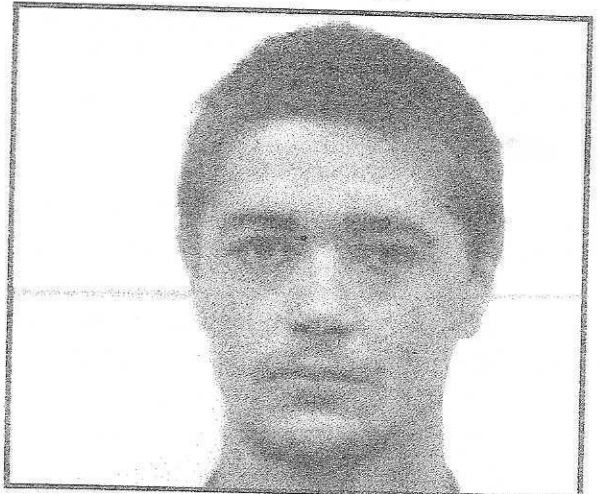

## CDC Investigation Notice: Small turtles purchased online linked to Salmonella outbreak affecting children

A CDC investigation notice regarding a multistate outbreak of Salmonella infections has been posted: <https://www.cdc.gov/salmonella/stanley-07-22/index.html>

### Key Points:

Fifteen people infected with the outbreak strain of Salmonella have been reported from 11 states. Five people have been hospital-

ized. No deaths have been reported. Many people in this outbreak are children.

The true number of sick people is likely higher than the number reported, and the outbreak may not be limited to the states with known illnesses. This is because some people recover without medical care and are not tested for Salmonella.

Interviews with ill

people, laboratory data, and purchase information show that small turtles (shells less than 4 inches long) are making people sick. Most people reported buying small turtles online. Half of the people who purchased their turtles online bought them from a website called

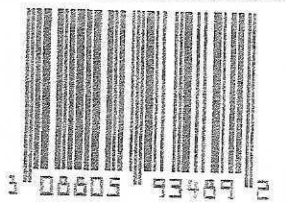
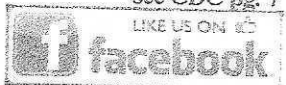

### Charged

Larry Trueblood, 28, County Road 415 Englewood, was charged with Aggravated Assault, Reckless Driving, Reckless Endangerment x2, Evading Arrest, Poss. Of Drug Para, Driving on Roadway Laned for Traffic, Improper Passing, Display of Registration Plate, Due Care, Speeding, Traffic Control Signal, Requirements for stop sign, and Driving on Revoked/Suspended License.

Deputy Harrison LCSO, observed a black four door sedan getting on I-75 south bound from highway 72 fail to use its turn signal while entering the highway and changing lanes. Upon running the registration dispatch advised the registration plate did not come back on file, but through the integrated portal the registration was expired and did not come back to the vehicle. Deputy attempted a traffic stop on the vehicle on I-75 south bound at the 71

mile marker, but the vehicle continued to accelerate and pass other vehicles on the shoulder. Deputy initiated a pursuit with the vehicle as it exited I-75 at the 68 exit and took a left on Pond Creek Road towards Highway 11. Deputy continued to pursue as it made a right on Highway 11, left on Fork Creek, and left on Calloway Road. While on Calloway, the vehicle lost control in a sharp 90 degree left hand turn and ran through a barbwire fence in front of Calloway Road. The vehicle continued on through a field until it came to a stop in the gravel driveway of Calloway road. As Deputy passed by the residence in search of the vehicle, it took a left out of the driveway behind him and while on Calloway, hit Deputy Lane in his patrol unit head on in an attempt to elude him and deputy once again. Deputy Lane did suf-

fer minor injuries to his left arm as a result of the impact. Deputy continued to pursue as the vehicle made a right on Fork Creek Road towards Highway 11. As the vehicle came to Highway 11, It accelerated past the stop sign causing the vehicle to lose control and crash across the roadway at Christian Street taking down a power pole.

Deputy exited his patrol vehicle and placed the driver identified as, Larry Trueblood Jr and the passenger Heather Carroll in custody. During a search of Trueblood's person Deputy located two needles as well as a scale and clear baggie with crystal like residue. Loudon County Dispatch advised Trueblood's license was revoked as of as 11-15-2021. TrueBlood was read miranda

and when asked why he ran he stated "stupidity". Carroll stated during the duration of the pursuit she asked Trueblood multiple times to stop the vehicle to which he refused. Trueblood refused EMS on scene and Carroll was transported by EMS to Ft. Loudon Medical Center for minor injuries and was later released. Tennessee Highway Patrol later arrived on scene to process both crashes. Heather Carroll was wanted out of Monroe County.

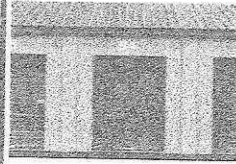

**What You Should Do:**

Only buy turtles with shells longer than 4 inches and buy them from reputable pet stores or rescues.

Stay healthy around your pet turtle by always washing your hands after touching, feeding, or caring for your turtle. Adults should make sure young children are washing their hands properly.

Don't toss your turtle if you decide you no longer want it. Reach out to your local pet store or reptile rescue.

Pick the right pet for your family. Pet turtles are not recommended for children younger than 5, adults aged 65 and older, and people with weakened immune systems as they are more likely to get a serious illness from germs that turtles can carry.

**About Salmonella:**

Most people infected with Salmonella develop diarrhea,

fever, and stomach cramps 6 hours to 6 days after being exposed to the bacteria.

The illness usually lasts 4 to 7 days, and most people recover without treatment.

In some people, the illness may be so severe that the patient is hospitalized.

Children younger than 5, adults 65 and older, and people with weakened immune systems are more likely to have severe illness.
