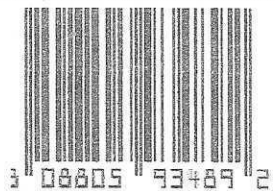

Christopher Collins, 47, Watkins Road Loudon, was charged with Aggravated Assault, and False Imprisonment.

Deputy Watson LCSO, responded to the 72 Market and Deli in reference to a domestic that occurred at Watkins Road. Upon arrival, deputy made contact with (Victim/Complainant) and she made the following summarized statements about the incident;

According to the report, On this date at approximately sunrise, the victim husband, Mr. Christopher Collins (Offender/Arrestee),

woke her up asking her questions about what was on her phone. The victim stated that Christopher Collins often accuses her of cheating on him. Ms. Charity Collins stated that the two argued for hours this morning when the victim stated that she was not giving Mr. Christopher Collins the answers that he wanted so he grabbed her by the hair and slung her onto the bed.

Mr. Christopher Collins then climbed on top of her and started yelling at her. The victim stated that she was attempted to use her arms to push him off of her when he bit her on the hand. The victim stated that Christopher

Collins eventually climbed off of her and grabbed a crutch that was in the room. The victim stated that Christopher Collins threatened to kill her, while holding the crutch, if she did not tell him what was on her phone. Mr. Christopher Collins left the room and did not return. The victim stated that Christopher Collins would not allow her to leave the bedroom to use the bathroom or get anything to drink. The victim stated that she had a key to her car hid on the back porch

and snuck out of the house at approximately 1400 hours and left.

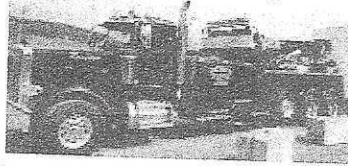

Officer R. Miller, with the

Lenoir City Police Department, responded to Broadway Street (Car Wash) located in Lenoir City, TN in regards to two subjects who were passed out in the front seat of a silver Chevy SUV. On scene the officer located the Chevy SUV which was parked in a wash bay of the car wash where the officer visually observed the male driver and female passenger of the vehicle asleep. As the

officer approached the vehicle the male driver woke up and immediately started the vehicle. The officer was able to quickly make contact with both the male and female. While speaking with both the driver and passenger the officer noticed that both subjects appeared sweaty and confused. The officer also visually observed a glass pipe commonly used to smoke THC Wax with at the feet of the female passenger. During the investigation the male driver was identified as Luke Daigle, and the female was identified as Samantha Jones. I then had both LUKE and SAMANTHA step out of the vehicle to conduct a probable cause search of the vehicle. During the subsequent search of the vehicle, the officer located several used hypodermic needles throughout the entire vehi-

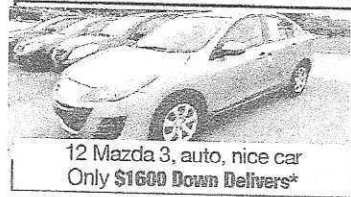
cle, along with a glass pipe commonly used to smoke methamphetamine with. The glass pipe was located wrapped up in a bandanna in the passenger's side door. The officer also located the THC glass pipe along with (2) containers of a brown wax like substance believed to be THC Wax in the passenger's side floorboard. SAMANTHA was then placed under arrest. Once at the jail SAMANTHA informed me that she had two items in her bra that she forgot about. SAMANTHA retrieve the items at which time she handed them to me. Located was a crystal-like substance believed to be methamphetamine (0.91 grams). Inside of the other container was a brown wax like substance believed to be THC Wax. Approximate total of THC Wax (3 grams).
