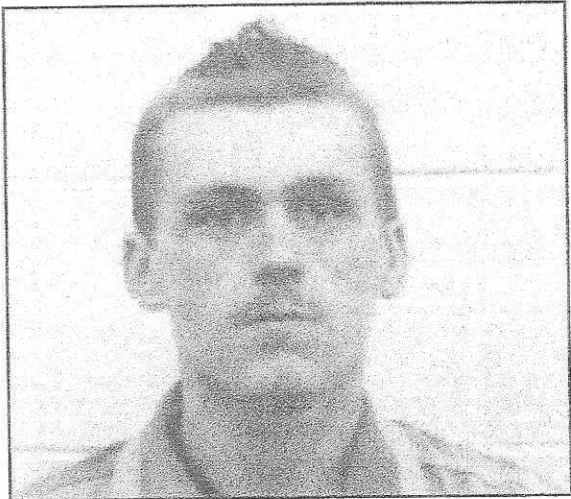

enforcement officers who made the ultimate sacrifice, as well as the family members, friends, and fellow officers left behind.

In 1962, President Kennedy issued the first proclamation for Peace Officers Memorial Day and National Police Week to remember and honor law enforcement officers for their service and sacrifices. Peace Officers

Memorial Day, which every year falls on May 15, specifically honors law enforcement officers killed or disabled in the line of duty.

This year, the names of more than 280 officers killed in the line of duty are being added to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washing-

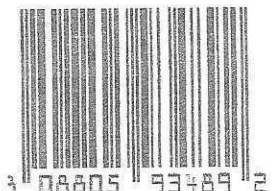

Sherron Shelton, 54, Caldwell Road Loudon, was charged with Aggravated Assault.

Deputy Craig Brewer LCSO, was dispatched to Forest Heights Circle Lenoir City Tennessee to a report of a past domestic. On arrival, the deputy met, the victim who explained when he woke up at Caldwell Road Loudon Tennessee, where he was residing with his girlfriend Sherron Shelton. She had a knife threatening him to stab or cut him if he did not get out of the residence. While he was packing his belongings she accused him of having

her keys and pulled the knife on him again. She grabbed his left arm leaving a cut with her fingernail on his forearm. Jeremiah Noah, 20, Watkins Road Loudon, was charged with Man/Sell/Del/Resale Sch. I & VI, Poss. of Drug Para, Possession of Handgun, Theft, Shoplifting, Tampering/Fabricating with Evidence, and Resisting Arrest.

Asset Protection Specialist at (Walmart) called in a shoplifting complaint. He had a female detained. A male suspect fled on foot. Detailed

information was given about his appearance. Reports were made that it appeared the male was carrying a firearm due to his actions as he ran. The female was asked by Officer Jason Arden and she confirmed that Jeremiah Logan Noah was armed with a pistol.
