RESOLUTION
A Resolution in opposition of the Loudon County Commission Requesting the Adoption of a Private Act by the Tennessee State Legislature requiring the Submission of Plats, Plans, Plots, and Road Plans Proposed within the Urban Growth Area of Lenoir City, Tennessee be submitted to the Loudon County Planning Commission for review and approval.
WHEREAS, Lenoir City is a Home Rule Municipality that opposes Loudon County Commission Resolution on the 2009 to adopt a Private Act requiring the submission of plats, plans, plots, and road plans proposed within the Urban Growth Area of Lenoir City, Tennessee be submitted to the Loudon County Planning Commission for review and approval; and
WHEREAS, the consistent development of regulations and review of plan proposals for Lenoir City and Loudon County can and will be accomplished without the passage of County Commission's request for a Private Act; and
WHEREAS, Public Chapter 1101 provides structure for municipalities for planning within their municipal jurisdiction and urban growth boundaries; and
WHEREAS, the City of Lenoir City has decided to withdraw from participation in the Loudon County Executive Planning Council to better serve the citizens of Lenoir City with the appointment of its own planning Director.
NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved, that a Resolution in Opposition of the Loudon County Commission Requesting the Adoption of a Private Act by the Tennessee State Legislature Requiring the Submission of Plats, Plans, Plots, and Road Plans Proposed within the Urban Growth Area of Lenoir City, Tennessee, be submitted to the Loudon County Planning Commission for Review and Approval.
Be it further Resolved that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to our State Legislative delegation.
Be It Finally Resolved, that this Resolution shall take affect immediately the public welfare requiring it.
