Models always get- | Comptroller Releases Q & A on Student Data Privacy Law

The Comptroller's Office of Research and Education Accountability (OREA) has released a report that answers some common questions about student data privacy in Tennessee. The Q & A provides information on state and federal laws that protect K-12 students' privacy.

In general, student data privacy refers to



the confidentiality of information that identifies individual students. The term "student data" is broad, encompassing almost anything that a student creates in school or that identifies an individual student.

Robert Lynn Miller, 21, was charged with evading arrest, resisting arrest, traffic control device, removal of registration decal and driving without a valid license.

Officer Jason Arden LCPD, did observe a red / silver motorcycle cross over Kingston Street and 2nd Avenue where it failed to obey the stop sign. Officer located the bike at West 2nd Avenue and observed the defendant dismount. Officer turned patrol unit to initiate a stop and the defendant fled the area on foot between the houses toward West 1st Avenue. A check of the registration displayed returned as expired on 03/31/2017 but physically displayed a 2018 sticker with the identification number cut away. Officer then drove to a location one block west to observe from concealment. Approximately one hour later, officer observed the bike

pull away and travel north on E-Street. Ms Garcia was arrested on scene and transported to the Loudon County Jail by this Deputy without incident. This did occur in Loudon County, TN.




