New offerings include Clarence Brown Theatre and Knoxville Opera.

Library card holders can explore many cultural attractions for a lot less. Knox County Public Library is pleased to announce new and renewing partners for its popular Explorer Pass program. In August 2021, the Library introduced the program to provide free or reduced admis-

sion to area attractions including Zoo Knoxville, area museums and historic homes.

This year, the program has expanded its offerings to include Clarence Brown Theatre and Knoxville Opera performances. New passes include one free ticket with the purchase of one adult ticket to Knoxville Opera's Glory Denied beginning Friday, September

9 and three children's tickets with the purchase of one adult ticket to Murder on the Orient Express at CBT on select nights starting Sunday, September 18. Knoxville Symphony Orchestra, which joined the program last year, is offering tickets for its Masterworks and Chamber Classics se-

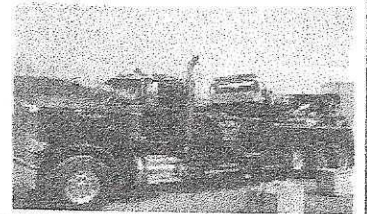

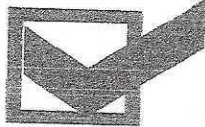

Officer Law LCSO, was dispatched to Glenbrook Drive in reference to a 911 hang-up. Upon arrival Officer met "Victim", who stated him, and his wife got into an argument over a mower. Victim stated while arguing that Mrs. Millisaps followed him into the bathroom, when victim was trying to put on some pants, Mrs. Millisaps was holding down his pants resulting in his zipper getting broke and begging him not to leave. Victim stated she then grabbed him by his genitals and would not let go. He then stated he had to push her off him, thus her grabbing him by his face. Officer did observe

visible markings on victim face/neck, victim then stated once she began scratching him, he pushed her again and then hit her on the back. 

Officers with the Lenoir City Police Dept., were dispatched to a possible intoxicated driver leaving Food City. The complainant advised a partial TN tag of (2226) attached to a White Dodge Dakota.
