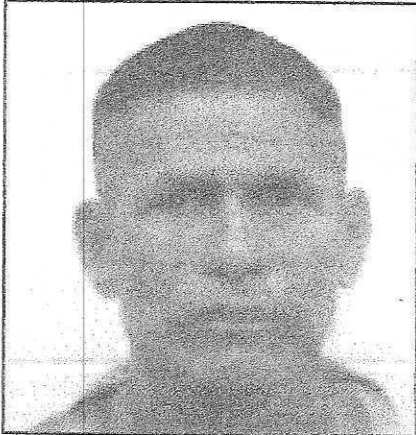

## Former Heritage High School Football Coach Sentenced To Fifteen Years for Attempted Production Of Child Pornography

The Honorable Thomas A. Varlan, United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Tennessee, sentenced James David Morrow, 51, of Maryville, Tennessee, to 15 years in prison.

Morrow, a former football coach at Heritage High School, pleaded guilty to one count of attempted production of child pornography, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2251(a) and (e). Following his incarceration, Morrow will be on supervised release for 12 years and will be required to comply with special sex offender conditions. In addition, Morrow will be required to register with the state sex offender registry in whatever state in which he resides.

As set forth in the

plea agreement filed with the court, Morrow used a social media platform to engage in conversations with an individual he believed to be a 12-year-old girl but who was actually an undercover federal agent. Morrow, despite knowing the vic-

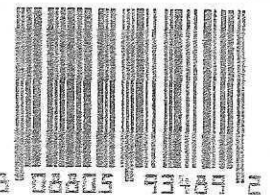

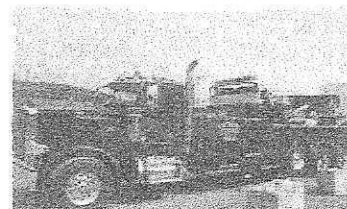

Chelsey Coker, 26, Sunny Side Road Philadelphia, was charged with, DUI, Joyriding, And Driving on Revoked/Suspended License.

Deputy Stanley LCSO, responded to W Lee highway in regards to a possible stolen vehicle. Upon arrival, Deputy made contact with the victim/complainant who advised his daughter (Chelsey Coker) had taken his BMW out of his garage without his permission while he was gone. Victim also exclaimed that Chelsey was highly intoxicated on an unknown substance. He also stated she had discharged a firearm into a wall of the residence earlier that morning, but it was not an act of assault or intimidation.

Deputy was advised by oth-

er family members on scene that Chelsey was spotted driving the car through multiple roads in Monroe County. She started making her way back towards Loudon County on Highway 11. Deputy spotted her in the BMW. In which Deputy conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Before the vehicle came to a stop, Deputy observed the vehicle swerve and move in a jerking motion.

Deputy made contact with Chelsey, and she seemed very anxious and immediately started spontaneously uttering incoherent statements. Deputy then detained her and read her Miranda Rights, in which she agreed to speak without council. She could not give him an exact explanation on why she took the vehicle, but then later stat-

Officer R. Miller LCPD, was conducting a patrol in the area of Kingston Street near Old Highway 95 in Lenoir City, TN. During patrol duties Officer observed a silver in color Honda sedan traveling north on Old Highway 95. While observing the vehicle Officer noticed that the driver's side brake light was not functioning properly. Officer initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle in the area of Old Highway 95 near Snow Biz in Lenoir City. Upon traffic stop Officer made contact with the driver of the vehicle who gave the name of, Fred-

dy Molina and the date of birth. MONLINA advised that he did not have a license. While speaking with MOLINA Officer visibly observed a marijuana roach in plain view near the gear shifter of the vehicle. Officer asked MOLINA if there was any marijuana inside of the vehicle at which time, he handed him a bag of a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana (3 grams). A probable cause search of the vehicle relieved (0.56 grams) of a crystal-like substance believed to be methamphetamine. MOLINA was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

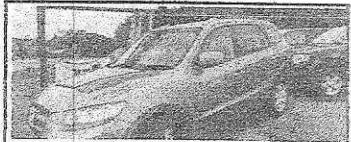

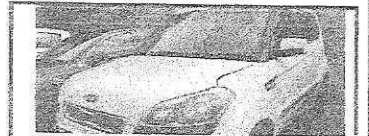

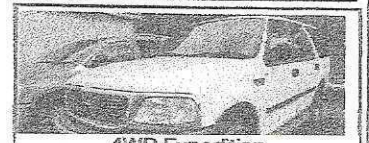

tim's age, repeatedly asked her to take sexually explicit photographs of herself for him to view, and he sent her several photographs of himself, including one displaying his genitalia.

This prosecution was the result of an investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Jennifer Kolman represented the United States.

ed that she had permission. While speaking with Chelsey, she seemed very anxious and was sweating.

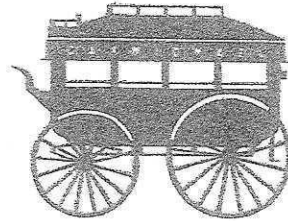
She also did not make sense in some of her statements and would constantly speak about something random and irrelevant. Deputy attempted to conduct a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests with Coker, but discovered she was unable to perform the tests properly and was started to get agitated. Based on the whole totality of circumstances,

Deputy had determined Chelsey to have been under the influence of an unknown intoxicant and subsequently charged her with Driving under the Influence. Chelsey agreed to provide me with a blood sample, which was obtained at Ft. Loudoun Medical Center.

Deputy was also advised by dispatch that Chelsey's license was suspended. Charges as follows: Joyriding, Driving Under the Influence, Driving while License Suspended. All occurred in Loudon County.

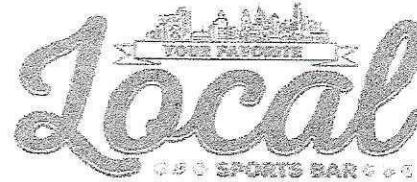

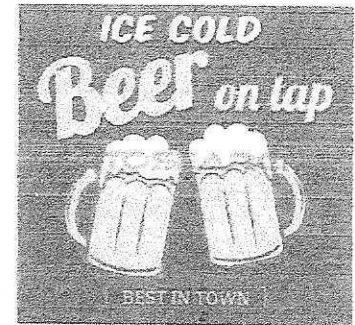

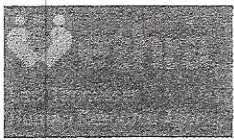
