

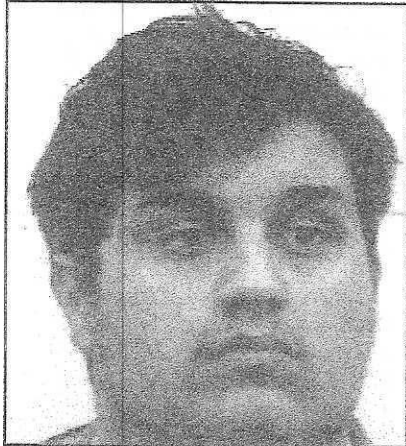

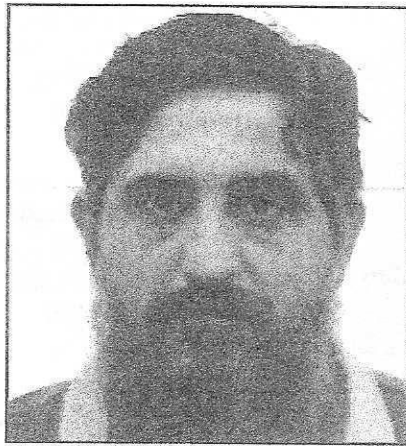

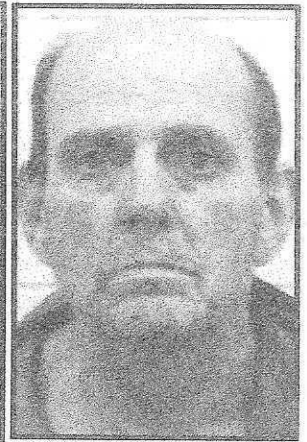

## TDOT Reminds Motorists to Work with Us – Move Over, Slow Down in Work Zones National Work Zone Awareness Week

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is joining states across the nation to ask motorists to Work with Us – move over and slow down for highway workers. TDOT will spread that message statewide during National Work Zone Awareness Week to improve safety in Tennessee's interstate and high-

way construction and maintenance work zones.

"It's been six years since our TDOT family lost three employees struck and killed by passing motorists, and it's still fresh in our memories," TDOT Interim Commissioner Joe Galbato said. "Hundreds of TDOT employees are working on our highways

each day. We need motorists to work with us by moving over and slowing down for our workers and first responders along our interstates and state routes. We ask drivers to pay attention to signs, observe the hands-free law, reduce your speed, and move over when possible."

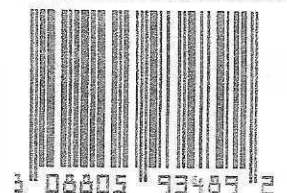
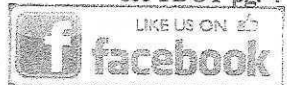

**Thieves**

Antonio Ionut, 18, Braeswood Blvd. Texas, was charged with Identity Theft x2, and Theft of Property x2. Costel Mitrache, 41, Braeswood Blvd. Texas, was charged with Identity Theft x3 and Theft of Property x2. On April 5th, 2022, Flock cameras alerted law enforcement to theft suspects from the Oak Ridge Walmart on Highway 321. Agent Fritts observed the vehicle, a Black

KIA suv with Texas tag PYW9496, in the Walmart parking lot. Agent observed the vehicle leave Walmart and fail to turn on its headlights while traveling in the rain on Kelsey Lane, Garret Drive, and Highway 321. The driver was also not wearing his seatbelt. Upon stopping the vehicle the driver was identified as Costel Mitrache and the passenger was identified as Antonio Ionut. Walmart LP determined that MITRACHE and IONUT

both used a quick cash scam while at Walmart by scamming Walmart out of US currency. Agent asked MITRACHE if I could search his vehicle and person and he agreed. Found in MITRACH's pocket was a debit card belonging to victim. Found in MITRACH's wallet were (2) debit cards that belong to another victim and (2) debit cards that belong to another victim. Agent asked IONUT if he could search him and he

agreed. Found in IONUT's pocket was a debit card belonging to victim. Found in IONUT's wallet were (2) debit cards belonging to another victim, (2) more debit cards belonging to victim, and a check that had been stolen out of South Carolina with a value of 150.00 dollars. Found in the vehicle in MITRACHE's fanny pack and suitcase was approximately 18,710 dollars.

The debit cards found, contained personal identifying information of individuals that were not present at the time of use and recovery by law enforcement MITRACHE and IONUT were taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

During the booking process, jailers located 56 stolen checks hidden in MITRACHE's groin area that were valued at approximately 62,037.74.

Megan Moore, 36, Browder Hollow Road Lenoir City, was charged with Domestic Assault, and Aggravated Burglary.

Corporal Z. Frye LCSO, responded to Turman Dr in reference to an unwanted guest.

According to the report, The complaint/victim, stated that his ex-girlfriend had showed up at his residence and was attempting to get inside the house and had broke the glass window out on the front door. Upon arrival Cpl. made contact with the offender, Megan Moore. She stated that she had traveled to this residence with victim and that she was drunk and accidentally knocked too hard on the front door window causing it to break.

The report noted, She did

have several cuts on her hand and wrist that she stated was from the broken glass on the door.

The victim stated that he currently moved into this residence with his brother and parents after returning from rehab. He had ended his relationship with Megan a few weeks ago. He stated she showed up to the residence intoxicated and began beating on the door and window causing it to break.

A witness, brother of victim, was holding the door shut trying to prevent her from entering the residence. Victim stated that once she broke the glass they both ran towards the back bedroom. Megan Moore then made entry into the residence and began assaulting the victim. She began swinging with both hands and struck victim

several times across the face and then bit him in the right arm. The victim was able to get her off of him and Moore then left the residence and waited in the driveway for our arrival. Cpl. did observe the window on the door to be completely shattered with glass on the floor and front porch. The frame around the

window had been pried open on one side as well. Cpl. also observed bite marks and red marks on victims face and arm. The homeowner and witness, did witness all said events. Megan Moore does not reside at this residence and currently states she is homeless. This all occurred in Loudon County, TN.
