

On April 5th, 2022, Flock cameras alerted law enforcement to theft suspects from the Oak Ridge Walmart on Highway 321. Agent Fritts observed the vehicle, a Black

Upon arrival Cpl. made contact with the offender, Megan Moore. She stated that she had traveled to this residence with victim and that she was drunk and accidentally knocked too hard on the front door window causing it to break.

have several cuts on her hand and wrist that she stated was from the broken glass on the

The victim stated that he currently moved into this residence with his brother and parents after returning from rehab. He had ended his relationship with Megan a few weeks ago. He stated she showed up to the residence intoxicated and began beating on the door and window causing it to break.
