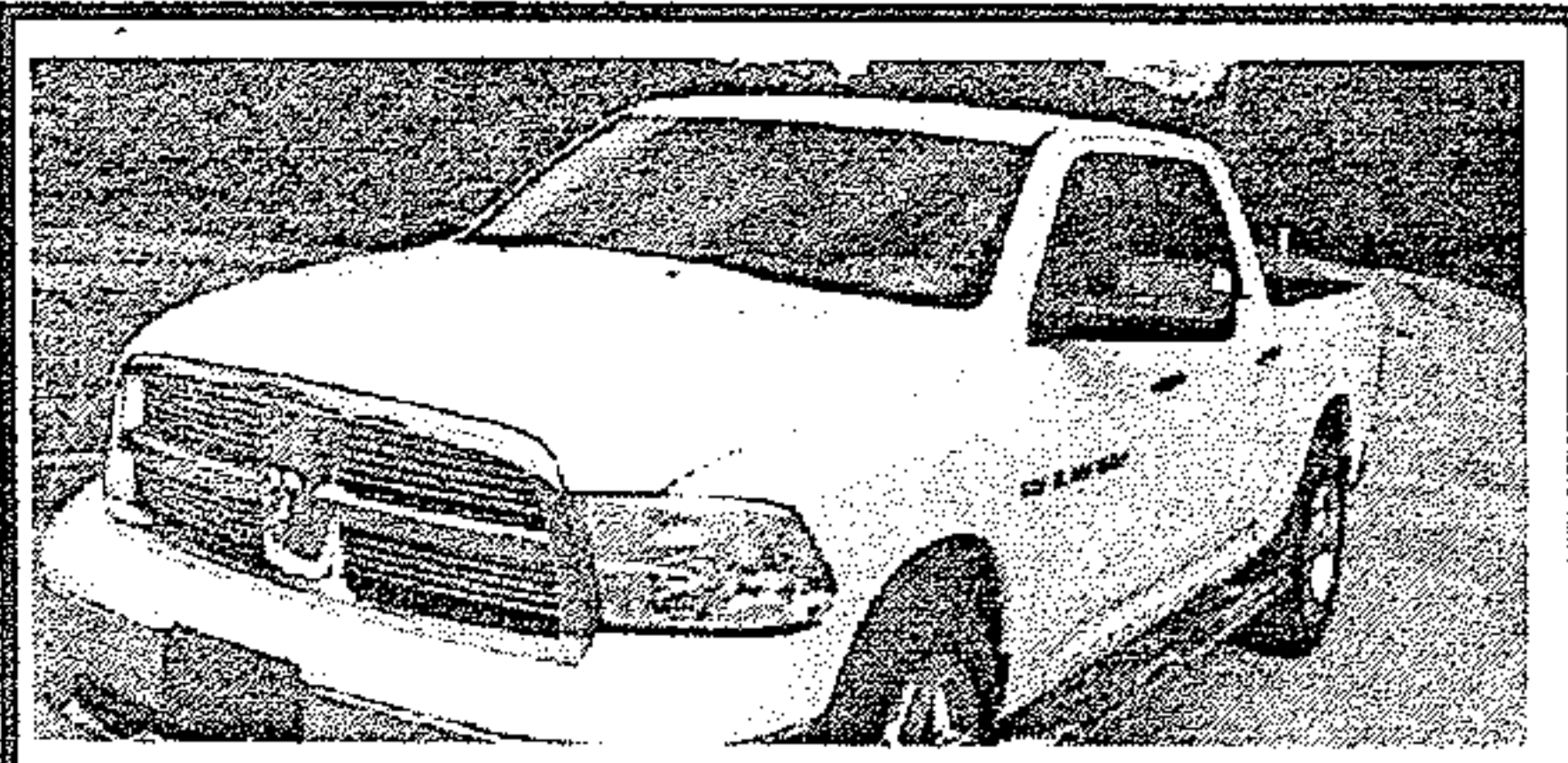

**Biker**

Robert Lynn Miller, 21, was charged with evading arrest, resisting arrest, traffic control device, removal of registration decal and driving without a valid license.

Officer Jason Arden LCPD, did observe a red / silver motorcycle cross over Kingston Street and 2nd Avenue where it failed to obey the stop sign. Officer located the bike at West 2nd Avenue and observed the defendant dismount. Officer turned patrol unit to initiate a stop and the defendant fled the area on foot between the houses toward West 1st Avenue. A check of the registration displayed returned as expired on 03/31/2017 but physically displayed a 2018 sticker with the identification number cut away. Officer then drove to a location one block west to observe from concealment. Approximately one hour later, officer observed the bike

pull away and travel north on E-Street. 

curity numbers or test scores. Student data can encompass school work, class behavior, or even a student's location. A key question to ask is whether a piece of information identifies an individual student or uses personal information about an individual student – if the answer is yes, then that information can be considered "student data".

State and federal laws protect student data privacy by governing the actions of either a school employee, a member of the public, or a third-party vendor or technology operator. The new publication explains state laws in Tennessee that protect student data privacy. One of the laws - the Data Accessibility, Transparency and Accountability Act - gives the state more control and oversight regarding Tennessee public school employees' collection of student data, and strengthens parental rights with respect to student data privacy. The Tennessee Gen-

eral Assembly passed this law in 2014.

Another law is the Student Online Personal Protection Act, passed in 2016, which primarily addresses the actions of third parties outside of Tennessee schools and districts. This law regulates vendors/contractors or other third parties operating online services used by students. The three primary federal laws related to student data privacy are also covered in the Comptroller's publication.

School districts may take steps to protect student data privacy beyond what the laws require. However, those additional protections are likely to cost more in time or money.

Upon arrival Officer, spoke with victim/complainant, who gave a verbal statement stating that his girlfriend/offender, Ms. Tammy Stallings, slapped him twice in

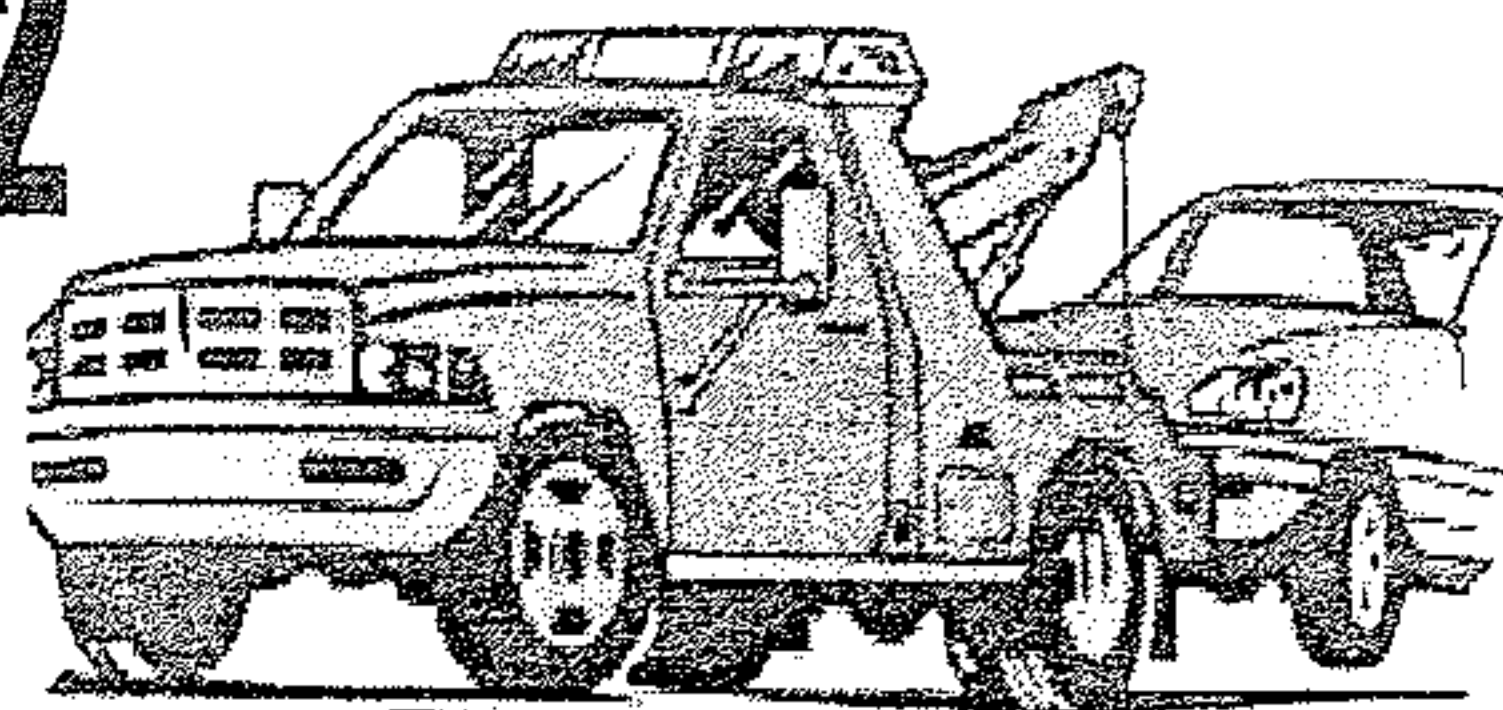

Deputy JC Schultz LCSO, and Deputy Guy wells observed a white female walking down Hwy 11 at Shaw Ferry Rd. The female was
